MATHEWS SHINES, TORRES WALKS OFF ON TULSA: Bryan Torres hit a walk-off home run with two outs in the bottom of the 9th inning to break a 2-2 tie and lift the Cardinals to their third walk off win in four games this week, 3-2 over the Tulsa Drillers on Friday night at Hammons Field. **Torres** drove in all 3 runs for Springfield. **Quinn Mathews** put together his best start yet in Double-A, allowing just 1 R on 2 H over a career-high 7.2 innings with 12 K. He retired the first 19 batters he faced. The Cardinals have now won 6 in a row and 9 of their last 10.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Chris Campos** makes his 10th start this season with the Drillers... Last start came on Sunday, August 18 at home against Midland and he allowed 3 ER on 5 H with 3 K over 6.0 IP...His previous 2 starts did not allow a run on just 5 H with 11 K over 12.0 IP combined...Did not factor in the decision in his only start against the Cardinals, allowing 6 R (5 ER) on 5 H with 3 BB and 5 K over 4.1 IP...Surrendered HRs to **Jacob Buchberger** and **Chandler Redmond**...Tulsa won the game 10-8...Added to the Tulsa roster June 25...Began the season at High-A Great Lakes where he went 3-2 with a 3.15 ERA over 12 appearances (5 starts)...Struck out 50 Midwest League hitters while walking just 10 in 45.2 IP and a .213 BAA...Spent his first full season at Low-A Rancho Cucamonga in 2023 going 5-6 with a 5.06 ERA in 25 appearances (16 starts), striking out 85 batters in 69.1 IP...Selected by the Dodgers in the 7th round of the 2022 draft out of Saint Mary's...Served as a two-way player for the Gaels, as did Dodgers All-Star **Tony Gonsolin**...LA's 4th pick out of Saint Mary's since 2016 and was college teammates with **Michael Hobbs**...24 years old

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CLASSIC ROCK 106.7 For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

ON PACE...: With 69 wins through their first 118 games, the Cardinals are on pace for 80 wins in 2024, which would eclipse the franchise record for wins in a season. The current record is 77 wins which has been achieved twice: 2017 (77-63) and the Texas League title year of 2012 (77-61).

LONG, HOT SUMMER: Since the beginning of July, no team in Double-A has won more games than the Springfield Cardinals. The Cards are 30-13 since July 1, tied with the Portland Sea Dogs for the best record in Double-A during that time. Springfield since the calendar flipped to July is 4-1-2 in series and has the best batting average below Triple-A at .278. The Cardinals have an ERA during that time of 3.92, which is 4th-best in the Texas League. Through the end of June Springfield sported a 4.75 ERA.

CARDIAC CARDS: Over their last 10 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in 6 of their last 10 games, Springfield is 9-1 during that time. The Cards scored 33 of their 66 (50%) runs in the 7th inning or later, and have outscored their opponents 27-8 in the 8th inning or later. The Cardinals have walked off on the Drillers in 3 of the first 4 games of the series this week at Hammons Field.

POWER SURGE: After getting off to a slow start in the power category to start the 2024 season, the Cardinals have already eclipsed their home run total from the first half. With 47 longballs in 49 games, Springfield is on pace to hit 66 HR in the 2nd half after hitting just 37 in the 1st half. Springfield has the highest OBP (.352) and OPS (.763) in the Texas League and has scored 19 more runs (267) than any other club in all of Double-A in the 2nd half (since June 24). The Birds ranked 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712) in the Texas League in the 1st half.

FOR STARTERS: The Cardinals starting rotation has been up and down this season but has been lights out in the month of August. Springfield's starters since August 1 have the 2nd-best ERA in the Texas League at 2.36, trailing only Midland (2.34). Opposing hitters are batting just .215 against Cardinal starters since the calendar flipped. Through the first 4 games of their series against the Drillers, Cardinals starters are 1-0 with a 0.72 ERA with a .159 BAA.

TORRES BRINGS HOME TLPW HONORS: For his performance last week in Frisco, Cardinals INF/OF **Bryan Torres** was named Texas League Player of the Week for the first time this season. Torres is the 2nd Cardinal to win the award this season; **Nathan Church** was named Texas League Player of the Week for the week of April 15-21. **Cooper Hjerpe** earned Texas League Pitcher of the Week for June 17-23.

Torres had himself a week, batting .609 (14-for-23) with 2 2B, 4 RBIs and 8 runs scored against the RoughRiders. He added 3 BB and 2 SB and had a .654 OBP. **Torres** is 24-for-49 (.490) over his last 11 games and hit a walk-off homer in the bottom of the 9th inning on Friday night in the Cardinals' 3-2 win.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 41 games dating back to June 23, the final day of the 1st half, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the Eules, TX native leads all qualified hitters in the circuit with a .362 average, 10 HR and 38 RBIs and is slugging a league-high .624 and with a 1.047 OPS. In his first 44 games of the season, **Crooks** batted .282 with 1 HR and a .786 OPS. He has hit safely in 17 of his last 18 games and is batting .391 (25-for-64) with 4 HR and 19 RBIs over 17 games in August.

KING OF THE "K": Cardinals LHP **Quinn Mathews** has been racking up the strikeouts through his 3 levels in his first full season. With 12 K's on Friday night, the Stanford product added on to his MiLB-leading strikeout total with 180 in 126.2 IP on the season. **Mathews** leads **Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson** of the Cleveland organization who has struck out 164 in 107.2 IP with Low-A Lynchburg and High-A Lake County.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 22-for-22 and his 45 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 22 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 22.0 IP (0.41 ERA) and is 12-for-12 in save opportunities. **Svanson** has allowed just one un-earned run over his last 18 appearances, allowing just 11 H with 14 K over 21.0 IP. The Cardinals are 49-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
