RIDERS DOMINATE ON THE MOUND, TAKE THE SERIES OVER CORPUS:

The Frisco RoughRiders secured an opening series win with a 2-0 victory over the Corpus Christi Hooks on Sunday evening from Riders Field. RoughRiders starter Trey Supak (1-0) earned the win with five shutout innings and four strikeouts, throwing 38 of 57 pitches for strikes. Hooks starter Jose Fleury matched him with five scoreless frames and four strikeouts. The Riders and Hooks both loaded the bases in the sixth inning but could not get a run across. RoughRiders reliever Gavin Collyer (1-0) stranded the bases loaded while Hooks reliever Trey Dombroski (0-1) did the same. Collyer eventually earned the victory while Dombroski suffered the loss. In the bottom of the seventh, top Rangers prospect **Sebastian Walcott** ripped an RBI single off Dombroski to give Frisco a 1-0 lead. Next inning, Aaron Zavala hit a sacrifice fly to give the RoughRiders a 2-0 lead. Daniel Missaki nailed down his first save in his RoughRiders debut.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

The Frisco bullpen was a bright spot for the Riders in the opening series against Corpus Christi. While the pitching staff owned a 2.67 ERA overall (2nd-best in the Texas League to San Antonio, 2.00), the bullpen pitchers were even better. If you remove Ben Anderson's long relief as a normal starting pitcher, Frisco's bullpen pitchers combined to allow just one earned run over 12.0 innings during the weekend (0.75 ERA). Skylar Hales and Daniel Missaki both collected saves on Saturday and Sunday, respectively. Frisco's shutout win on Sunday marked just one of three shutouts in the Texas League so far. Their one blemish as a staff was 16 walks in the three games, tied for the third-most in the Texas League through the weekend.

NO. 1 PROVING TO BE NO. 1 PROSPECT:

 $\textbf{Sebastian Walcott} \ \text{has shown off his top prospect status in the first three games of the season, going 4-for-12 with two doubles, the double$ RBIs, a walk and a steal. He hit four balls with exit velocities over 105 in the weekend. Walcott is the No. 17 prospect in all of baseball by MLB.com and the No. 2 prospect by Keith Law of *The Athletic*.

VERSUS THE NATURALS:

A season ago, the RoughRiders went 7-5 against Northwest Arkansas. **Maximo Acosta** dominated on the offensive side (.421/.532/.658/1.190 over 10G), but Abimelec Ortiz and Josh Hatcher were the two best returners against the Naturals. Ortiz hit three home runs in 11 games while slashing .341/.449/.610/1.059 while Hatcher collected 17 hits in 10 games, including a five-hit game, to hit .405 with a 1.039 OPS against the Royals affiliate.

Josh Hatcher was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season and has started 2025 by hitting .626 (5-for-8) with an RBI, a stolen base and three runs scored over the first two games. Last year, he was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better.

ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz ended the year on fire for the RoughRiders. In his last 48 games, Ortiz hit .321/.413/.592/1.005 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 28 walks. After July 10th, in those 48 games, he is fourth in average (.321), first in OPS (1.005), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he paced all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 29 games, he batted .364 (40-for-110)/.470/.710/1.170 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 21 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. After, he hit .307 with a .954 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .760 OPS. Ortiz collected two hits on Saturday in the Riders win.

WE'RE GOING PROSPECTING:

The RoughRiders have nine players in MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30 Prospects rankings to start 2025. Sebastian Walcott (No. 1) headlines the bunch and is the only member of the top 100 as well (No. 17). On the mound, Winston Santos (No. 5), Kohl Drake (No. 13), Mitch Bratt (No. 21) and Josh Stephan (No. 22) all slot into the starting rotation while Skyler Hales (No. 25) will work from the bullpen. On offense, outfielder Alejandro Osuna (No. 8) and first baseman/outfielder Abimelec Ortiz (No. 14) round out the nine players.

FAMILIAR FACES IN FRISCO:

The RoughRiders welcome a remarkable 23 returning players in 2025 and had just two players on the roster (infielder Cam Cauley and catcher lan Moller) that made their Double-A debuts this year.

ABOUT KOHL

-While he was born in Orem, Utah, Drake grew up in Sachse, Texas (25 minutes from Riders Field) and attended Wylie High School. The Wylie Pirates produced NFL players Kyle Fuller, Chris Givens, Kameron Kelly and Nikita Whitlock.

- -Began his collegiate career at Arkansas Tech (2019), spent 2020 at San Joaquin Delta College in Stockton, California and ended with his final two seasons at Walters State Community College in Tennessee. WSCC is the same program which produced Texas LHP Brett Martin.
- -In 2022, he was named NJCAA D1 Pitcher of the Year with WSCC after setting a program record with 160 strikeouts (15.43 K/9) while just walking 17 batters. He went 14-0 with a 1.93 ERA (20 ER/93.1 IP) in 17 starts as a redshirt sophomore.
- -He and teammate Jake Knapp (3rd TM NJCAA All-American) led the pitching staff at WSCC, tying for the national lead with 14 wins. Knapp is now at UNC, but will miss the whole season with Tommy John Surgery.
- -2022 Draft for Rangers as RoughRiders include: RHP Matt Bosky (2023), INF/OF Josh Hatcher (2023, 2024).

2024 SEASON

- -Made first start of the season with Down East on 4/9/24, allowing just four baserunners (3 H, 1 BB) in 4.0 scoreless innings while striking out six.
- -After spot start with Frisco on April 18th, he returned to Down East and pitched eight games for Hickory before coming back to Frisco for an August 25th start.
- -Entering into August 25th, he has a 38 percent strikeout rate. That and his 131 strikeouts are first among Texas Rangers farmhands and his K/BB of 5.04 is fourth in the organization.
- -In home debut with the RoughRiders on August 25th, Drake struck out six over six innings, allowing just two base runners (one hit, one walk), in win.
- -In game two of the 2024 Texas League South Division Series, Drake threw 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and walking one while striking out six against Midland on September 19th.

2023 SEASON

- -Made his professional debut for the ACL Rangers (Rk.) and Down East (A), totaling a 2-5 record, 6.86 ERA (33 ER/46.2 IP), and 55 strikeouts (10.6 SO/9) over 14 G/4 GS.
- -His only scoreless outing of the season came in third appearance (6/22/23 @ A-MRN): 3.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R,0 ER, 1 BB, 5 K.
- -Participated in Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.
