The Century Mark

The Fightin Phils return home and continue a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Hartford Yard Goats, on Saturday night. It is the 17th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season, and 11th-of-12 in Reading. The season-series is tied at eight. It's game number 100 of the season.

Back In the Win Column

A six-run bottom of the eighth inning propelled the Fightin Phils to an 8-2 win over the Yard Goats on Friday night, Reading had solo home runs from Marcus Lee Sang and Caleb Ricketts in the first and third and led 2-1. Hartford then tied it in the top of the seventh on an unearned run to make it 2-2. Reading's offense then put up six runs in the bottom of the eighth. Kendall Simmons gave Reading the leads with a single, then Ethan Wilson put the exclamation point on the game with a three-run homer to left. Cade Fergus also scored a run when he came home on an errant throw after stealing third base. Robinson Pina was strong again, allowing one-earned run on five hits, with four strikeouts over 6.2 innings pitched, in a no-decision.

Leadoff Lee Sans

Marcus Lee Sang set the tone early in Friday night's ballgame as he blasted a leadoff home run in the bottom of the first inning. It marks the first leadoff home run for Reading this season and the first since Lee Sang had a leadoff home run on Sept. 2, 2023, at home against New Hampshire.

Wonderful Wilson

After missing the first two games of the series, Ethan Wilson has been red-hot the last two nights. So far this week, Wilson has four hits, two runs, two doubles, two home runs and four RBI. He's homered in back-to-back games, marking the second time he's homered in consecutive contests this season (6/27-28 vs Bowie). In his career against Hartford (34 games), Wilson is 46-129 (.357), with 29 runs, 19 XBH (11 2B, 1 3B, 7 HR) and 23 RBI.

Bombs Away

The Fightin Phils added three more home runs in last night's ballgame. Reading now has 110 home runs hit this season, which is tied for first in the Eastern League, with Somerset. Since June 1, the Fightin Phils have hit the most home runs in the Eastern League with 68.

100 For Pina

Robinson Pina struck out his 100th batter of the season on Friday night, and currently sits at 102 punchouts on the season. Pina is one-of-six active Eastern League pitchers who have 100-or-more strikeouts this season. He ranks sixth in the league with his 102 strikeouts so far this year.

Reading Debut

Phillies No. 10 Prospect Seth Johnson will make his Fightin Phils debut on Saturday night. Johnson was acquired, along with Moises Chace (who's with Jersey Shore), in exchange for Gregory Soto in a trade with the Baltimore Orioles. Johnson has had a strong season with Double-A Bowie, posting a 2.63 ERA over 18 starts. Saturday won't be the first time Johnson pitches at FirstEnergy Stadium, as he started for the Baysox here on June 27. In that game, Johnson went four-scoreless innings, allowing three hits and striking out four.

Hardware for Castellano

Fightin Phils' pitcher Eiberson Castellano was named the Phillies Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July. Over four appearances in July, Castellano went 2-1, with a 3.66 ERA. He made his final two starts of the month with Reading and will be on the mound on Sunday for the Fightin Phils.

Hey Hartford

Hartford enters tonight after finishing in first place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 38-30 record. They are second in the Northeast Division with a 18-12 record in the second half of the season. Hartford most recently took five-of-six from Harrisburg at home. Following this week, Hartford heads to Richmond. Hartford's roster features 14 players ranked amongst the Colorado Rockies' top-30 prospects: Chase Dollander (1), Adael Amador (2), Yanquiel Fernandez (4), Zac Veen (5), Sterlin Thompson (6), Benny Montgomery (10), Ryan Ritter (12), Sean Sullivan (13), Gabriel Hughes (15), Warming Bernabel (16), Bradley Blalock (20), Mason Albright (22), Jaden Hill (27) and Luis Peralta (30).

Goat on the Bump

Lefty, and Rockies No. 13 Prospect, Sean Sullivan makes his Double-A debut tonight. With High-A Spokane this season, Sullivan was 7-2, with a 2.16 ERA over 14 starts (83.1 IP, 62 H, 8 BB, 101 SO). He made three starts in 2023 in his first pro season between the ACL-Rockies and Single-A Fresno. Colorado drafted Sullivan in the second round of the 2023 draft out of Wake Forest, where he pitched in 2023. He previously pitched for Northwestern in 2022. His fastball averages slightly over 90, and his changeup is his best secondary offering. He fills up the zone, despite unsual mechanics. He had a good mix, making it hard on hitters.
