### On the Road Again

The Fightin Phils are back on the road for their second trip of the season, and first six-game series away from home, this week at the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliation of the New York Yankees. It is the third-of-18 matchups between the teams and third-of-12 at TD Bank Ballpark in Bridgewater, New Jersey. The Fightin Phils fell in the season-series in 2025 to Somerset 11-7, which included a 6-3 record at the Patriots. The season series is tied at one.

### Just Kept on Fightin'

Back-to-back ninth-inning home runs from Jordan Dissin and Bryson Ware lifted the Reading Fightin Phils to an 8-6 win over the Somerset Patriots. Reading jumped out early, scoring two runs in the second on a two-run single from Dissin, then breaking it open in the third when Dylan Campbell launched a grand slam to make it 6-0. Somerset answered with a five-run fourth inning, fueled by a two-run homer from Kennedy Corona, and tied the game in the sixth on an RBI single. The game remained even until the ninth, when Dissin and Ware delivered consecutive home runs to give Reading the lead for good. Lenny Torres Jr. closed it out with a perfect ninth inning to earn the save. Adam Seminaris started for Reading, allowing five unearned runs over four innings with six strikeouts, while Alex McFarlane picked up the win with a scoreless eighth.

### Here Come the Bats

The Fightin Phils offense is beginning to heat up after a quieter start to the season. Over the first eight games of the season, the R-Phils averaged 3.1 runs per game and 25 runs total. They have nearly matched that mark over the last three games, scoring 20 runs, which is good for 6.7 per game.

### The Italian Stallion

Dante Nori continued his red-hot start to the 2026 season on Tuesday and Wednesday night, connecting on his second triple of the season in the series opener and another hit on Wednesday night. Nori is riding a nine-game hitting streak, dating back to Apr. 3, and is slashing .317/.333/.537 (.870 OPS), with two doubles, two triples, one home run and four RBI over the streak. His nine-game hit streak is currently tied for the longest active streak in the Eastern League and is also the longest hit streak in the league so far this season.

### Horns Up

Former Texas Longhorn Dylan Campbell has now launched a home run in three-straight games following his grand slam on Wednesday night. The grand slam for Campbell marked the first of his career and it is also the first time in his professional career that Campbell has homered in three-straight contests. Campbell is the first Fightin Phil to hit a grand slam in a game since Nick Dunn on Sept. 12, 2025, also against Somerset and in total, Reading hit four grand slams during the 2025 season.

### Going Going Gone

The Fightin Phils offense continues to produce home runs as of late, after Dylan Campbell, Jordan Dissin and Bryson Ware and launched homers in Wednesday night's game. After not hitting a home run in the season-opening series at Akron, Reading has launched 15 home runs across its last eight games. The Fightin Phils 15 home runs rank as tied for the most in the Eastern League so far and they are most in the league since April 7, but a four home run margin over second place Harrisburg, who has 11. No other teams have more than nine home runs since Apr. 7.

### Pitching Powers

The Fightin Phils pitching staff turned in a banner week against Hartford, posting an Eastern League-best 2.13 ERA (13 ER, 55.0 IP) over the six games. Through 10 games, Reading is second in the league in ERA at 3.66 (39 ER, 96.0 IP). This came after the Fightin Phils finished last in the league in ERA in 2025 and '24, and finished 11th in 2023.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

April 16, 2018: At Harrisburg, Ranger Suarez picks up his first Double-A victory as the Fightin Phils blank the Senators, 6-0. Suarez allows 6 hits and strikes out 10 over 8.0 innings and does not issue a walk. Zach Coppola goes 3-for-5 with 2 runs and a stolen base while Kyle Martin connects for a grand slam in the 5th inning.

### 'Sup Somerset

Somerset enters tonight with a 4-6 record, which is fifth in the Northeast Division. The Patriots dropped four-of-six games at Binghamton last week and hit the road against next week to face Richmond. Somerset finished 2025 with a 73-65 record and made the postseason after finishing second to Binghamton in the second half. Somerset's roster has nine of the Yankees' top-30 prospects (MLB Pipeline): Geroge Lombard Jr. (1), Ben Hess (5), Chase Hampton (8), Kyle Carr (11), Brock Selvidge (15), Cade Smith (16), Jace Avina (19), Xavier Rivas (23) and Eric Reyselman (28).

### Patriots' Pitcher

Righty, and Yankees' No. 16 prospect, Cade Smith makes the start tonight for Somerset. He made his season debut last Thursday at Binghamton and allowed two runs on two hits over 4.1 innings, with five strikeouts. Smith was limited to 11 starts last season between the FCL-Yankees (ROK), Tampa (A) and Hudson Valley (A+), combining to go 2-1, with a 2.50 ERA, along with 42 strikeouts over 39.2 innings pitched. Smith began his pro career in 2024 between Tampa and Hudson Valley. The Yankees drafted the 24-year old in the sixth round of the 2023 draft out of Mississippi State. Smith pitched for Mississippi State from 2021-23, prior to being drafted by New York.
