### Today's Game: Salt Lake looks to split their fourth straight series, closing out a six-game set in the Sooner State against the Oklahoma City Comets on Sunday afternoon.

**About Last Night:** Salt Lake jumped out early as Nelson Rada lined his second triple of the season down the left-field line before coming around to score on an RBI single from Denzer Guzman. Oklahoma City answered in the third after stringing together four straight baserunners with two outs, capped by a game-tying RBI single from Jack Suwinski. Making his first appearance at the Triple-A level, Alberto Rios delivered the go-ahead knock in the fifth with an RBI triple notching his first career Triple-A hit that scored Jose Siri and gave the Bees a 2-1 edge. OKC responded with a four-run 7th inning, highlighted by Suwinski's two-run homer — his 29th RBI of the season and seventh hit of the series. The Comets added two more runs in the frame on a wild pitch and sacrifice fly to take control. Oklahoma City tacked on another insurance run in the eighth and held off Salt Lake for a 7-4 win in game five of the series.

**Today's Pitcher:** Sam Aldegheri is set to make his sixth start of the season on Sunday, tying Brett Kerry for the most starts on the Salt Lake staff. The left-hander returns to the mound for the first time since April 28 against Sacramento after making a start for the Los Angeles Angels on May 5 versus the Chicago White Sox. In his last outing with the Bees, Aldegheri turned in a Triple-A career-high six innings against Sacramento, holding the River Cats scoreless on three hits through the first four frames before allowing five runs over his final two innings. Aldegheri has surrendered four or more runs in four of his five starts this season, with the lone exception coming in his strongest outing of the year — five scoreless innings at Las Vegas. Sunday will mark his first career appearance against Oklahoma City and the fifth different Pacific Coast League opponent he has faced.

**Split it:** Salt Lake will look to secure its fourth consecutive series split on Sunday as the Bees enter the finale with an 0-2-4 series record this season while going 2-4 in series finales, including 1-2 on the road....Offensively on Sundays, Salt Lake ranks eighth in the Pacific Coast League with a .235 batting average while averaging 4.5 runs per game, good for seventh in the league. The Bees are also tied for third in the PCL with seven home runs on Sundays this season. On the mound, Salt Lake owns a 6.11 ERA on Sundays, ranking seventh in the league, while its 29 walks allowed are the third most in the PCL. The Bees have also surrendered a league-high 66 hits on Sundays....Salt Lake went 8-17 in Sunday contests during the 2025 season and dropped both series finales against Oklahoma City last year, falling 8-7 in South Jordan and 12-10 in Bricktown.

**Limit the Damage:** The Bees have allowed opposing offenses to record at least one three-run frame in each of the last eight games, dating back to Apr. 30 vs. Sacramento. Salt Lake gave up four runs in the seventh on Saturday night proving to be the dagger in game five. Salt Lake pitching posts the second-highest ERA in the league in the seventh inning or later at 6.34 with Oklahoma City having the highest at 6.39.

**First and Foremost:** Salt Lake has found success early in the series, scoring a run, recording multiple hits while having an extra-base hit in the first inning of three of the five games against Oklahoma City this week. Since the start of May, the Bees are tied for the second-most first inning runs scored in the Pacific Coast League while their four extra-base hits in the opening frame are also the second most in the league. Denzer Guzman has been a key catalyst at the top of games, recording three first-inning hits in May, tied for the most in the PCL, including two during the current series against Oklahoma City.

**Early and Often:** When coming to the plate in the first four innings, Nick Madrigal is batting .356 (16x45) with six extra base hits, four RBI, six walks and three strikeouts along with a .964 OPS. When batting in the fifth inning or later, Madrigal is hitting just .190 (11x58), going without an extra base hit, 12 RBI, seven walks and three punchouts to go with a .451 OPS.... Similarly, Denzer Guzman (11 hits in the 1st inn.) is one of five PCL hitters to have at least 10 hits in the first inning while batting .393 in the opening frame.

**Two-Hit Nick:** Nick Madrigal pushed his hit streak to eight games while reaching base for the 11th consecutive contest on Friday. It is the second longest in his career at the Triple-A level, trailing a nine-gamer between August 18-27, 2019 with Triple-A Charlotte. Madrigal holds a pair of double-digit hit streaks in his career, both coming at Double-A Birmingham when he accomplished 10 in a row (July 18-27, 2019) and 16 straight games with a hit (June 22-July 12, 2019). Madrigal has five two-hit performances during his current eight-game hit streak, including Friday night's 2-for-2 ledger in which he reached in all three plate appearances. He is hitting .371 (13x35) with seven RBI and six runs scored with an .868 OPS over his eight game stretch.

**Hump the Hero:** Zach Humphreys now has three straight games with at least one hit. It is his longest stretch, since a career-high nine game hit streak set last season between July 25-August 23, 2025 with Salt Lake. Humphreys set a new career-high with four total hits on Friday, joining Denzer Guzman and Jose Siri as three Bees with a four-hit game this season. Humphreys had the go-ahead two-run double in the 10th inning adding his sixth AAA game with three RBI.

**Trey Day:** Trey Mancini has hit safely in 10 straight Sunday games dating back to May 11, 2025...he is batting .429 (6x14) in four Sunday games this season while coming off last Sunday playing the hero with a walkoff sacrifice fly against Sacramento. During his 10-game Sunday hitting streak, Mancini is hitting .436 with five RBI, a homer and five doubles with a 1.130 OPS. Across his entire Triple-A career, Mancini is batting .328 on Sunday's highlighted by 12 doubles — his highest total on any day of the week.

#### Overview

Sam Aldegheri begins his third season in the Los Angeles Angels organization since being traded from the Philadelphia Phillies. The first Italian born and developed player to appear in the major leagues, Aldegheri ranks 17th in the Angels Top 30 Prospects (MLB Pipeline). The southpaw has made seven big league outings following his debut in 2024 but has spent most of his career at Double-A Rocket City (27 appearances, 27 starts). Aldegheri earned the opportunity to play on the international stage, pitching in the 2026 World Baseball Classic.

#### In the Majors

- Aldegheri has seen action for the Halos in two seasons, debuting on August 30, 2024.
- The lefty pitched five innings in his first outing but was dealt the loss. He would earn his first MLB win in his next start, tossing six frames of one-run ball in a 5-1 road victory over the Texas Rangers on September 6.

#### 2025 Season

- The southpaw made 24 minor league appearances, with all but one of those coming at the Double-A level.
- Aldegheri logged 128.1 innings of work for the Trash Pandas, while making a single five-inning home start for Triple-A Salt Lake on September 11.
- The Italian also appeared in four MLB games, making his season debut at Fenway Park on June 4 in a save opportunity. Aldegheri tallied 13.2 innings for the Angels across his second big league campaign.

#### WBC

- Aldegheri earned his first international start for Team Italy in the 2026 World Baseball Classic, taking the bump against Brazil on March 7. He tossed 4.2 scoreless innings, walked two and punched out eight in the Azzuri's 8-0 win in Pool Play.
- Aldegheri earned the starting nod in Italy's first knockout game against Puerto Rico. Despite recording only four outs, the southpaw picked up the victory to help his country advance to their first ever WBC semifinal appearance.
- In total, Aldegheri tossed six innings, allowed two runs, walked three and got nine strikeouts.

#### 2026 Season

- Has made five starts for Triple-A Salt Lake and two outing with the Angels
- Tossed at least 4 IP in all four of his appearances...
- Has 5+ Ks in three consecutive starts
- Earned first win of campaign in his first outing with the Halos....tossing 1.2 innings in relief at Yankee Stadium in an 11-4 victory, struck out two in that outing
- Earned first career Triple-A win on season-high 7 strikeouts in Las Vegas on 4/22

## Overview

Chris Taylor enters his first full season in the Los Angeles Angels organization after signing a minor league contract on Feb. 12, 2026, following the conclusion of the 2025 season. Taylor previously spent the majority of his career with the Los Angeles Dodgers, where he became part of several memorable moments at Dodger Stadium, including a ninth-inning walk-off home run in 2021 against the St. Louis Cardinals that sent the Dodgers to the National League Division Series. A native of Virginia Beach, Virginia, Taylor began his Major League career with the Seattle Mariners before being traded to the Dodgers during the 2016 season.

- Taylor made his Major League debut on July 24, 2014, starting at shortstop for the Seattle Mariners against the Baltimore Orioles after being called up from Triple-A Tacoma, where he was hitting .328

## Overview

Donovan Walton has signed a Minor League contract, joining his fourth organization after stints with the Mariners, Giants, and Phillies. Walton played college baseball at Oklahoma State University and was drafted in the fifth round of the 2016 MLB Draft by the Milwaukee Brewers. Walton returns to the PCL for the first time since 2024 after spending time with Sacramento and having previously played in Tacoma (2021-22), where he earned PCL Player of the Week honors on August 15, 2021. Walton's three-hit performance on Opening Night against the Las Vegas Aviators marked the most by a Salt Lake Bees player since 2019. The Texan went a perfect 3-for-3 with a home run and an RBI.

- His managerial career began in 1996, when Davis was named manager of the Pittsfield Mets, before being promoted to manage the Double-A Binghamton Mets in 1999.
- As a player, Davis was a catcher and infielder and was selected by the California Angels in the ninth round of the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons across the Angels, Texas Rangers, and Kansas City Royals organizations, appearing in seven Major League games—six with the Angels in 1988 and one with the Rangers in 1992.
