LAST DAY OF MAY: After dropping two out of the first three games in Kinston, the FredNats will look to even the series as the second half this six-game set begins in Down East. Jarlin Susana starts tonight, and he looks to bounce back from back-to-back rough starts for FXBG. Heading into play today, Fredericksburg is now in second place in the division behind Carolina, with the Wood Ducks nipping at the heels as well. Six of FXBG's final 18 games in the half are against the Wood Ducks, as DE returns to Fredericksburg for the final three games of the half as well. Down East does not have a video broadcast, so the only live broadcast of this week's series is on the radio on the FredNats Baseball Network. This is FXBG's last scheduled trip to Historic Grainger Stadium before it closes after this year and DE moves to Spartanburg, S.C.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats scored first against Down East, but crucially left five men on base in the first two innings, and eventually that came back to bite FXBG in a 6-3 loss to the Wood Ducks. Nate Ochoa continued to swing the bat well recently, smoking a two-run double off the left field wall in the 6th inning, but three runs for Down East off Samuel Vasquez in the 5th inning ultimately did the FredNats in. Travis Sykora pitched well, setting down 12 straight hitters at one point and striking out a career-high seven in his fifth professional start.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 20-3 this season when scoring first, including 17 out of the last 18 wins. Fredericksburg's only two losses this year when scoring first both came in the last road trip against Charleston. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses last week to the Hillcats, in fact, Lynchburg scored first in five out of the six games in the series.

SLOW STARTS RECENTLY: After dropping just its third game all season when scoring first yesterday, the FredNats have been consistently playing from behind in this recent stretch that has seen FXBG go 6-11 in its last 17 games. The FredNats have only scored first in three out of the last 13 games including last night's loss when they did score first. FXBG starting pitching has an ERA of over seven in May after putting up a 4.57 ERA in April when the team went 15-7. Heading into tonight's May finale, the team is 13-13 this month.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. So far this season, the bullpen has pitched 254 innings this year and allowed just 74 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.62. The Freddie's are also 13/14 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is first in the Carolina League and T-4th in MiLB with eight saves. Fredericksburg remains undefeated when leading after 7 (22-0), and 8 (23-0) innings after taking the lead in the 6th Wednesday night and winning the game in 10 innings.

NO GRAY MAY: Roismar Quintana's emergence in the middle of this Fredericksburg order has been a huge key to success for FXBG in this month of May. In addition to coming up with the game-winning RBIs in last night's 10-inning victory, this month, Quintana is slashing .293/.354/.493 for an OPS of .847, and his wRC+ is 143 (100 is average). Quintana's wOBA, which is a key advanced metric that measures how a hitter reaches base and the impact it has on scoring runs, is .396 this month (.320 is average).

RBI KING: Brandon Pimentel continues to be second in all of Minor League Baseball Double-A and below in RBI with 46 after he drove in three more runs last series. This year, Pimentel is hitting .411 with runners in scoring position, and is 10-for-20 (.500) with runners in scoring position and two outs. Pimentel continues to be one of the best situational hitters in all of MiLB.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 169-139 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with ZSP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

TONIGHT'S START: Jarlin Susana is set to make his ninth start of 2024, after getting the nod on Opening Night. The big righty features a heater that routinely exceeds triple digits, to go along with a sinker, a tight slider, plus a curveball and a changeup.

EARLY-SEASON HIGHS: After an up-and-down April last year, Susana really hit his stride going into May. From his start on 5/3 vs Down East, Jarlin was flat out dominant. Over his next eight starts, Susana worked to a 2.35 ERA across 30.2 IP, with opponents hitting a measly .167 against him.

LATE-SEASON LULL: Unfortunately, Susana faltered as the season went on. After the aforementioned eight-start stretch, Jarlin made just four more starts the rest of the season. He struggled with his command, walking 15 batters in 22.2 IP, with an ERA north of 9.00. Susana made his final start of the year on 8/5 against Salem before being placed on the Development List to end his season.

LAST TIME OUT: Susana had a rough outing last week against the Lynchburg Hillcats. The dynamic righty gave up six base hits and six earned run across four frames, and also walked five Hillcats.
