Last Time Out...Bryson Ware gave the BlueClaws the lead with a three run triple in the top of the third inning and Jersey Shore went on to top Wilmington 5-4 on Wednesday night at Frawley Stadium...Keaton Anthony and Luis Caicuto each had two hits for the BlueClaws...Wen-Hui Pan threw two scoreless innings of relief while Paxton Thompson threw a 1-2-3 ninth inning to earn his first Jersey Shore save.

State of the BlueClaws...The BlueClaws have won two straight games, the first two games in Wilmington, after an eight-game losing streak (one off the club record)...The BlueClaws are now 15-5 against Wilmington this season.

**Playoff Picture...**The BlueClaws are in fourth place, 3.0 games behind Greensboro, but with the Grasshoppers having won the first half, and thus already in the postseason, the BlueClaws are only 2.5 games behind Hudson Valley for the final postseason spot....There are 28 games left...Last year, the BlueClaws trailed by six games on August 3<sup>rd</sup> and rallied to make the postseason on the final day.

Paxton Locks It Down...RHP Paxton Thompson threw a 1-2-3 ninth inning on Wednesday to earn his first High-A save...He has thrown 11 innings and allowed just one unearned run with Jersey Shore since arriving on July 2nd...He joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater where he 1-2 with a 3.62 ERA in 19 appearances...He struck out 30 and walked nine in 27.1 innings with the Threshers...Thompson signed with the Phillies last year from UNC-Charlotte where he helped them reach the NCAA Tournament last year and he threw three scoreless innings in the Regionals to eliminate #3 Clemson.

From the Plains to the Shore...Bryson Ware, the Phillies 8<sup>th</sup> round pick last year from Auburn, hit a three-run triple to give Jersey Shore the lead in their Wednesday win at Wilmington in what was his first BlueClaws hit...Ware joined Tuesday from Clearwater, where he was hitting .201 with nine home runs and 41 RBIs with 33 walks in 308 plate appearances...Ware has started games for Clearwater and 18 .28 .38 .St .1 c. and CF.

Pan in Charge...Wen-Hui Pan threw two scoreless innings with four strikeouts on Wednesday at Wilmington...Since re-joining the BlueClaws, he has allowed just one earned run in 10 innings with 10 strikeouts and four walks...Pan finished last year with Jersey Shore and opened this year on the 60-day IL...He is a 21 year old from Taiwan and the #13 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline.

Keaton Mashing...Keaton Anthony had two hits on both Tuesday and Wednesday, including his first BlueClaws home run on Tuesday...Anthony had four home runs with Clearwater earlier this year...The former lowa Hawkeye is now 36-103 (.355) with the BlueClaws adding 12 multi-hit games...He had a walk-off single on July 23<sup>rd</sup> against Aberdeen...He was hitting .322 in 44 games with Clearwater, adding four home runs and 21 RBIs, and drew 28 walks in 186 plate appearances while striking out only 28 times...He signed as an NDFA from the University of lowa in 2023 after three years with the Hawkeyes.

Home & Away...The BlueClaws are 34-20 at home and 22-28 on the road this year...At home, they have a .700 OPS vs .705 on the road, and are averaging 4.8 runs per game (271 runs in 54 games) against 5.3 runs per game on the road (267 runs in 50 games)...However, their team ERA is 3.67 at home (1.24 WHIP) compared to 4.69 on the road with a 1.37 WHIP.

Three for Aidam...Aidan Miller had three hits and scored three runs in the win on Tuesday...lt was his first three-hit game with the BlueClaws...The 20 year old was the Phillies first-round pick last year...He has two home runs with Jersey Shore – one on June 16<sup>th</sup> (Father's Day) and one on July 4<sup>th</sup>...Miller hit leadoff on Tuesday, the third time he has hit leadoff since joining the BlueClaws.

Zach Attack...Zach Arnold is now 28-80 since July 1<sup>st</sup> with five multi-hit games, 12 RBIs and six walks (he hit .163 in June and .237 in May)...He also has two stolen bases since July 26<sup>th</sup> after having just one leading into that game...Arnold was a 14<sup>th</sup> round pick last year from the University of Houston.

**The NEWClaws...** The BlueClaws roster entering today has just 11 players that have been with the team since Opening Day: Ps Jack Dallas, Braeden Fausnaught, Charles King, Gunner Mayer, and Danny Wilkinson, C Jordan Dissin, IFs Zach Arnold and Felix Reyes, and OFs Emaarion Boyd, Hendry Mendez, and Troy Schreffler.

Troy Going Deep...Troy Schreffler hit two home runs last week in Hudson Valley, giving him six on the season, and he added a two run single on Sunday...He is 6-18 with two home runs and two doubles since July 28<sup>th</sup>...A Harrisburg native, Schreffler played collegiately at the University of Maryland and was a 15<sup>th</sup> round pick in the Jo202 draft.

Welcome, Moisés...Moisés Chace made his organizational debut on Saturday, allowing three runs in 3.2 innings...He threw three scoreless innings before allowing three runs in the fourth...Chace, who was with Aberdeen, has been acquired by the Phillies and assigned to Jersey Shore...Chace was in the deal that sent LHP Gregory Soto to the Orioles and came over with RHP Seth Johnson (now with Reading)...Chace, a 21 year old from Venezuela, was 2-2, 3.46 with Aberdeen, striking out 76 batters in 52 innings...He faced the BlueClaws in his last appearance, allowing one run in three innings with seven strikeouts on Thursday at ShoreTown Ballpark.

Walk-Off, Wrong Way...The BlueClaws have lost two games in walk-off fashion since the break (July 19<sup>th</sup> at Brooklyn and July 31<sup>st</sup> at Hudson Valley), and five on the year...On Wednesday, they led by five and gave up five in the ninth, then lost in the 10<sup>th</sup> inning...The BlueClaws do have one walk-off win after the break – July 23<sup>th</sup> vs Aerdeen on a Keaton Anthony RBI single in the 9<sup>th</sup>.

Viars Joins the BlueClaws...Jordan Viars, a 3<sup>rd</sup> round pick in the 2021 draft (Reedy HS, Frisco, TX), joined the BlueClaws last week (6-37 so far)...He had an RBI single on July 20<sup>th</sup> and a hit and two runs scored on Julyl 24<sup>th</sup>...Viars was hitting .252 with Clearwater, adding 12 home runs and 39 RBIs at the time of his promotion...He had a three home run and nine RBI game on 5/30 vs Lakeland.... At the time of his promotion, he was tied for third in the FSL with 12 home runs, first in slugging percentage (.491), and second in OPS (.846)...He turned 21 years old on Thursday, July 18<sup>th</sup>.

Going Going Gone...The BlueClaws (30 HRs in Lakewood and 34 on the road) have two this week from Trov Schreffler (6 on the season)...They got a home run from Felix Reyes, his 6<sup>th</sup>, on July 31<sup>st</sup> (five have come since June 16th)... They hit four home runs on July 6th against Wilmington - one each from Emaarion Boyd, Justin Crawford, Hendry Mendez, and Leandro Pineda... Aidan Miller hit a leadoff home run in the game on July 4th...Jordan Dissin leads the team with nine and Leandro Pineda (now with Reading) has eight.

Hitting Triple Digits...A South Atlantic League starting pitcher has thrown 100 pitches seven times in a game this season - all seven are BlueClaws...Sam Aldegheri has done it three times (including 103 on June 13th), Jean Cabrera has done it three times (including a league-high 110 on Wednesday at Brooklyn), and Braeden Fausnaught has done it once...Cabrera's 110 pitches are the most by a BlueClaw since Nick Fanti threw 113 in two no-hitters in 2017 (7/17 vs CHA, 26 outs in a 5/6/17 no-hitter at COL), not incluing Matt Russell, who threw 125 pitches in eight innings against ABD in 2022 but pitched three innings in April and the remaining five in June after the game was suspended.

Save Index...Daniel Harper (now with Reading) leads the BlueClaws with seven saves and earned his seventh on June 19th at Brooklyn...Andrew Walling (now with Reading)

earned his sixth save of the year in the win on July 14th... Gunner Mayer has four while Charles King has two.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have three walk-off wins this year - July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5<sup>th</sup> against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3<sup>rd</sup>, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

The Comeback Claws...The BlueClaws got a two-out, two-strike hit from Keaton Anthony and a two-strike RBI double from Felix Reyes on July 21st at Brooklyn to tie the game, that they would win 9-6 in 10 innings...Jersey Shore erased a 5-0 deficit on June 8th at Greensboro and a 4-0 deficit on June  $15^{\text{th}}$  to come back and beat Wilmington...On June 15th, Troy Schreffler doubled home two runs to tie the game and Justin Crawford gave the BlueClaws the lead with a line drive RBI single to centerfield...Their largest comeback win last year was six (5/24/23 at Aberdeen in a game they trailed 8-2 and won 12-10).

Just Grand...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they have three grand slams since May 30th - one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by

Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...Boyd's home run was the second of his career while Dissin's was his sixth home run of the season.

Trying For Back to Back...The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once - in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws had five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and

In the First Round...Aidan Miller is the 16th former first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fifth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team...(his ex-teammate Justin Crawford in 2024, Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester



From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9th through July 6th, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017...Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team.

Season Notes: Set a career high with 6.1 IP, allowing three runs/two earned in 7/27 win vs ABD...Struck out eight over five innings (two runs) on 7/20 at BRK, earning win...Threw five scoreless innings on 7/10 vs HV to earn first win...Gave up one run in four innings on 6/18 at BRK...Threw four scoreless with six strikeouts on 6/11 vs WIL...Threw three scoreless innings in '24 BlueClaws debut on 6/4 at GBO...Joined the BlueClaws on 6/1 from Reading, where he was 1-1, 6.62 in 17.2 innings over 14 appearances, all in relief.

Career Notes: Spent his first season in the organization with the BlueClaws, going 3-4, 3.38 over 16 games and 10 starts...Struck out 54 batters and walked just 14 over 42.2 innings pitched...Threw five no-hit innings in two starts – 8/17 vs ASH (9 Ks) and 8/31 vs ABD (10 Ks)...Pitched in the 2023 Arizona Fall League...Pitched for Adelaide in the ABL, helping them win the 2023 league title...Pitched for Team Australia in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.
