NOTES AND NUGGETS

LET'S PLAY 2!

After last night's game was postponed, the Storm Chasers and Mud Hens will play a traditional doubleheader today beginning at 3:05 p.m. CT.

Since 2011, Omaha is 68-66 in doubleheaders ... in the Storm Chasers era, Omaha has played 65 doubleheaders, with 38 splits ... the Chasers have swept 15 doubleheaders, but also been swept 14 times.

Today will mark Omaha's 4th doubleheader vs. Toledo and the Storm Chasers are 5-1 in these games ... on June 14, 2024 at Fifth Third Field, Omaha swept the doubleheader, with a 5-2 win in Game 1 and a 6-2 win (8 innings) in Game 2 ... Omaha combined for 11 runs and 20 hits in these two games ... the Storm Chasers also swept a doubleheader on July 6, 2022 vs. Toledo and split a doubleheader on September 1, 2021 vs. Toledo.

Last year, Omaha played 7 doubleheaders, the most the Chasers had played in a season since 2017, when they played 8 ... in 2024, Omaha split 3 doubleheaders (4/4 @ Columbus, 5/1 @ Iowa and 8/30 vs. St. Paul), swept two doubleheaders (4/30 @ Indianapolis & 6/14 @ Toledo) and Omaha was swept twice (6/28 @ Columbus and 9/5 @ Memphis).

WHAT A RELIEF!

Relievers stepped up lately for Omaha, including 3 bullpen games last week.

Since last Wednesday, relief innings accounted for 45.1 of Omaha's 65.1 innings, approximately 69% of the team's total innings.

20.0 innings from Omaha's starting pitchers across the last 7 games are the fewest of any MLB team in the last week (since April 16).

When accounting for the 2 relief pitchers that "opened" games last week, Omaha's bullpen arms got 106 of the team's 135 outs last week (79%).

LEAN WITH IT, WALK WITH IT

Omaha's 105 walks are 5th in the International League league.

Through 22 games, the Chasers are averaging 4.77 walks per game, and are on pace to draw 711 walks ... the franchise record is 671 walks drawn in the 2023 season and they have drawn more than 600 walks just twice.

Nick Loftin is responsible for nearly 1/4 of Omaha's walks ... the 26 walks Loftin has drawn are tied for the most of any Minor League hitter.

DUSTIN TIME

After joining the Storm Chasers last week and starting off slow, infielder **Dustin Dickerson** has heated up in his first three games at Fifth Third Field.

Dickerson began his Omaha career 0-for-8 with 3 walks ... since the 7th inning on Tuesday when he recorded his first Triple-A hit, Dustin is 8-for-11 with 4 RBI, a walk and sacrifice fly.

In 6 games with Omaha, he is slashing .421/.500/.474 (8-for-19) with 4 RBI and 4 walks with only 4 strikeouts ... his 16.7% strikeout rate is the 2nd-lowest among 14 Storm Chasers hitters with at least 20 plate appearances this year.

Prior to his promotion to Triple-A, Dickerson has played just 7 games at the Double-A level ... he began his pro career in the Arizona Complex League in 2023, then played 132 games in High-A before getting moved up to Double-A this year.

SACRIFICIAL LOVE

Omaha leads the International League in sacrifices (6) and ranks near the top in sacrifice flies (10) as well.

The Chasers led the IL in sacrifice bunts last year, with 38 ... the 6 sacrifice bunt this year are tied for the International League lead ... Omaha is tied 2nd in Triple-A in sacrifice bunts and tied 4th in Minor League Baseball.

Harold Castro's 3 sac bunts this year are tied for the league lead and tied 2nd in the Minors.

10 sac flies are tied 3rd in the International League, with Jacksonville (MIA) and Lehigh Valley (PHI) tied for the league lead with 11.

WELCOME HOME WIEMER

Storm Chasers outfielder **Joey Wiemer** returns to Toledo this week to play in his hometown for just the second time in his professional career.

Born in Sylvania, Ohio (20 minutes Northwest of Toledo), Wiemer attended Bedford Senior High School in Temperance, Michigan (20 minutes North of Toledo) ... he also played four years of football and two years of basketball at Bedford, was named all-state, all-region and all-district in baseball.

The only other time Wiemer has played in Toledo as a professional was at the start of last season ... in 2024, the Nashville Sounds opened their season at Fifth Third Field from March 29 to 31, but Wiemer collected just one hit that weekend.

NOAH CAMERON SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline

Scouting grades: Fastball: 50 | Curveball: 55 | Changeup: 60 | Cutter: 50 | Control: 55 | Overall: 50

Somewhat of a local product from nearby St. Joseph, Mo., Cameron was selected by his favorite team in the seventh round of the 2021 Draft out of Central Arkansas. He had undergone Tommy John surgery that year, so his pro debut was delayed until 2022. The lefty has had a steady progression through the Minors since, and 2024 was his best year yet, when he put together a 3.08 ERA across 25 starts (128 2/3 innings) between Double-A and Triple-A. His run in Triple-A nearly had him in the big leagues by year's end, with a 2.32 ERA in nine starts, a 1.01 WHIP and 62 strikeouts to just 11 walks in 54 1/3 innings.

What stands out about Cameron is his command. He's a strikethrower, and he doesn't walk batters: He had just a 6.7% walk rate in the Minors in '24. There was an uptick in his fastball, averaging 92 mph but with flashes of the mid-to-upper 90s. Although it can be susceptible to hard contact at times, it also grades better because of its command and how well it plays with his other pitches. Cameron's bread and butter pitch is his plus changeup, a low-80s offering that tumbles and misses a ton of bats. He mixes in a plus upper-70s curveball that has a tight break and tunnels well with his fastball. He also brought back an upper-80s cutter, an effective pitch that helps his fastball play better by adding another dimension for the hitter to think about. Cameron is beginning to tinker with a slider too, potentially giving him a fourth pitch. With a clean over-the-top delivery, Cameron understands how to use his pitches -- and how they play off each other -- to keep hitters off balance.

Cameron's mix, in addition to his command and makeup give him a starter's projection, and now he's on the cusp of Kansas City as one. The Royals added him to the 40-man roster last November and see him as a future part of their rotation. Cameron will likely return to Triple-A aiming for more sustained success with his debut coming at some point this year.

Baseball America

Scouting Grades: Fastball: 50 | Curveball: 55 | Changeup: 60 | Cutter: 50 | Control: 55

Track Record: Cameron continues to defy projections that say he doesn't have enough power on his fastball to consistently retire more advanced hitters. He has maintained his advance through the Royals' system without hitting that imaginary wall. The Missouri native, who missed his junior season at Central Arkansas to Tommy John surgery, has performed consistently well at every level since first getting into minor league games in 2022, one year after being drafted in the seventh round. His nine starts at Triple-A Omaha to end 2024 represents the best run of his career, with a 2.32 ERA and 62 strikeouts to just 11 walks in 54.1 innings.

Scouting Report: A finesse lefthander with a sneaky four-seam fastball averaging 92 mph, Cameron excels because of the deceptive life on the pitch and its good vertical carry, helping to compensate for lower velocity. He added an extra tick of zip in 2024 and now touches 96 mph, and he may still have more in the tank. Cameron's best secondary pitch is a plus low-80s changeup with good vertical separation off his fastball. It's a deceptive pitch with big tumble, depth and command. Cameron has good feel for an above-average 78-83 mph curveball with 11-to-5 shape and tight break that he throws for strikes and tunnels well with the fastball. His fourth pitch is an 88-91 mph cutter with average horizontal movement. Cameron gets swings and misses from both his changeup and curve, and he's a savvy hurler who mixes his pitches well. His arm action and repeatable over-the-top delivery work well.

The Future: Cameron's next big test will be to see if he can repeat the success he had in Triple-A, leading to a determination on if he's got enough stuff to face big league hitters. The Royals added him to the 40-man roster in November, and he could make his MLB debut in 2025.
