NEWS & NOTES

DOING THE DOUBLE: The Renegades will play in their first doubleheader of the season this Sunday against the Cyclones. It's one of two doubleheaders scheduled between these two teams, the other scheduled for May 21st in Brooklyn.

CATCHING FIRE: The Renegades have won five in a row, their longest winning streak of the season. Over the streak, Hudson Valley has outscored its opponents 32-18.

LONG TIME, NO SEE: The Hudson Valley Renegades welcome the Brooklyn Cyclones to Heritage Financial Park this week for their second meeting of the season. The teams first met in Brooklyn for a three-game series to open up 2026. The 'Gades took the first two games from Brooklyn, and the third game got rained out (will be made up as part of a double-header on May 21). This is the first of two times the Cyclones will come to the Hudson Valley.

CARDIAC 'GADES: The Renegades came from behind in three of their last four, and they won the first two games against Brooklyn in the final inning. Last Sunday, the 'Gades trailed the Frederick Keys 5-2 in the top of the ninth inning, and then they scored three in the frame to push the game to extras. The 'Gades then scored two in the 10th to secure the first extra-innings win for the 'Gades, and the first comeback victory as well. Hudson Valley then booked its first walk-off of the season on Monday night, courtesy of **INF Kaeden Kent**. Trailing by two in the bottom of the ninth, Kent hit a three-run walk-off home run, the first of its kind this season. Last night, the 'Gades got their second walk-off home run in as many games. This time, it was **INF Kyle West** who blasted a ball to straight-away center on the first pitch of the inning. It was a 3-3 tie when West stepped up to the plate, and history when he crossed it. It's the first time in the Portal Era (2005-2026) that the 'Gades have had back-to-back walk-off home runs.

BULLPEN BEAUTIES: The Renegades bullpen is coming off a very strong 6-game series at Frederick. 'Gades relievers allowed only 6 ER across the series, and they kept a clean sheet in three of the six games. Three Renegades relievers came away with 3 wins across the series. The bullpen picked up right where it left off in Frederick, allowing one hit and one earned run in Game 1 against Brooklyn (4.0 IP) and zero hits and zero runs in Game 3 (4.2 IP).

FIXIN' AT HERITAGE FINANCIAL: The Renegades opened up their 2026 home slate with a six-game series against the Wilmington Blue Rocks, High-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The 'Gades lost five of six games to the Blue Rocks, making it the first time Hudson Valley has lost five games in a six-game home series since August 2023 when it lost five of six to Jersey Shore. However, the 'Gades have won each of their last four home games against Brooklyn, improving their home record to 5-5. Last season, the Renegades were 44-21 at Heritage Financial Park, the best home record in the South Atlantic League, and the second-best home record in High-A baseball. The Renegades trailed only the West Michigan Whitecaps (DET, A+) in the category.

ROAD SUCCESS: The Hudson Valley Renegades are 6-2 on the road this season, thanks to some strong pitching. The 'Gades are hitting the same AVG at home and on the road (.229), but the pitching staff is allowing 1.04 fewer earned runs on the road compared to at home.

BEST IN THE BIZ: RHP Luis Serna was named the South Atlantic League pitcher of the week for his nearly flawless performance against Wilmington on 4/9. Serna dealt a career-high 7.0 innings, and tied a career-high 10 strikeouts in his first start in High-A. He allowed one hit and zero runs, leading the Renegades to their first shutout of the 2026 season.

MAMA SAID SHUT YOU OUT: Since the start of the 2018 season, the Renegades have thrown 95 shutouts in 797 games (8.39 games per shutout), by far the most of any team in Minor League Baseball. The second-place team, Montgomery (TB, AA), has thrown 86 shutouts in 939 games (10.92 games per shutout). The only other active MiLB team with fewer than 800 games played from 2018-24 with more than 60 shutouts thrown is Brooklyn (NYM, A+), with 64 in 794 games (12.41 games per shutout). The Renegades have one shutout this season, thanks to RHP Luis Serna who dealt 7.0 scoreless innings against Wilmington on 4/9.

BATS ARE BACK?: The Renegades averaged just under six hits per game against Wilmington. Of the 54 innings played, the Renegades only tallied multiple hits in nine of them. In the first three games against Frederick, the 'Gades tallied 24 total hits over 25 innings, and they had seven multi-hit innings. Over the course of the 6-game series at Frederick, Hudson Valley grabbed 44 hits across 53 innings (7.3 hits per game). Additionally, the 'Gades hit seven home runs in the series at the Keys after entering the week having hit only two in their first eight games of the season.

ON-BASE ANIMALS: Multiple Renegades batters are now settling into their season, and putting together impressive on-base streaks. There are currently 10 Renegades players with multi-game on-base streaks, three players with on-base streaks that are at least five games long, and two with on-base streaks greater than 10. Leading the pack is **C Eric Genter** who's working a 16-game on-base streak, and a 23-game on-base streak if you go back to the end of 2025 during his time with the Single-A Tampa Tarpons.

BEST IN SHOW: The Renegades had the lowest team ERA (2.82) among full-season MiLB teams in 2025. It was also the lowest single-season ERA for any full-season MiLB team since the reorganization of the minors in 2020. Since the start of the 2021 season, the Renegades own a cumulative 3.48 ERA, the lowest in MiLB among MiLB teams who have played every season.

ER-YAY: The Renegades boast the best ERA in High-A Baseball (3.07). The two runs the Renegades allowed through the first two games of the season are the fewest for the club since 2019 when they allowed three total runs to Aberdeen through their first two games. The last time the Renegades allowed two or fewer runs through the first two games of the season was 2018 against Aberdeen (one).

Ks FOR EVERYONE: Through the first 18 games of the season, Hudson Valley struck out a league-leading 209 batters. The Renegades have struck out double digit batters in all but three game so far, and they are averaging 11.6 strikeouts per game.

STAR-STUDDER ROSTER: The Renegades Break Camp Roster features seven of the New York Yankees Top 30 prospects per *MLB Pipeline* rankings, led by **LHP Pico Kohn** (#10). Joining him are **INF Core Jackson** (#12), **INF Kaeden Kent** (#13), **OF Wilson Rodriguez** (#18), **RHP Rory Fox** (#21), **RHP Sean Paul Liñan** (#23) and **RHP Jack Ceibert** (#25). An eighth, **RHP Bryce Cunningham** (#7), begins the season on the Renegades 7-day Injured List. Many of these are new names to the Yankees top prospects lists, as the organization has traded 17 of their top 30 prospects since the beginning of the 2025 season.

NEW YEAR, NEW GADES: Hudson Valley's roster includes 11 players from the Yankees' 2025 draft and free agent class. This includes four of the team's top five picks in the draft (**Kaeden Kent**, 3rd round; **Pico Kohn**, 4th round; **Core Jackson**, 5th round, and **Rory Fox**, 6th round).

HOME COOKING: The Renegades have set single-season franchise records for wins in each of the last two seasons (73 and 79, respectively), and a big reason for that has been their dominance at Heritage Financial Park. Since the start of the 2024 season, Hudson Valley has a 91-40 (.695) record at home, by far the best of any MiLB team in that span.

RETURN OF THE KING: Returning to begin the 2025 season with the Renegades is **INF/OF Josh Moylan**, who is the all-time franchise leader in numerous offensive categories. Moylan is the Renegades all-time leader in: Games Played (228), At-Bats (762), Hits (177), Singles (113), Doubles (41), Extra-Base Hits (64), Total Bases (284), Runs (103), RBI (101), Walks (126) and Strikeouts (260). Moylan became the first Renegade ever to surpass 100 career RBIs on Friday night's game against Brooklyn on 4/25. Moylan went 3-for-3 with three RBIs.

APRIL... FLOWERS?: The Renegades thrived last April, starting off 16-7 in the first month of the year. That led to a slower May and June where the Renegades finished the respective months 14-12 and 12-12. The Renegades played one six-game series against the Cyclones in April (3-3), and they played two three-game series against the Cyclones in June (5-1).

ACQUIRED: Trade with Washington on 3/22/26 in exchange for INF Jorbit Vivas.

PITCHES: Four-Seam Fastball, Sinker, Changeup, Slider

LAST TIME OUT: Liñan struggled through a rough bottom of the second inning last Saturday, allowing four runs to the Frederick Keys, but that blemish was enough for him to get the loss in a 4-1 Renegades loss. The right-hander allowed four runs (three earned) on seven hits across 3.2 innings, striking out six and walking none. Liñan departed after allowing a two-out double to Nate George in the bottom of the fourth, and allowed hits and runners in scoring position in the final three innings he threw.

THE BEST CHANGEUP?: MLB Pipeline's profile of Liñan makes the bold claim that he "has a legitimate claim for the best changeup in Minor League Baseball." The profile continues: "The 6-foot right-hander throws the 79-82 mph offering like a screwball with significant drop and armside run, and oddly, it's also his highest-spin pitch. Batters whiffed on 60 percent of their swings against the cambio that earns Devin Williams comps from virtually all that witness it."

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Made his Yankees organization debut on 4/4 at Brooklyn: 2.2 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 4 K on 55 pitches, 32 strikes.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Split the season between Triple-A Oklahoma City, High-A Great Lakes, and Single-A Rancho Cucamonga in the Dodgers system, and High-A Wilmington in the Nationals organization.
- Acquired by Washington in a trade with Los Angeles-NL on 7/31/25 in exchange for OF Alex Call.
- Made two starts in Oklahoma City (AAA, LAD), tallying a 9.82 ERA over 7.1 IP in a cameo.
- In 10 appearances (7 starts) with Great Lakes (A+, LAD), he tallied a 2.65 ERA over 37.1 IP, and he recorded a save.
- Allowed five earned runs over his last six appearances of the season (22.0 IP) for a 2.05 ERA
- Struck out multiple batters in all but two appearances last season, and he struck out more than five on nine occasions.
- Struck out 10 or more batters in 3 of his first 4 appearances.

PERSONAL:

- Had the "Best Changeup" in the Nationals' system, according to *Baseball America*.
- Prior to the trade to the Nationals, he ranked third in the Dodgers' system with 101 strikeouts in 74.1 IP in 2025.
- Has not had a losing record in any of his four seasons in Minor League Baseball.
- Was signed as an international free agent with the Los Angeles Dodgers on 1/15/22.

ACQUIRED: Non-Drafted Free Agent, 1/15/25

PITCHES: Four-Seam Fastball, Gyro Slider, Changeup

LAST TIME OUT: Herrera got the start in the Renegades series finale last Sunday at Frederick and turned in a solid start in his second outing of the week. He allowed a wind-aided solo home run to Vance Honeycutt in the bottom of the second, the third home run allowed by the lefty to Frederick on the week in 6.1 innings, but that was the only damage against him. He finished his start by retiring seven of the final eight batters he faced, including the final six in a row, racking up three of his six strikeouts in the process. Herrera allowed three hits and one walk while striking out six Keys hitters.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season as the youngest player on the Renegades Break Camp roster.
- Made his season debut on 4/7 vs Wilmington in the Renegades home opener (3.2 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 4 BB, 5 K), and recorded his first five outs of the season on strikeouts (1 pitch clock violation, 4 swinging).
- Allowed home runs to Ike Irish and Victor Figueroa of Frederick on 4/14 in a 2.0 inning start, the first time in his career he allowed two home runs in a game. He had only allowed 2 HR career in 96.2 innings before that game.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Split the season between the FCL Yankees and the Single-A Tampa Tarpons, combining to go 3-1 with a 1.70 ERA (37.0 IP, 25 H, 14 R, 7 ER, 14 BB, 40 K, .191 BAA, 1.05 WHIP, 1 HR) across 22 appearances while making 1 start.
- Made first 17 appearances with the FCL Yankees, allowing 6 ER across 27 IP (2.00 ERA).
- Only allowed more than 1 ER in an appearance once while with the FCL Yankees (4 ER on 7/11).
- Did not allow an earned run in any of his 5 appearances with Single-A Tampa (10 IP).
- Struck out multiple batters in 6 of his last 7 games, and he only walked multiple batters in 1 of his last 7 games.
- Tallied two wins with Single-A Tampa: 8/17, pitching 2.0 innings while allowing one hit and striking out one, and 8/26, pitching 2.1 innings while allowing one hit and striking out five.

- Played in Single-A for the first time last year, his 4th season in the Yankees organization.
- Battled injury in 2023.
