### TODAY'S GAME

The Express and Aces close out their six-game set at Greater Nevada Field on Sunday afternoon. Round Rock RHP James Marvel is slated for the start up against Reno LHP Konnor Pilkington. First pitch for the series finale is set for 3:05 p.m. CT.

### BIG INNINGS, BIG RESULTS

Round Rock used two big innings to claim a 9-5 win over Reno late Saturday afternoon. The Express struck first and plated four runs in the fourth inning on a combination of two walks, two singles, one double and one forceout. Aces LF Dominic Canzone put the home team on the board with a solo home run in the fifth inning. A five-spot in the sixth gave Round Rock an impressive 9-1 advantage. After a solo bomb from RF Rafael Ortega with two outs recorded, 3B Jonathan Ornelas worked a walk. He was followed by four straight hits as DH Justin Foscoe tripled, 1B Yoshi Tsutsugo doubled, CF Elier Hernandez tripled and 2B Dio Arias singled to round out the inning's scoring. Reno made it 9-2 when CF Jorge Barrosa hit a home run in the bottom of the sixth. The Aces worked at a comeback in the ninth inning, but were only able to plate three runs when Canzone hit his second home run of the night and scored RF Jake McCarthy and 3B Phillip Evans. The 9-5 victory gives Round Rock a 3-2 edge in the series heading into Sunday's finale.

### READY TO MARVEL

RHP James Marvel is slated to make his first start for Round Rock on Sunday after signing with the Texas organization. The righty has made one start this season with the Independent High Point Rockers, tossing 5.0 innings in a loss that saw three runs, four hits, one walk and three punchouts.

### LIVE, LAUGH, LOVING RENO

Round Rock RF Rafael Ortega tallied multiple hits for the third consecutive game and posted his second straight three-hit performance on Saturday. The outfielder hit 3-for-5 with two doubles, one home run, three RBI and one run scored. On Friday, he went 3-for-4 and scored two runs and on Thursday, finished 2-for-4 with one double and one run scored. Through four games played in Reno, Ortega is hitting .500 (8-16), bringing him to a career mark of .387 (43-111) over five different seasons against the Aces.

### DOUBLE TROUBLE

The Express defense turned a season-high five double plays on Saturday. Round Rock has not turned five in one game since doing so on July 14, 2019 against the Iowa Cubs. It also marks just the third time since becoming a Triple-A team that the club has tallied five or more double plays. The E-Train turned six in Tucson on May 20, 2005.

### LET'S HEAR IT FOR HEARN

Round Rock LHP Taylor Hearn turned in 2.0 shutout innings of relief on Saturday as he allowed three hits and one walk with one strikeout. Hearn has worked to a 0.93 ERA (1 ER/9.2 IP) over seven outings, with the only run he has allowed scoring during his first outing with the team on April 16.

### KEEP HEATING UP

E-Train 2B Dio Arias posted an impressive 4-for-5 evening at the plate on Saturday. Arias is hitting a red-hot .400 (6-15) in Reno and has tallied two RBI, two walks and two runs scored. The infielder has also totaled seven putouts and eight assists and was part of three of Round Rock's five double plays during Saturday's win.

### MORE ON MARVEL

Newcomer RHP James Marvel joins the E-Train with six seasons of professional baseball experience. The righty was drafted by Pittsburgh in 2015 and made his Major League debut with the Pirates on September 8, 2019 against St. Louis. He signed a minor league contract with Philadelphia as a free agent and spent 2022 with Triple-A Lehigh Valley.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
