TONIGHT: The Stripers begin a 13-day, 12-game road trip with game one of a six-game series vs. the Nashville Sounds (Milwaukee Brewers). It is the seventh of 18 meetings between the two clubs this season, and the first of 12 games Gwinnett will play in Nashville.

VS. NASHVILLE: This series marks the Stripers' third trip to Nashville all-time (first in 2022), a place where they have gone just 3-9 (.250) over two prior series. Gwinnett has lost three straight games at First Horizon Park (outscored 8-3) dating back to a 2-1 win on 8/26/21. In six series against the Sounds, the Stripers are 1-4-1.

STIFLING STAFF: Gwinnett leads Triple-A in ERA in the month of June with a 3.60 mark in 17 games. That's 0.03 points lower than Lehigh Valley (2nd, 3.63 ERA in 17G). Stripers' starters **Tucker Davidson**, **Bryce Elder**, **Nolan Kingham**, **Kyle Muller**, and **Huascar Ynoa** have combined to post a 3.68 ERA (39 ER in 95.1 IP), 9.62 SO/9.0 IP ratio (102 SO), and eight quality starts this month.

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett's pitching staff leads Triple-A in strikeouts with 676 in 66 games (10.24 SO per game). That's three more than Sacramento of the Pacific Coast League (2nd, 673 SO in 66G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). **Kyle Muller** (1st, 92), **Tucker Davidson** (T-7th, 57), and **Huascar Ynoa** (T-7th, 57) all rank in the International League top 10 in strikeouts.

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller retired the final 19 batters he faced on Sunday vs. Indianapolis (6.2 IP, 3 H, 3 ER, 0 BB, 8 SO, 1 HR), producing his fourth straight quality start in a no-decision. He is 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA (5 ER in 26.2 IP), 1.12 WHIP, .221 BAA, and 12.15 SO/9.0 IP ratio (36 SO) during that four-start stretch.

IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (92) and is among the top 10 in ERA (3rd, 3.00), innings (3rd, 69.0), WHIP (94th, 1.12), and BAA (5th, .221).
GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-7 with a 3.21 ERA (53 ER in 148.2 IP), .222 BAA, and 185 strikeouts (11.20 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 29 starts.

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. is riding a nine-game on-base streak since 6/3, batting .417 (10-for-24, 1 2B, 1 HR, 9 R, 3 RBI, 9 BB, 5 SB, 1.154 OPS) in that span. Overall with Gwinnett, he has reached base safely in 39 of 46 games (84.8%), batting .277 (36-for-130, 5 2B, 1 HR, 23 R, 13 RBI). He currently ranks among IL leaders in stolen bases (T-7th, 15) and walks (T-9th, 34).

WATERS WATCH: Drew Waters notched his sixth multi-hit game of the season on Sunday vs. Indianapolis (3-for-5, 1 3B, 1 RBI). In 32 games since being activated from the 7-day IL on 5/3, the Atlanta Braves' No. 2 prospect is batting .258 (32-for-124, 6 2B, 2 3B, 3 HR, 16 R, 11 RBI, 1 SB), including .436 (5 XBH, 1.078 OPS) vs. LHP and .176 (6 XBH, .544 OPS) vs. RHP.

Start it With a Bang: Waters has three XBH on the first pitch of the game this year, including leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. Charlotte (off LHP Wes Benjamin) and 5/11 at Durham (off RHP Tommy Romero), and a leadoff triple on 6/11 at Jacksonville (off RHP Bryan Hoeing).

GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .246 (155-for-630, 33 2B, 2 3B, 16 HR, 103 R, 58 RBI, 32 SB, .703 OPS) in 160 games.

ROBERTSON STREAKING: Kramer Robertson is riding a six-game hitting streak, batting .364 (8-for-22, 2 2B, 1 HR, 6 R, 5 RBI, 4 SB, 1.091 OPS) since 6/12.

Giddy Up: Robertson blasted his first Gwinnett homer on 6/17 vs. Indianapolis, a solo shot to center on the first pitch of the game from RHP Jerad Eickhoff. It was the fourth clout by a Stripers player leading off a game this year (**Drew Waters** has 2, **Phil Gosselin** has 1).

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Over his last six outings, **Michael Tonkin** has gone 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (1 R, 0 ER in 6.1 IP), 0.63 WHIP, .136 BAA, and one save. In 20 games overall, he is 3-0 with a 2.70 ERA (6 ER in 20.0 IP), .197 BAA, and team-high four saves (4-for-5, T-15th in IL).

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .100 (2-for-20, 4 R, 1 RBI, 1 SB) in five games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 164 of 194 games (84.5%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .279 (187-for-671, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 14 SB, .927 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining **Stefan Gartrell** and **Ernesto Mejia**.

TUIASOSOPO REACHES 100-WIN MARK: Matt Tuiasosopo earned his 100th win as a Triple-A manager on 6/9 at Jacksonville (won 5-1). He is the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 wins, joining **Dave Brundage** (293 from 2009-12), **Brian Snitker** (161 from 2014-16), and **Damon Berryhill** (221 from 2017-19).

GOSSELIN GETS THE CALL: On 6/15, Atlanta selected the contract of INF **Phil Gosselin** from Gwinnett. He hit safely in 23 of 29 games from 5/1-6/12, batting .312 (34-for-109, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 14 R, 16 RBI, .885 OPS) in that stretch. Through 6/13, Gosselin ranked 14th in the IL with a .297 average (54-for-182, 13 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 25 R, 24 RBI).

GWN Career: In 284 games over four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), Gosselin is batting .295 (309-for-1046, 64 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 138 R, 106 RBI, 11 SB, .769 OPS). He is one of just seven players in Gwinnett history to record 300 career hits with the club.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TONIGHT'S START: Bryce Elder makes his ninth Triple-A start and 13th start of the season in the opener of a six-game series at Nashville.

- **GWN Career:** Makes his 16th career start with Gwinnett ... Is 5-6 with a 4.23 ERA (39 ER in 83.0 IP), .197 BAA, 36 walks, and 84 strikeouts since 2021 ... When he debuted last season, was the first of Atlanta's 2020 draft class to reach Triple-A.
- **Triple-A Splits:** Makes his eighth career Triple-A road start (2-4, 5.45 ERA, .211 BAA) and his 14th career Triple-A night start (5-5, 4.11 ERA, .195 BAA).

PROSPECTING: Elder is ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 4 prospect by MLB.com ... He is the second-highest ranked pitcher on Gwinnett's roster (Kyle Muller is No. 3).

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Was on Gwinnett's Opening Night roster, but did not appear before having his contract selected by Atlanta on 4/12 ... Optioned back to Gwinnett on 5/1 ... **5/18 vs. MEM:** Set new career high with 11 strikeouts over 7.0 IP (5 H, 3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB) for his first Triple-A victory of the season as the Stripers won 4-3 ... **5/30 vs. LOU:** Tossed a career-high 8.0 innings (2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 8 SO) and had a no-hitter through 6.1 frames in a 2-0 win on Memorial Day ... **6/16 vs. IND:** Snapped a two-start losing streak with his third win (5.0 IP, 8 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO in 10-5 win).
