RIDERS TAKE SERIES BEHIND PITCHING DOMINANCE:

The Frisco RoughRiders dominated on the mound and just snuck past the Arkansas Travelers 2-0 on Sunday from Dickey-Stephens Park. The Riders (16-23, 54-53) did not waste much time in the top of the first inning against Arkansas (20-19, 55-53) starter Michael Morales (2-6), scoring two runs. Keyber Rodriguez plated **Cam Cauley** with an RBI single to start the scoring and **Aaron Zavala** scored from third on a balk to make it 2-0. From there, the Frisco pitching took care of the Travelers, beginning with **Jose Gonzalez** (1-0), who went 5.0 shutout innings in his Double-A debut, striking out three and walking one. **Larson Kindreich** threw 2.0 scoreless innings, **Jackson Kelley** stranded a pair in the eighth and **Bryan Magdaleno** earned his second save with a 1-2-3 ninth inning. **Frainyer Chavez** collected the only multi-hit affair for the Riders, going 2-for-4 at the plate.

THE CARTER 32 IS BACK:

Texas Rangers outfielder **Evan Carter** is slated to begin his rehab assignment with the Frisco RoughRiders on Tuesday. With Texas in 2025, Carter is hitting .238/.323/.381/704 with four home runs, 21 RBIs and 12 steals over 55 games. His 1.5 bWAR is sixth among position players on the Rangers. Debating in 2023 as the No. 1 prospect in the organization, Carter helped lead the Rangers to their first World Series title in franchise history, batting .306/.413/.645/1.058 during the regular season and an all-time record nine doubles during the postseason run while batting .300 with a .917 OPS. In Frisco, Carter helped lead the RoughRiders to a Texas League Championship in 2022 and dominated in 2023 before his MLB call-up. Overall, Carter hit .291/.418/.465/.883 with 18 doubles, six triples, 13 home runs and 24 steals over 103 total games.

POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ, OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:

Frisco's bullpen has struggled this season, but has been great to start August. In nine games, the Riders bullpen is second in the Texas League with a 2.23 ERA, but they are 5-for-8 in save opportunities.

ROTATION ROTATING:

With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of **Trey Supak** and **Ben Anderson** and the trade of **Mitch Bratt**, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (**Josh Stephan**). Frisco's starting ERA of 3.85 in the second half is second in the Texas League, while it is 3.54 since the start of July, which is also second in the league. In the last 12 games, Frisco has a 2.08 ERA for starters which is first in Double-A and Frisco leads the league with a 1.64 ERA in nine August games. **Jose Corniell** (11.2 IP, 0 ER) and **Leandro Lopez** (14.0 IP, 1 ER) have been incredible to start their Double-A careers.

BROKEN BATS:

For the first time since midseason 2023, the RoughRiders were blanked in back-to-back games on offense on Sunday and Tuesday. Frisco ended their scoreless streak with **Aaron Zavala**'s two-run double in the 10th on Wednesday, stopping the streak at 29 consecutive innings without a run. In the first nine games in August, Frisco has scored just 21 total runs while hitting .182/.271/.244/.515 as the plate as a team with two home runs. Zavala has scored or driven in 10 of the 21 runs in the month for Frisco.

THE BOYS ARE PICKIN' IT:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.982) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (69). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .984 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the third-best in Double-A. They committed two errors on Saturday, just their ninth game since May 1st committing multiple errors.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO:

In their last 26 games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in 19 of the 26 games, but they are 12-14. The Riders have blown 10 saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 4.99 in July is last in all of Double-A and while they allowed 54 earned runs, they also surrendered 12 unearned runs.

WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.2 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.4 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 34 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), **Jackson Chourio** (43, 2023), **Nelson Rada** (35, 2024) and **Mike Trout** (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.

-Before being drafted by the Rangers, he was committed to transfer to Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) for baseball.

-Enjoys fishing, playing basketball and eating suski in his free time.
