### TODAY'S HEADLINES

### Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 287-269 LAST TIME OUT: The Saints split their doubleheader with Omaha on Friday LAST TIME OUT: The Saints split their doubleheader with Omaha on Friday, dropping game one 6-5 before winning the back end 8-3. In game one, Saints pitchers issued nine walks, five of which would eventually score. Yunior Severino went 3-for-4 in the first game, as the Saints out-hit the Storm Chasers 11-4 in game one, but came up short in the loss. In game two, Andrew Morris dealt 5.0 innings of shutout baseball, picking up his first Triple-A win. The Saints scored four runs in the second inning and four more in the third, aided by a three-run home run from Carson McCusker. The Saints went 5-for-8 with runners in scoring position in game two, holding the Storm Chasers to 1-for-13. two, holding the Storm Chasers to 1-for-13.

AUGUST THIEVERY: The Saints have stolen 39 bases in August, the most for a single month in franchise history. The previous high was set in August of 2022, when the Saints stole 35 bases. The next closest is the 33 stolen bases the Saints swiped in August of 2023. The 39 steals this month are the third-most in the International League and is the club's 92.9% success rate. However, the two teams ahead of them in stolen base percentage, Syracuse and Louisville, have only swiped 20 and 27 bases, respectively.

LIMIT LONG BALLS: Over the last three games, Saints pitchers have managed to keep the ball in the yard. It marks the fifth time this season the Saints have not surrendered a home run in three consecutive games. Their season-best is five straight games from April 16-20 and May 8-12.

OMAHA OUTBURSTS: Dating back to 2021, Werner Park has been one of the best for the Saints offense, hitting .265/.352/.441 and a .793 OPS. The Saints' batting average and on-base percentage are the best of any road venue they've played in since joining the IL. Their slugging percentage and OPS rank second to Louisville Slugger Field, where the Saints have a .458 slugging percentage and a .809 OPS.

A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN: DaShawn Keirsey Jr. has put together an impressive 2024 campaign, recording 115 hits, 14 home runs and 34 stolen bases. He is the only Triple-A player this season to record at least 100 hits, 10 home runs and 30 steals. He is one of six minor leaguers to amass those totals this season.

S Keirsey Jr. is now third on the single-season hit totals at 115, trailling Jose Miranda (117, 2021), Tomás Tellis (125, 2021) and the franchise record set by Andrew Stevenson at 132 hits last season.

S In the month of August, Keirsey Jr. ranks among league leaders in stolen bases (T-1<sup>st</sup>, 11), triples (T-1<sup>st</sup>, 3), hits (T-3<sup>st</sup>, 31), batting average (6<sup>th</sup>, .352), total bases (T-5<sup>th</sup>, 50), runs (T-5<sup>th</sup>, 19), OPS, (7<sup>th</sup>, .984) and slugging percentage (7<sup>th</sup>, .568)

**ELECTRIC EELES:** Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .415 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 40 of the 45 games he's played in, drawing 21 walks and been hit by a pitch seven times. He is fifth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .437 across three levels.

TWINS UPDATE: The Twins took the series opener against Toronto, beating the Blue Jays 2-0. Pablo López threw 7.2 innings of shutout baseball, giving way to Griffin Jax and Jhoan Duran to finish the game. The Twins, who managed just four hits, scored both of their runs in the fifth inning on a Carlos Santana single and a Willi Castro sacrifice fly.
