YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Curve, 6-1. **Carson Whisenhunt** made his Double-A debut and struck out seven over five scoreless innings. Altoona broke the scoreless tie in the sixth with an RBI single by Matt Gorski. In the bottom of the sixth, **Riley Mahan** tied the game with a solo homer. Later in the inning, **Carter Williams** hit an RBI single and **Vaun Brown** added a two-run single to give the Flying Squirrels a 4-1 lead. **Brett Auerbach** brought in two more runs with a double in the seventh. **Nick Zwack** threw four relief innings and struck out six batters to pick up his second win of the year.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh. Today is the ninth of 18 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 3-3 against the Curve at The Diamond from May 2-7. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will head to Altoona for six games from August 1-6.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 10-of-12 since May 25. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 22-of-their-last-31. Their 9-22 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 180.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 267.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.23 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and the fourth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE CURVE are tied for first place in the Southwest Division, even with Erie. The Curve saw their season-high six-game win streak snapped on Wednesday night. The Altoona offense has struck out 406 times this year, the fewest in the Eastern League. Altoona's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including INF Liover Peguero (No. 7), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 14) OF Matt Gorski (No. 16) and INF Andres Alvarez (No. 30). Nicholas Dombkowski is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Pirates organization and Sanchez is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes Peguero (No. 6), Jones (No. 11), Gorski (No. 16), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 19) and OF Matt Fraizer (No. 22).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Mason Black makes 11th Double-A start and his second against Altoona. Last time out, he allowed three runs over four innings in a no-decision against the SeaWolves on Friday. He last faced the Curve on May 4 at The Diamond and surrendered four runs over 3.1 innings in a loss. A native of Scranton, Pa., Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named an MiLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. For more on Black, see page two.

FOR ALTOUNA: Right-hander Jared Jones makes his ninth start of the season and his first against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Friday against Binghamton and allowed one run over a season-high six innings to pick up his first Double-A win. Jones was selected in the second round (44th overall) by the Pirates in 2020 out of La Mirada High School in California. He had been committed to play collegiately at the University of Texas. Last year, he went 5-7 with a 4.62 ERA in 26 starts for High-A Greensboro. Jones is rated by Baseball America and MLB.com as the No. 11 Pirates prospect.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, they are again leading the level in average attendance (6,758) and total attendance (189,225). The Flying Squirrels are ranked 10th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance.

GLDW SHOW: Infielder Jimmy Glowenke was assigned to Double-A Richmond last week and made his Double-A debut last Wednesday against Erie. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glowenke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glowenke ranked sixth in OPS (.956), sixth in batting average (.313), sixth in wRC+ (146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542) at the time of his promotion. He also had the fourth-lowest strikeouts percentage (14.3) in the league. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut last Wednesday, he has hit safely in each of his last five games, batting .333 (6-for-18) with a double, one RBI and two runs scored.

WHERE THERE'S A WILLIAMS THERE'S A WAY: Carter Williams has hit safely in each of his last eight games since May 27. During that stretch, he is batting .355 (11-for-31) with two homers, a double, three RBIs and seven runs scored. Last year in his first full professional season, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, which ranked second among Giants minor league hitters (min. 300 PA).

VAUN RETURNS: Outfielder Vaun Brown was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown has reached base in each of his nine games with Richmond. Last Wednesday, he set a Double-A high with three hits, including a homer and a double. On Friday, he again picked up three hits and scored the walk-off winning run in the ninth.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Over his last 13 games since May 21, **Andy Thomas** is batting .255 (13-for-51) with three homers, three doubles, three walks and 12 RBIs. Over his last five games since last Friday, he is batting .278 (5-for-18) with a homer, a double and five RBIs. Thomas hit a three-run, go-ahead homer last Friday night against the SeaWolves. On Tuesday against the Curve, he drove in two runs and picked up the third stolen base of his professional career.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Ismael Munguia is ranked seventh in batting average (.300). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for second in triples (3). Hayden Cantrelle is ninth in walks (33). Evan Gates is tied for ninth in saves (4). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for eighth in strikeouts (55).

WHERE THE CURVE RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Mason Martin is ranked tied for sixth in homers (10), seventh in RBIs (30), fifth in OBP (.409), 10th in SLG (.508), fifth in OPS (.917) and fifth in walks (37). Liover Peguero is 10th in hits (50), tied for fourth in doubles (13), tied for seventh in extra-base hits (19) and tied for ninth in runs scored (34). Connor Scott is first in triples (4). Cameron Junker and Juan Minaya are tied for second in games pitched (19).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is also rated as the No. 63 prospect on Baseball America's Top 100. In Baseball America's "Best Tools" list, Luciano is rated as the best power hitter, Brown is rated as the best thitter for average and best athlete, Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp is rated as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz is rated as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes 10 Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2, No. 18 overall), Brown (No. 5), Whisenhunt (No. 8), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 25), Murphy (No. 26), Cruz (No. 29) and Meckler (No. 30).


