Hernandez Notches Three Hits Again, Pelicans Drown RidgeYaks 8-1

SALEM, Va. (June 26, 2026). –The Myrtle Beach Pelicans (4-3, 31-40) bested the Salem RidgeYaks (2-5, 27-45) 8-1 at Carilion Clinic Field on Friday night. With the win, the Pelicans lead the week-long series 3-1.

Myrtle Beach started the scoring in the top of the second. Yahil Melendez walked and then moved to second after Geuri Lubo reached on a fielding error. After a groundout moved both runners into scoring position. The next batter Darlyn De Leon smacked a two-run double to give the Pelicans a 2-0 advantage. Then Alexey Lumpuy worked a walk. With runners on second and third, a wild pitch scored De Leon to extend the lead to 3-0. Salem responded in the bottom of the third. Ilan Fernandez walked and then stole second base. Andrews Opata followed with an RBI double to cut the deficit to 3-1.

The Pelicans added to their lead in the top of the fifth. Melendez was plunked and then moved to second when Ezequiel Pena worked a walk. After a double steal, Darlyn De Leon reached base on a walk. Then Lumpuy was walked which scored Melendez to increase the Birds lead to 4-1. Another bases loaded walk issued to Alexis Hernandez which scored Pena to make the score 5-1.

Myrtle Beach added another run in the top of the seventh. De Leon was hit by pitch and then moved to second on a wild pitch. A batter later, Hernandez roped an RBI triple to extend the lead to 7-1.

In the top of the eighth, the Pelicans tacked on one more in the top of the ninth. Lubo hit a double and then scored on a single coupled with an error to make the score 8-1.

LHP Pierce Coppola (1-5, 3.50 ERA) received the win for the Pelicans. RHP Brady Tygart (0-1, 5.19) was tagged with the loss for the RidgeYaks. RHP Daniel Avitia (5, 2) received the save.

HITTIN HOMERS

As of June 24th, The Pelicans are currently in fourth for most home runs in the entire Carolina League with 62. The Fredericksburg Nationals have hit the most (80). For the Birds' C Logan Poteet has the team-high in homers with 14 on the year. OF Eli Lovich is in second with eight on the year. Poteet is 2nd in HR's in the entire Carolina League, only trailing Wilson's Jose Anderson (17).

CUBS TOP 30 PROSPECTS

The Birds currently house three of the Cubs Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. #11 RHP Kaleb Wing, #15 RHP Dominick Reid, and #30 LHP Pierce Coppola. Wing was a 4th round pick in the 2025 MLB Draft out of Scotts Valley HS (Calif.) Reid was drafted in the 3rd round of the 2025 MLB Draft

out of Abilene Christian. Coppola was a 7th round selection in 2025 out of University of Florida.

LUMPUY LUMBER CO.

OF Alexey Lumpuy finished the 2025 season leading the team in home runs with 11 on the year. After a slow start this season, Lumpuy might've found his power swing. The Camaguey, Cuba product has caught fire. Over his last 11 games, Lumpuy is slashing .356 (16-for-45) with 1 double, 3 HR's, 11 RBI, 11 SB, and 10 BB. In the entire month of June, Lumpuy is hitting .327 over 13 games.

PO-POWER

C Logan Poteet has been on an absolute tear as of late. The former Charlotte 49er, has homered in four straight games. Poteet was chasing a feat that was set by former Pelican (Now Houston Astros) INF Cam Smith, who homered six times in six games back in 2024. In his last 10 games, Poteet is slashing .395 (15-for-38) with 12 runs scored, three doubles, one triple, 6 HR's, 11 RBI, and 10 walks.

21 RUNS, 17 HITS, 5 HR'S IN ONE INNING: OH WHAT A NIGHT!

On 6/18 at Delmarva the Pelicans offense exploded for a season-high 21 runs while notching a season-high 17 hits on the night. The Birds scored 12 runs in the top of the 8th inning by way of hitting 5 HR's none of which came in back-to-back fashion. A 2R HR from Derniche Valdez (5), a 3R HR from Henniell Alcalá (1), a solo shot from Alexey Lumpuy (4), a 3R HR from Michael Carico (6), and then another 3R HR from Geuri Lubo led the charge. They accomplished the feat while facing not just one pitcher, but two in the inning. The Birds bats also racked up a season-high 19 RBIs.

FRIDAY NIGHT THEIVERY

Back on 4/10 in Columbia, the Pelicans stole a season-high nine bags, four of them coming from INF Ty Southisene (tied his career high in SB). OF Alexey Lumpuy stole three bases, OF Cole Mathis and INF Jose Escobar swiped one a piece. Myrtle Beach currently ranks tied for third in stolen bases across Single-A with 20 on the year. Both Southisene and Lumpuy also led the stolen base charge last season as they finished No.1 and No.2 in team high steals. Southisene (41), Lumpuy (30).

HERNANDEZ IS HUMMIN AT THE PLATE

Pelicans INF Alexis Hernandez has been red hot at the plate as of late. He recorded back-to-back three-hit games on 6/25-6/26 at Salem. In his last last six games, he is slashing .308 (8-for-26) with two runs scored, two doubles, four RBI, four walks, and one triple. Hernandez is now hitting .252 on the year after struggling to start the season.
