Stockton Ports (2-5) RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (4-3)





RHP Drew Conover (0-0, 5.40 ERA) vs. RHP Cam Day (0-0, 2.45 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field for a double-header of sorts, as your Quakes host the Stockton Ports (OAK)! Earlier today, local little leaguers were welcomed to LoanMart Field for our first U.S. Bank Youth Clinic, where they received free instruction from Quakes' players and coaches. After today's games, kids will run the bases, thanks to San Antonio Regional Hospital. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE PORTS: Today's games will be the fifth and sixth, respectively, of 12 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the final head-to-head games at LoanMart Field, as this is Stockton's lone trip to Rancho this year. The Quakes have won three straight, after dropping the first game in this series, making them 3-1 against Stockton. In 2023, the Quakes went 7-5 against the Ports, 4-2 at home.

LAST GAME: Saturday's regularly-scheduled game was interrupted and eventually postponed, as the Quakes held a 2-0 lead in the top of the third inning. Steady rain eventually became too much and after more than a 90-minute delay, the game was called. Wilman Diaz gave Rancho a 2-0 lead in the second, with a two-run double off Ports starter Franck De La Rosa. Today's action will pick up where we left off, with a man at second base and two outs in the top of the third inning. At the completion of that nine-inning contest, the Quakes and Ports will take a 30-minute break, then play today's regularly-scheduled game, which will now be just seven innings. The Quakes last played a double-header at LoanMart Field in September of 2022, dropping both games against the Lake Elsinore Storm.

BUEHLER:: Former Quake Walker Buehler returned to Rancho on Friday night for the first time since a rehab appearance in 2018, as he threw 27 pitches over two innings, allowing one run on three hits on Friday night. His appearance marked the first for a rehabbing Dodger in 2024. Buehler made five starts for the Quakes in 2017 while coming up through the Dodgers' system, so Friday marked his seventh overall game in a Rancho uniform. All Dodger rehabbers are sponsored by Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel.

FAMILIAR FACES ON THE FIELD: The Quakes have 30 active players on their 30-man roster to open this home stand. Of the 30, 22 have seen time in Rancho within the last two years. Returning Quakes include pitchers Patrick Copen, Carlos Duran (2022), Gabe Emmett, Jorge Gonzalez, Roque Gutierrez, Edgardo Henriquez (2022), Carlos Martinez, Garrett McDaniels, Jose Rodriguez, Christian Ruebeck, Ben Serunkuma, David Tiburcio and Reynaldo Yean. Returning position players include Jesus Galiz, Cameron Decker, Wilman Diaz, Jake Gelof, Jeral Perez, Joe Vetrano, Juan Alonso, Josue De Paula and Kendall George.

PROSPECTS TO WATCH: The Quakes have four players on their current roster who are rated by MLB Pipeline as Top-30 Dodgers prospects. Three of them play in the outfield, with Josue De Paula (#4), Kendall George (#12) and Zyhir Hope (#21). Infielder Jake Gelof is the other ranked prospect, as he checks in at #23. Former Quake Dalton Rushing is currently the Dodgers' top-ranked prospect.

CAM DAY: Cam Day will make his first start and second appearance of the year, his second against the Ports. In his debut on April 9, Day allowed one run on four hits over 3.2 innings in a no-decision. Day signed as an undrafted free agent with the Dodgers, after playing collegiately at the University of Utah.

DREW CONOVER: Righty Drew Conover will make his first start and second appearance today, his second in this series against Rancho. On Tuesday night against the Quakes, he allowed three runs (one earned) on two hits over 1.2 innings in a no-decision. Conover was selected by the A's in the 11th round of the 2023 draft out of Rutgers.
