LAST TIME OUT...

MOOSIC, Pa. (July 27, 2021) – In a wild contest on Tuesday night, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fell to the Syracuse Mets 10-8 at NBT Bank Stadium. The Mets took the lead in the bottom of the second with a six-run inning, sending 10 batters to the plate despite just two hits against Luis Gil. Former RailRider Mark Payton had a key two-run single which helped end Gil's night after only 1.1 innings.

SWB struck back in the top of the third with a pair of runs against Vance Worley. Andrew Velazquez had an RBI single to get the RailRiders on the board, and a Socrates Brito sacrifice fly closed the deficit to 6-2. Velazquez had a great night at the plate, going 3-for-4 with two doubles, two RBIs and a run scored. He also started a spectacular double play in the fourth with a diving stop and a behind-the-back flip to second.

In the top of the fourth, the RailRiders tied the game with another outburst against Worley. After back-to-back hits to start the inning, Brandon Wagner brought in a run with an RBI single. Matt Pita followed with a three-run homer to left to draw even at 6-6. The long ball was Pita's second of the year with the RailRiders.

Syracuse took the lead with a run in the fifth against Reggie McClain, but Scranton/Wilkes-Barre responded with two runs in the sixth to take its first lead. Velazquez tied the game with an RBI double off A.J. Shugel and scored on a Brito base hit to go up 8-7.

However, the Mets regained the lead in the bottom of the sixth on a two-run double from Chance Sisco. They tacked on another on a Mason Williams sacrifice fly in the seventh to take a 10-8 lead. The RailRiders brought the tying runs to the plate in both the eighth and ninth innings, but could not score against the Mets bullpen. Shugel (1-1) got the win with 2.1 innings of relief for the Mets, while McClain (5-2) took the loss. Tom Windle notched his second save of the season.

NEWS & NOTES

ALVAREZ ON THE RISE: RailRiders infielder **Armando Alvarez** has been on a tear over his last nine games at the plate, batting .359/.375/.795 with four home runs and 11 RBIs. Of the 14 hits he has in this span, nine of them have gone for extra bases, with five doubles added to his home runs. He has raised his season batting average from .219 to .245, and his OPS has jumped 96 points from .648 to .744. In addition to his recent offensive spurt, Alvarez made a diving catch into the first base camera well on Tuesday night against Rochester which ended up as the No. 1 "Top Play" of the night on ESPN's *SportsCenter*.

FALLING BEHIND: The RailRiders have made a habit of notching comeback wins this season, but the flip side is that is predicated on the team falling behind in many games this season. Through 69 games this season, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has allowed the first run in 37 games, notching a 21-16 record in those contests. The RailRiders have been out-scored 79-65 (-14) in the first two innings of games this season, a shocking number considering the team is +111 in run differential this season, the second-best mark in Triple-A East (Durham, +156). Most of the damage has been done in the middle innings, with SWB sporting an impressive +92 run differential in innings four through six.

SWB DIGS THE LONG BALL: On Friday night the RailRiders set a new season high by hitting six home runs against the Rochester Red Wings in a 14-5 triumph at PNC Field. **Armando Alvarez**, **Donny Sands**, **Thomas Milone**, **Andrew Velazquez** (2x), and **Frederick Cuevas** all went deep for SWB on the night. It was the first career multi home run game for Velazquez, and Cuevas' dinger was his first above the High-A level in his career. The SWB franchise record for home runs in a game is seven, set on May 31, 1998 at Toledo. The RailRiders have hit 10 home runs in the first five games of the series.

TURN AROUND NOW SWITCH: As part of his two-homer performance on Friday night, **Andrew Velazquez** became just the second player in SWB franchise history to switch hit home runs in a game. He hit a home run right-handed against Matt Tomshaw in the fourth inning, and clubbed one left-handed against Ronald Peña in the sixth. Velazquez joined **Darren Burton** in the annals of franchise history with his switch-hit performance. Burton accomplished the rare feat on April 23, 1998 in a game at the Rochester Red Wings.

NO HITS FOR YOU!: Last Wednesday **Luis Gil**, **Reggie McClain** and **Stephen Ridings** combined to no-hit the Rochester Red Wings in an 8-0 victory. It was the first no-hitter thrown by Scranton/Wilkes-Barre under the Yankees affiliation (2007 - Present), and the first overall since **Jeremy Cummings** no-hit Rochester on Sept. 3, 2006. With the RailRiders having thrown a one-hitter on May 27 against the Buffalo Bisons, 2021 is the first season in franchise history to feature both a no-hitter and a one-hitter in the same season.

- The RailRiders no-hitter was the third thrown in Triple-A East this year. The Iowa Cubs have thrown two no-nos this year, using four pitchers to no-hit the Indianapolis Indians on May 9, and had three pitchers no-hit St. Paul on July 11.
- It was the first no-hitter for a Yankees Triple-A affiliate since 2002, when **Adrian Hernandez**, **Bob Scanlan** and **Kevin Lovinger** of the Columbus Clippers no-hit the Indianapolis Indians in a 15-1 win. The Clippers threw four no-hitters while affiliated with the Yankees from 1979 - 2006, including one by **Mariano Rivera** in 1995.

IT'S THE FINAL STRETCH (DA NA NA NA): In lieu of a traditional playoff in Triple-A Baseball, MLB announced last Wednesday that all Triple-A teams will compete in a 10-game postseason tournament called the Triple-A Final Stretch from Sept. 22 through Oct. 3. Each league will have a regular season champion, crowned for having the best record across 120 games, and a Final Stretch champion, crowned for having the best record in the added 10 games. Unlike any tournament you may be familiar with, the Triple-A Final Stretch has a set schedule of opponents and you continue to play even if you are eliminated from contention. MLB announced the RailRiders will play Syracuse from 9/22-26 at PNC Field and finish the Final Stretch at Rochester from 9/28-10/3. MLB also announced it will give a prize to the winners.

LAST TIME OUT: For the third straight start, Krook lasted 5.0 innings for the RailRiders his last time out against Rochester, but allowed a season-high seven runs on nine hits, taking the loss last Thursday. He allowed four runs in his first inning, including a three-run home run by Brandon Snyder. Krook then settled down in the second and third, before allowing a run in the fourth, and another homer to Snyder in the fifth, this time a two-run shot.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season with the Double-A Somerset Patriots break camp roster.
- Promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on June 15, the first mid-season promotion of his career.
- Posted a 44:11 K:BB ratio, 0.89 WHIP in 29.1 innings with Somerset before the promotion, including 17 strikeouts in 10.0 innings in his last two starts.
- Had a streak of 18.2 IP without allowing an earned run from 5/18 - 6/12.

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- Selected by the Yankees in the first round of the Triple-A phase of the 2020 Rule 5 Draft.
- Full name is Matthew Edward Krook.
- Drafted in the 1st Round of the 2013 MLB Draft (35th overall) by the Miami Marlins, but did not sign (Competitive Balance Round A). Agreed to a contract with the Marlins, but failed his physical and Miami withdrew its offer.
- Underwent Tommy John surgery performed by Dr. James Andrews on April 22, 2014, during his freshman year of college. Did not pitch in 2015 collegiate season, but did return to pitch with the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League in the summer of '15.
- Drafted by the San Francisco Giants in the 4th round of the 2016 MLB Draft.
- Traded by the Giants to the Tampa Bay Rays on December 20, 2017 along with RHP Stetson Woods, INF Christian Arroyo and OF Denard Span in exchange for 3B Evan Longoria.
- During the COVID-19 pandemic, Krook traveled around the country as different locales began opening up to train with teammates and find open gyms. He mostly stayed in Washington, DC and Charlotte, NC in different AirBNBs. Krook trained and lived for a while with Durham Bulls pitcher Tyler Zombro, whom he describes as a close friend and pitching mentor.
