Zarraga Shines In Return, Pelicans Outduel Howlers 3-1

MYRTLE BEACH, S.C. (August 12, 2026). – The Myrtle Beach Pelicans (16-28, 43-65) took game two of the series against the Hill City Howlers (16-28, 47-63) 3-1 on Wednesday night at Pelicans Ballpark. With the win, the Pelicans have tied the weeklong series 1-1.

LHP Victor Zarraga (3-3, 5.45) received the win and was brilliant in his return from the Complex League, tossing three shutout innings while not surrendering a hit and registering two strikeouts.

RHP Jubrayker Salaya (0.00, 0.0) also turned in a solid performance in his Pelicans debut, tossing three innings of one-run ball while posting two strikeouts and only giving up one hit.

Myrtle Beach started the scoring in the bottom of the first. Alexis Hernandez worked a walk and then scored on a double from Ethan Conrad that was coupled with a fielding error to give the Birds a 1-0 advantage. The Pelicans added to their lead in the second inning. Eli Lovich reached on a walk and then moved to second on a single from Corey Nunez. A batter later Ivan Cespedes roped an RBI single to extend the lead to 2-0.

Hill City struck back in the top of the third. Ben Cleary lined a double and then moved to third on a fielding error. One batter later Pedro Dalmagro grounded out to second which scored Cleary to cut the deficit to 2-1.

The Birds tacked on one more insurance run in the fourth. Jhoander Irigoyen reached second via a throwing error. After Lovich singled Irigoyen to third, Nunez grounded out which scored Irigoyen to stretch the Pelicans lead to 3-1.

RHP Will Hynes (0-2, 8.49) was tagged with the loss for the Howlers. RHP Julio Valdez received the save (S,1) for the Pelicans.

HITTIN HOMERS

As of August 8th, The Pelicans are currently in seventh for most home runs in the entire Carolina League with 86. The Fredericksburg Nationals have hit the most (121). Former Birds' C Logan Poteet has the team-high in homers with 14 on the year. OF Eli Lovich is first on the active roster with nine on the year.

CUBS TOP 30 PROSPECTS

The Birds currently house five of the Cubs Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. #3 Ethan Conrad, #8 Juan Cabada, #6 RHP Kaleb Wing, #11 RHP Dominick Reid #28 Fernando Cruz. Conrad was the Cubs 1st Rd pick (17th overall) in 2025 out of Wake Forest. Wing was a 4th round pick in the 2025 MLB Draft out of Scotts Valley HS (Calif.) Reid was drafted in the 3rd round of the 2025 MLB Draft out of Abilene Christian.

Cruz was signed as an INT FA back in 2024.

CONRAD HITS THE BEACH

OF Ethan Conrad was promoted from the ACL to Single-A Myrtle Beach on 7/7/26. The Cubs 1st round pick in the 2025 MLB Draft is finally seeing his first action at the pro level after surgery on his torn labrum and dislocated left shoulder kept him out of action in 2025. The former Wake Forest Demon Deacon had been sidelined by a nagging lower-back injury to start the 2026 campaign. Conrad made his professional debut on 6/30/26 vs A-DOD. He tallied two hits in three at-bats. **Conrad mashed a two-run home run over the batter's eye in centerfield, joining Felix Stevens, Andy Garriola, and Matt Warkentin as the only Pelicans hitters to ever hit a home run that cleared the batter's eye in centerfield.**

VALDEZ NAMED MiLB PLAYER OF THE WEEK (7/6-7/12)

INF Derniche Valdez was red-hot at the plate last week vs FBG. So hot, that he took home MiLB Player of the Week honors for the week of 7/6-7/12. Over six games, Valdez hit .500 (14-for-28) with nine runs scored, two doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight RBI's, and four stolen bases. To cap it all off, Valdez smashed an extra-inning walk-off grand slam earlier in the week. Valdez is the third Pelicans player to receive honors this season, RHP Mason McGwire was named MiLB Pitcher of the Week (4/14-4/19) and RHP Yoendris Gonzalez was tagged MiLB Pitcher of the Week (6/29-7/5). Going into the All-Star Break, Valdez was on a seven-game hitting streak. His numbers have seen a significant jump since Valdez got eyeglasses back on June 10th.

21 RUNS, 17 HITS, 5 HR'S IN ONE INNING: OH WHAT A NIGHT!

On 6/18 at Delmarva the Pelicans offense exploded for a season-high 21 runs while notching a season-high 17 hits on the night. The Birds scored 12 runs in the top of the 8th inning by way of hitting 5 HR's none of which came in back-to-back fashion. A 2R HR from Derniche Valdez (5), a 3R HR from Henniell Alcala (1), a solo shot from Alexey Lumpuy (4), a 3R HR from Michael Carico (6), and then another 3R HR from Geuri Lubo led the charge. They accomplished the feat while facing not just one pitcher, but two in the inning. The Birds bats also racked up a season-high 19 RBI's.

FRIDAY NIGHT THEIFERY

Back on 4/10 in Columbia, the Pelicans stole a season-high nine bags, four of them coming from INF Ty Southisene (tied his career high in SB). OF Alexey Lumpuy stole three bases, OF Cole Mathis and INF Jose Escobar swiped one a piece. Myrtle Beach currently ranks tied for third in stolen bases across Single-A with 20 on the year. Both Southisene and Lumpuy also led the stolen base charge last season as they finished No.1 and No.2 in team highs. Southisene (41), Lumpuy (30). In the month of June, the Birds led the entire league in steals with 51 throughout the
