#### NOTES

**LAST TIME DUT:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies were blanked by the Somerset Patriots, 5-0, on Wednesday night at TD Bank Ballpark. **Nolan McLean** allowed three runs over 3.1 innings, **Nolan Clenney** allowed one unearned run over 2.2 innings, and **Jeffrey Colon** allowed one run over two frames. **Jeremiah Jackson** and **Drake Osborn** both hit doubles in the game.

**CLEAN CLENNEY:** Right-hander **Nolan Clenney** allowed just one unearned run and one hit and recorded three strikeouts over 2.2 innings in relief at Somerset on Wednesday. Since he allowed seven earned runs over one-third of an inning at Reading on May 22, Clenney has been electric out of the bullpen and is 3-1 with a 3.38 ERA and a 28-to-5 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 26.2 innings over his last 16 outings in that span. More recently, over his last 12 outings, Clenney is 3-1 with a 2.14 ERA and a 23-to-4 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 21 innings.

**PARADA PARTY:** Mets No. 9 prospect **Kevin Parada** singled on Wednesday is now riding seven-game on-base streak. Parada has reached base safely in 27 of his last 28 games that he's had a plate appearance in, including a 20-game on-base streak from June 27 to July 26. Since June 20, Parada is hitting .283 with an .824 OBP, three home runs, nine doubles, nine runs batted in, 10 runs scored, and 16 walks. He had a red-hot July, as he hit .300 with an .880 OPS, three home runs, five doubles, eight RBIs, and seven runs in 19 games. The Mets top catching prospect turned 23-years-old last Saturday.

**CLIFFORD CRUSH:** Mets No. 3 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 69 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** hit two RBI singles on Tuesday and recorded his 10th multi-hit game and 10th multi-RBI game at the Double-A level. The 21-year-old has 40 RBIs across 64 games with Binghamton. Since the start of June, Clifford's longest span without an RBI is six games. He had a strong month of July and in 20 games, he hit .291 with a .371 OBP, a .915 OPS, 23 hits, four home runs, eight doubles, 13 runs batted in, and 15 runs scored. Clifford recorded at least one hit in 15 of his 20 games in July.

**FDREVER YDUNG:** Infielder **Wyatt Young** drew a walk on Wednesday at Somerset, and extended his on-base streak to six games. Over his six-game on-base streak, Young is hitting .438 (7-for-16) with a .524 OBP, .961 OPS, two runs batted in, two runs scored, four walks, and two stolen bases. He went 4-for-4 with an RBI, a run scored, and two stolen bases on Tuesday, tying his career high with four hits. It marked the second four-hit game of his career and the first since May 1, 2022, with Triple-A Syracuse. He also tied his career high with two stolen bags, doing it for the third time in his career. Young currently ranks seventh in the Eastern League with a .371 OBP this season.

**SHOOK ME ALL NIGHT LONG:** Right-hander **TJ Shook** earned his second save of the season, retiring all five batters he faced on Tuesday. In his first four outings with Binghamton and as a member of the Mets organization, Shook is 1-0 with two saves, and eight strikeouts in seven scoreless frames, while he's issued just one hit and three walks. Shook was traded to the Mets from Milwaukee for LHP Tyler Jay on July 21.

In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by
