TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves begin a three-
game road series against the Chattanooga
Lookouts on Friday night. This is the last series
between the two clubs, who will meet a total of
14 times this season (one cancellation)

LAST TIME AGAINST THE LOOKOUTS The M-Braves swept Chattanooga in a five-game series at Trustmark Park from May 9-14, outscoring the Lookouts 27-8. The M-Braves starting pitchers allowed just one earned run over 27 innings in the series. The offense exploded in two games, putting up 10 runs on Wednesday and Sunday.

BEFORE THE BREAK: Four M-Braves pitchers combined for a three-hit shutout to salvage a doubleheader split against the Biscuits this past Saturday. The M-Braves lost game one 5-2 in a game with four combined errors. In game two, the M-Braves scored three runs in the first inning and got a combined shutout from Domingo Gonzalez, Hayden Harris, Daysbel Hernandez and Alec Barger.

LET THE GOOD TIMES ROLL: The M-Braves closed the first half by going 24-17 over the last 41 games, after starting 9-18. The club picked up right where it left off with a series win at Biloxi. Over the last nine series, the club is 4-2-3, starting the run with a five-game sweep of Chattanooga from May 9-14.

TOP PITCHING STAFF: The M-Braves lead the Southern League, rank 2nd in Double-A, and rank 10th among full-season MiLB clubs with a 3.71 ERA. The pitching staff has given up just 58 home runs, fewest in Double-A. The bullpen is 4th in MiLB with a 3.14 ERA.

GRAND SALAMI TIME: The M-Braves have a club record five grand slams, including the first ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell). Waddell's last two home runs were grand slams on June 16 at Pensacola, and July 1 at Biloxi.

PROSPECTING: 8 of Atlanta's Top 30 MLB Pipeline prospects are on the active roster: RHP Victor Vodnik (10), INF Cal Conley (12), OF Jesse Franklin V (13), RHP Alan Rangel (25), RHP Tanner Gordon (27), C Tyler Tolve (28), LHP Luis De Avila (29) and INF Luke Waddell (30).

RETURN OF THE PEARL CITY BOMBERS: The M-Braves rank 2nd in the league, and 7th in Double-A with 95 homers in 79 games - 58 on the road while their opponents have just 59 total home runs. 16 different players have at least one homer with Landon Stephens leading the way with 16 which leads the Southern League. The M-Braves hit 14 home runs at MGM Park this past week

STREAKIN' TOLVE: Tyler Tolve had his 20-game on-base streak (began May 24) end on July 2. The streak is the longest by an M-Braves player

DEAN RUNNIN' WILD: Justin Dean set a club record with four steals in the first two innings on July 1 at Biloxi. Dean had seven steals over two games, June 30-July 2, finished the series with eight stolen bases, and has 21 on the year.

WELCOME BACK MILLY: OF Cody Miligan returned from the IL on Friday, after being shut down on April 25 after suffering a wrist injury. The Binger, OK native hit in 11 of the first 13 games, batting .333 with six doubles, a homer, six RBI, and five stolen bases.

LEAGUE AFFILIATE OF THE

FRANKLIN V ON FIRE: Jesse Franklin V became the fourth player in M-Braves history (Ryan Casteel ('19), Shea Langeliers ('21), Greyson Jenista ('21)) to hit three homers in a game on June 30 at Biloxi. He hit four home runs in two games.

ANOTHER WINNING MONTH: After an 8-13 April, the M-Braves posted a 13-12 record in both May, and June. Over the month of June, the M-Braves ranked 2nd in the league with a .250 batting average, 37 home runs, and 4.17 ERA. The M-Braves are out to a 5-3 start in July.

ALL HAIL KING SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer hit his 100th minor league home run on June 29 at Biloxi, which was his 59th in three seasons for the M-Braves. Lugbauer placed on the IL again on July 3, is currently on a 10-game hitting streak, batting .455 with 4 2B, 3 HR, 8 RBI, 6 BB, .538 OBP, and 1.386 OBP. It's the longest current streak in the league.

On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mile-perhour home run, which ranked 5th among MLB players for hardest hit balls at the time.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record 59 home runs over parts of three seasons, blowing past the previous record of 32 (Travis Demeritte/Connor Lien). He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022.

WADDYYY: Over his last 30 games since June 4, Luke Waddell is batting .339 with a league-most 39 hits, 24 runs, plus 25 RBI, five homers, two grand slams, 11 extra-base hits, 10 stolen bases, and .951 OPS.

DE AVILA DELIVERS IN JUNE: Luis De Avila has delivered five solid starts in June, going 3-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 28.0 innings. The left-hander ranks top 10 in the league in ERA (3.52, 5th), Wins (5, T-4th), and OPP AVG (.233, 8th).

EVEN STEPHENS: Landon Stephens hit in eight straight games from 6/29-7/7, batting .423 (11-for-26) with a 1.439 OPS, three home runs, four doubles and eight RBI. He homered in three straight games from June 16-18, and 10 home runs since June 1. Stephens is tied for the league lead with 16 home runs.

HOT VOD: Victor Vodnik has not allowed a run over his last 12 appearances, 16.1 IP, 25 strikeouts to 11 walks. Since the start of May, Vodnik has a 0.68 ERA in 26.1 innings. He is currently 3rd in the league appearances with 26

WINNIN' WITH WILCOX: RHP Kyle Wilcox has allowed two earned runs in 20.2 innings over 18 relief appearances with the M-Braves, including eight walks to 32 strikeouts. The right-hander was on Triple-A Gwinnett's roster from April 18-May 23, recording a 4.32 ERA in 12.1 innings.

DAYSBEL DIALED IN: RHP Daysbel Hernandez has yet to allow a run in 12 games, 14.0 innings pitched with 19 strikeouts to seven walks. Hernandez is coming off Tommy John surgery in 2022.



Rangel makes his 15th start of 2023 and his sixth career start against the Lookouts. This will be Rangel's 48th career start for Mississippi over the last three seasons. On May 14, Rangel earned his lone win of the season with five innings of one-run ball on May 14.

LAST TIME OUT

 Rangel gave up two runs in 4.2 innings on Monday, July 3 at Biloxi. The right-hander settled for a no decision with four walks and four strikeouts.

- Posted a 2.61 ERA in 20.2 innings in May, recording at least five innings in all four starts
