TONIGHT'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field for the conclusion of a three-game home stand, as your Quakes host the Visalia Rawhide in the final game of the three-game set. Tonight's game is our Third of July Fireworks Celebration, with Military Appreciation Night, thanks to the Ontario International Airport. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the 15th of 30 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the ninth of 15 at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 8-6 against the Rawhide in 2024, 4-4 here at home. Last season, the Quakes went 17-13 against the Rawhide, 7-5 here at home.

LAST GAME: Joe Kelly fired a scoreless first inning, but it was all Visalia after that, as they roughed up the Quakes on Tuesday night by a final of 13-4 at LoanMart Field. After a scoreless first, Visalia erupted for one in the second, three in the fourth and then six in the fifth, chasing Rancho reliever Christian Zazueta (0-2) and taking a commanding 10-2 lead. Three different Visalia players had three hits each, as they pounded out 13 runs on 16 hits. Rancho got two hits and an RBI from Jesus Galiz, while Wilman Diaz knocked in a pair with a two-run triple. Visalia reliever Jorge Minyety (2-0) was credited with the win, throwing 2.2 innings of scoreless relief. The loss for Rancho brings an end to their two-game win streak and drops them a game behind first-place Visalia in the second half standings.

JOE KELLY: Right-hander Joe Kelly of the Los Angeles Dodgers threw one scoreless inning for the Quakes, using just five total pitches on Tuesday, as part of a rehab assignment. Kelly has been on the Injured List since early May, making his last appearance on May 5 against the Atlanta Braves. In 15 games this year, Kelly was 0-0 with a 4.73 ERA for the Dodgers across 13.1 innings. Kelly pitched for the Quakes on rehab assignment on two occasions in 2021 and then again in 2023, when he made two more appearances. Kelly, who won a World Series with the Dodgers in 2020, is currently in his second stint with the Dodgers, after spending 2022 and part of 2023 with the Chicago White Sox. Kelly was originally drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the third round of the 2009 draft out of UC Riverside. All Dodgers rehabbers are sponsored by Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel.

SECOND HALF STUFF: In order to make the playoffs in 2024, the Quakes must win the second half, or else finish second in the South Division's second-half race, while having the first-half champion Storm win the division again. The Storm will meet the second-half winner or the team with the next best second-half record. Lake Elsinore last went to the playoffs in 2022, when they won the Cal League title. Modesto won the North Division First Half Title.

WYATT CROWELL: Left-hander Wyatt Crowell makes his third appearance for the Quakes and his seventh total appearance of 2024, his first against the Rawhide. Threw three scoreless innings in his debut at LoanMart Field against the 66ers on June 21, then followed it up with 2.2 innings of scoreless work in a start at Lake Elsinore on June 27. Crowell joined the Quakes from the Arizona Complex League, where in four starts, he pitched just six innings, allowing four runs on just two hits, but with four walks and nine strikeouts. The lefty was drafted by the Dodgers in the fourth round of the 2023 draft out of Florida State University.

DENNY LARRONDO: Righty Denny Larrondo will make his 14th start of the year and third against the Quakes. In two games against the Quakes, he's 0-2, allowing nine runs (seven earned) on ten hits over just nine innings. In his last outing, he allowed two runs (one earned) on four hits over six innings in a no-decision at Inland Empire on June 27. Larrondo was signed by the Yankees in 2018 out of Cuba and was claimed off waivers by Arizona in 2022.
