NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

2026 has been a roller coaster for Omaha, with the Storm Chasers recently going on an 8-game winning streak, from July 12 to 24.

- Of 18 series this year, the Chasers have won 7, lost 8 and split 3 ... last Friday's win secured back-to-back series wins and the club's 7th series victory of the year.
- Month by month, the Chasers went 13-12 in April, 13-14 in May, and 10-15 in June – their first back-to-back losing months since May/June 2025 ... July was a turnaround: at 14-10, Omaha had a winning month of July.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Chasers have 30 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 30 losses this year.

- 30 comeback wins are tied 2nd-most in the International League, tied 3rd-most in Triple-A and tied 10th-most in the Minor Leagues ... Omaha's 30 blown leads rank 3rd in the International League, 5th in Triple-A and tied 10th in the Minors.
- Over the last 70 games (since May 9), Omaha is 34-36 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 24 of their 34 wins in that stretch, and led at some point in 20 of their 36 losses – meaning 44 of Omaha's last 70 games (63%) have featured a comeback from the eventual winner ... it's also been a tight stretch overall: 46 of those 70 games (66%) have been decided by 3 runs or fewer.
- 7 of Omaha's last 12 wins have been comebacks, with the Chasers trailing for at least 2.0 innings in 5 of them and overcoming multiple deficits in 4 ... over the last 6 comeback wins, Omaha has erased 10 separate deficits – including trailing 3 times last Tuesday at Salt Lake, twice on Friday and once Sunday against the Bees.

CROSS ME UP

Gavin Cross had one of the league's slowest starts to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.

- Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) ... but in his last 57 games (since May 16), he's hitting .311 (66-for-212), with 25 extra-base hits and 36 RBI, with 20 multi-hit games, including the first 5 games last week in Salt Lake and 10 of his last 18 games.
- Thursday, Cross snapped a career-best 19-game hitting streak that was the longest active streak in the Minors and the International League's longest in 2026 ... from July 2 to 28, he hit .370 (30-for-81) with 16 XBH, 21 RBI and a 1.178 OPS.
- Cross homered in 6 consecutive games (July 22-28), becoming the first player in Omaha's modern history (since 2005) to homer in 6 straight games and the first Minor League player to do so since August 2024 ... he has driven in a run in 8 straight games, with 14 RBI since July 22, tied for the longest RBI streak in the International League this year and tied for the longest in Omaha's modern history, the first since Mike Moustakas from August 26 to September 2.
- Monday, Cross was named the International League's Player of the Week, going 12-for-27 (.444 average) with 2 doubles, 2 triples and 5 home runs for a MiLB-leading 33 total bases, with a Triple-A best 10 RBI ... 33 total bases over the 6-game series are the most for an Omaha hitter since 6-game series began in 2021.

HONEST ABE

Abraham Toro started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May.

- Since May 12, Toro has a .320 average (64-for-200) ... in this stretch, he ranks 1st among qualifiers in the IL in OPS (1.023), 2nd in SLG (.624) and 6th in AVG (.332) ... his 50 RBI over 55 games since May 12 rank as the 6th-most in the league.
- From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 13, Toro has hits in 41 of 55 games, with 4+ hits in 4 games.

SUMMER HEAT

A pair of Storm Chasers bats have especially been performing well in recent weeks.

- In his last 29 games (since June 21), Brett Squires is slashing .301/.390/.563 (31-for-103) with 21 RBI ... from June 16 to July 2, he hit safely in a career-best 14 games.
- Drew Waters has hit safely in 20 of his last 24 games (since June 16), a stretch where he is slashing .292/.346/.448 (28-for-96) with 9 extra-base hits and 11 RBI.

HITTERS HEAVEN

The Storm Chasers were on an offensive turnaround during the month of July, seeing some of the biggest success throughout the season.

- Since July 9, Omaha has had 10+ hits in 11 of 17 games (65%), and have won the last 10 games with 10+ hits ... before this 17-game stretch, the Chasers had 10+ hits in just 30 of its 88 games (34%), and won 20 of 30 double-digit hit games.
- In the month of July, the Storm Chasers batted .283 (234-for-828) as a team, which ranked 2nd in the International League ... Omaha also ranked 1st in total bases (392) and hits (234) and 2nd in OPS (.832), SLG (.473) and runs scored (144).

TODAY'S APPEARANCE

- Henry Williams is making his **12th start** this year with the Storm Chasers, his **14th Triple-A appearance**, his **18th overall start** and his **21st overall appearance** this season.
- Playing his **4th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- This is Williams' 3rd career appearance against the Saints and his 12th against the Twins and their affiliates ... both appearances against St. Paul came earlier this year, allowing 8 runs in 6.0 innings.

HENRY'S HUNCH

- FINDING HIS FOOTING:** Williams made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers last season, but made just 2 spot starts in the 1st half of the season ... he opened 2026 in Double-A, but since being promoted to Omaha on May 12, he has pitched in 13 games ... after posting an 8.59 ERA (14 ER in 14.2 IP) over his first 4 outings (May 17 to June 2), Williams worked a 7.17 ERA (17 ER in 21.1 IP) over his next 5 appearances (June 7 to 30) ... he has a 5.75 ERA (13 ER in 20.1 IP) in his last 4 games (July 5 to 26).
- HOME RUN HURTING:** Much of the damage off Williams in Triple-A early this year came on the long ball, but he has limited home runs recently ... he allowed 9 home runs (all solo homers) in his first 5 games and 20.2 innings, accounting for 50% (9 of 18) of the runs he allowed, but he has allowed just 4 home runs in his last 8 games, accounting for just 17% (5 of 29) of the runs he has allowed.
- QUALITY CONTROL:** Williams is tied for the team lead in quality starts (3) ... he fired consecutive quality starts, on July 5 vs. Indianapolis (PIT) and July 11 @ Louisville (CIN) ... he also worked a quality start on June 7 @ Columbus (CLE) ... he allowed 3 runs over 6.0 innings in each of those three starts.

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, JULY 26 @ SALT LAKE

- Earned his 2nd Triple-A win of the year ... opened the game with back-to-back perfect innings ... allowed his first baserunner of the game on a leadoff double in the bottom of the 3rd inning, then gave up a sacrifice fly before working out of the frame ... allowed a 1-out solo home run in the bottom of the 4th inning, but kept the Bees off the board in the 5th inning ... exited the game with one out in the 6th inning after allowing a baserunner on an error and single, the bequeathed runner scored.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made 7 starts for Northwest Arkansas before his promotion to Omaha ... worked a 4.72 ERA (18 ER in 34.1 IP) with a 1.37 WHIP ... 3 of his 7 starts went 5.0+ innings with 1 or less runs allowed.

CAREER NOTES

- Spent most of the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but also made 2 starts for Omaha ... among Royals Minor League pitchers, ranked 5th in innings pitched (115.1) and tied 6th in strikeouts (106).
- Opened the year with the Nationals and threw 5 quality starts over his first 8 appearances ... made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers on May 28 vs. St. Paul (MIN) ... in 2 starts for Omaha and allowed 9 ER in 8.0 IP (10.13 ERA) before returning to Northwest Arkansas on June 6 to finish his season.
- In Northwest Arkansas, totaled 21 appearances (19 starts) and worked a 4.24 ERA (51 ER in 108.1 IP) with 100 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP throughout the season ... named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for his start on July 2 @ Springfield (STL), tossing 5.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit and 7 strikeouts

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+) ... appeared in 22 games (21 starts) with a 3.68 ERA (42 ER in 102.2 IP) and 92 strikeouts at High-A ... 7 of his 21 starts were scoreless, including his last 3 of the season, for a career-high 21.0-inning scoreless streak that stretched into April 2025.
- Split 2023 between the Royals and Padres organizations ... opened the year with the Lake Elsinore Storm (A) in San Diego's system but the Padres traded him to Kansas City at the trade deadline ... after the trade, made 5 starts for Columbia (A) and posted a 3.38 ERA (9 ER in 24.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts for the Fireflies.
- Made his professional debut at the start of the 2023 season with Lake Elsinore after San Diego drafted him in the 3rd round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Duke University ... made 12 starts for the Storm before his trade to the Royals, working a 5.74 ERA (27 ER in 42.1 IP) with 40 strikeouts for Lake Elsinore ... missed the 2022 season as he recovered from Tommy John surgery.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Attended Duke University (2019-2021), where he appeared in 9 games (7 starts) over 3 seasons with the Blue Devils (ACC), going 3-3 with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER in 37.2 IP) and 45 strikeouts ... only pitched one full season in Durham (2021) due to the COVID-19 pandemic shortening his freshman campaign (2020) and Tommy John surgery in December 2021, keeping him out of action his junior year (2022).
- Lettered in both baseball and basketball all 4 years at Darien High School (CT) ... was a team captain for the basketball team his senior season.
- Father David played collegiate baseball at Davidson College from 1987 to 1991.

CAREER PITCHING
