EL PASO CHIHUAHUAS (29-39) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (21-47)

### LHP Miguel Cienfuegos (1-1, 5.91) vs. RHP Tanner Gordon (0-2, 7.11)

**TODAY'S GAME**: Albuquerque needs a win today to claim its first series victory of the season after a 13-3 triumph last night over El Paso ... A rematch of game one starters is set: Tanner Gordon for the Isotopes and Miguel Cienfuegos for El Paso.

ATTENDANCE: Over 38 home openings, the Isotopes have tallied the second-highest total attendance in all of Minor League Baseball and most in the Pacific Coast League (249,501). Highest: Dayton, 257, 230.

MARGINS: The Isotopes recorded their largest margin of victory last night (10) since Aug. 2, 2023 vs. Las Vegas (19-6). Additionally, it was the 47th time in club history that Albuquerque has won a game by a double-digit margin.

SERIES: Albuquerque clinched their third non-losing series of 2024, all coming against El Paso. They split six games in western Texas from April 16-21 and May 7-12. The Isotopes have not claimed a series victory since Sept. 12-17, 2023 at El Page (12 cets). Paso (12 sets).

HITS: The Isotopes finished with 17 hits last night, tied for their second-most in a game in 2024 (also: May 8 vs. El Paso). Most: 21 hits in a 17-13 loss to Oklahoma City on April 23.

**XBH**: Last night marked the 10th time the Isotopes recorded a minimum of seven extra-base hits in a contest, and fifth when playing the Chihuahuas (most recent: June 12, nine).

OPPONET XBH: El Paso's lone extra-base knock last night came via Brett Sullivan's RBI double in the first inning. The Isotopes have limited their opponent to one on eight occassions in 2024, but have yet to hold anyone to zero in a contest.

**RUNS IN A FRAME**: Albuquerque has plated four or more runs in a frame on 23 occassions this year, eight times against El Paso.

**ON THE BUMP**: Albuquerque's pitching staff limited the opposition to six hits last night for the fourth time in the last 10 contests, dating back to June 5 at Sacramento.

PITCHERS USED: Albuquerque used seven pitchers yesterday after starter Peter Lambert was knocked out after throwing 38 pitches in the first inning. It tied for their most hurlers in a contest this season, reached on two previous occassions (April 12 vs. Sugar Land, May 5 vs. Round Rock).

LIKE FATHER LIKE SON: Last night was the sixth time the Isotopes and Rockies have won on the same day this season, with Colorado's 16-4 trouncing of Pittsburgh.

BIRD IS THE WORD: Jake Bird pitched a clean, perfect sixth inning last night in the second outing of his rehab assignment ... Has allowed just one baserunner (walk) over 2.0 frames with three punchouts.

FAN FAVORITE: Coco Montes collected four hits in a game last night for the sixth time as an Isotope (last: May 15, 2024 vs. Sugar Land). This season, Montes leads the Isotopes with 27 multi-hit performances. Recorded back-to-back multi-hit games for eighth time in 2024 ... Is 9-for-20 with three doubles, a tirple, two homers and nine RBI over his last four games.

RBI: Montes' five RBI last night tied a season-high for an Isotopes player, reached on three previous instances (Sean Bouchard, March 31 vs. El Paso; Jordan Beck, April 18 at El Paso; Hunter Goodman, April 23 vs. Oklahoma City) ... Has 212 RBI as an Isotope, third-most in franchise history.

COCO VS. EL PASO: Montes has a .356/.412/.658 slash line with eight doubles, a triple, four long balls and 22 RBI in 18 games against the Chihuahuas in 2024.

JC: Julio Carreras tied a career-high with four hits last night (also: Aug. 4, 2023 at Reading). He is 10-for-22 with three multi-hit performances in his last six games, improving his season average from .187 to .216. Additionally, Carreras' 19 steals rank fifth in the Pacific Coast League, tying a career high (2022).

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk's 23 doubles is 2nd-most

**SAM I AM:** Sam Hilliard recorded a single last night to extend his hit streak to five games, slashing .364/.417/.636 with a double, triple, homer and two RBI. Over previous 12 games, batted .100 (5x50) ... Recorded his 209th RBI as an Isotope yesterday, fourth-most in team history.

TAKE FLIGHT: Jimmy Herron went 2-for-4 last night with a solo homer, snapping an 11 at-bat hitless streak since being activated from the Injured List Wednesday (last HR: April 27 vs. OKC).

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 4th in average (.313) **Aaron Schunk** is 2nd in doubles (23), T-6th in XBH (31) and T-9th in hits (71) ... **Coco Montes** is 1st in average (.338), 2nd in hits (81), T-3rd in triples (5), 4th in OPS (.970) and total bases (133), 5th in OBP (.416), 6th in slugging (.554) T-7th in walks (35), T-8th in RBI (46) ... Sam Hilliard is T-3rd in runs (51), T-6th in XBH (31), T-7th in triples (4) and walks (35), T-8th in homers (12), 9th in total bases (130), T-9th in hits (71) ... Julio Carreras is 5th in SB (19)

### **NUCLEI NOTES**

**SKIPPER**: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

**HOMETOWN KID:** Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
