WALK OFF WINS: Antonis Macias poked a walk-off single to seal Hub City's second victory of the night Friday. In 2025, the Spartanburgers won eight games in walk-off fashion. The first came against Greenville in the second home series of the year; Anthony Gutierrez singled to right to score Quincy Scott.	
TEEING OFF: Through seven games, the Spartanburgers have hit four home runs, all at over 100 mph exit velocities. All of the homers have been pull-side shots, two from right-handed hitters and two from lefties.	
YOU'RE OFF BASE: The Hub City pitching staff has the lowest WHIP (0.98) in the SAL through seven games, having allowed 33 hits and just 20 walks, the fewest in the league. Burger arms have struck out 71 batters through six games.	
A *HIT* AWAY FROM HISTORY: Four Spartanburgers pitchers combined for a one-hitter Wednesday, the second nine-inning one-hitter in Hub City history. The 'Burger bullpen's only one-hitter last year came against the Drive; Caden Scarborough, Brooks Fowler and Victor Simeon combined for the shutout.	
UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT: Former big league catcher Carlos Maldonado has taken the helm of the 'Burgers in 2026. The majority of Maldonado's staff from Low-A Hickory joins him: hitting coach Brian Pozos and development coach Jorge Cortes. Mason Milkey joins the 'Burgers from the ACL, and Landon Lassiter joins HC from the Orioles. 2025 manager Chad Comer, pitching coach Thomas St. Clair, development coach Jay Sullenger and trainer Kiley Brown were promoted to Double-A Frisco.	
COMEBACKERS: Hub City returns 23 players who spent time in the 'Burg last season. 20 of them were on the championship roster at the end of the season, and 10 were on the roster for the first ever game at Fifth Third Park on April 15, 2025.	
INAUGURAL I-85 RIVALRY: The Spartanburgers won 13 of 24 games in the first ever I-85 rivalry series against the Drive, including 8 of the 12 at Fifth Third Park. 11 games in the series were decided by one run.

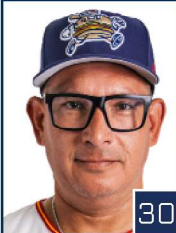
The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the

Down East Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager. The Spartanburgers play in the south division of the South Atlantic League. Chad Comer served as the first manager in Spartanburger's history, leading Hub City to a SAL South Division Championship in 2025. The Spartanburgers lost in the SAL Championship to the Brooklyn Cyclones, finishing the year 67-68.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ballpark seats over 5,000 people.



The Johnson Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Spartanburgers game was a 5-3 win over Bowling Green on April 15, 2025. Cole Swindell headlined the first concert in June 2025. Fifth Third Park hosted a record 4,798 fans in 2025 on the 4th of July for a Spartanburgers game and the Red, White & Boom celebration.

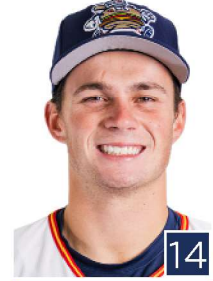

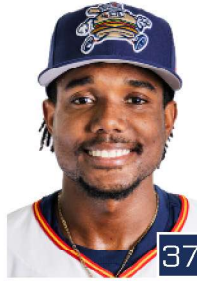
