SHRIMP FIZZLE AFTER FOUR-RUN FIRST, FALL 8-4

A four-run first inning on Tuesday was not enough for the Jumbo Shrimp in an 8-4 loss to the Sounds. After Jacksonville grabbed the lead in the top of the first, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered only three hits the rest of the game - all singles. Nashville methodically chipped away, scoring one in the second, one in the third and then two in the sixth to tie. **Brock Wilken** cracked a three-run shot in the seventh to put the Sounds in front for the first time. **Luis Lara's** RBI triple in the eighth capped the scoring at 8-4. All 12 runs in the game scored with two outs.

JUMPIN' BRAX

Braxton Garrett, who starts Wednesday's game for the Jumbo Shrimp, has been one of the toughest pitchers to hit in Triple-A this season. The 28-year-old has surrendered only 24 hits in 56.0 innings, working out to a .130 batting average against that would lead the IL if Garrett had enough innings to qualify. In fact, Garrett's 24 hits allowed trail only teammate **Jack Ralston** (21 in 43.2 innings) for the fewest of the 93 IL pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched this season. The closest IL hurler with at least 50.0 innings pitched this season is Charlotte's **Hagen Smith**, who has surrendered 13 more hits in 4.0 fewer innings.

ACE UP THE SLEEVE

Jacksonville starting pitching has been nothing short of dominant of late. Over the club's the last 14 games, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have combined to yield only 18 runs, 15 earned, on 46 hits (5.9 H/9) in 69.2 innings, recording an extraordinary 1.94 ERA. During this run, Jacksonville starters have combined for 94 strikeouts (12.1 K/9) against just 21 walks (2.7 BB/9). Not coincidentally, this starting pitching success has helped the Jumbo Shrimp go 11-3 over this stretch.

ONE DIRECTION

Jacksonville has won nine of their last 12 one-run games. The Jumbo Shrimp are now 14-7 (.667) in one-run games, tied for the second-most such victories in Triple-A. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp earned 29 one-run victories, tied for the most one-run victories in MiLB. The 29 one-run triumphs were the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014, when the Jacksonville Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs.

THE SOUNDS OF MUSIC

Jacksonville and Nashville split their first series of the season, continuing a theme between the two clubs. Since Jacksonville rejoined Triple-A in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp have played 87 games against the Sounds, with Jacksonville going 43-44 (.494) against Nashville. The Sounds have outscored the Jumbo Shrimp by a miniscule 422-409 (+13) margin over these 87 contests.

MEN OF STEAL

The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp swiped 305 bases, blowing past the previous club record of 192 set by the 1979 Jacksonville Suns. The 2026 Jumbo Shrimp got off to a slower start in the steals department, with their 29 stolen bases through the season's first 24 games placing in a tie for 13th place in Triple-A. Since that point has been a completely different story; Jacksonville's 112 steals in the last 57 games are the second-most in Triple-A, trailing only Gwinnett (114).

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Jacksonville has racked up an impressive 22-15 (.595) record on the road this season - the 22 away victories rank in a tie for ninth in all of Triple-A. The biggest difference for the Jumbo Shrimp in their away contests has been their offense. At VyStar Ballpark, the club is hitting just .219/.330/.360/.690 with 190 runs scored (4.3 per game). Jacksonville is batting .259/.338/.428/.766 with 228 runs scored (6.2 per game) on the road.

ETZEL DAY? WELL, I LIKE ETZEL DAY

Matthew Etzel got off to a very slow start to the season, hitting just .183/.256/.254/.510 over his first 20 games of the season. Over the last 43 contests, however, the Texas native is a scorching 47-for-161 at the plate, slashing a robust .292/.397/.503/.900 with six doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 28 RBIs, 27 walks and 38 runs scored. Since this stretch began on May 3, Etzel ranks third in the IL in runs, 16th in OBP, tied for 16th in walks and 18th in both OPS and hits.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has won 11 of their last 14 games dating back to June 17. During this stretch, they lead Triple-A in ERA (2.95), runs allowed (48) and BAA (.197).

ABOUT BRAXTON

-The Miami Marlins' first-round pick in 2016, Garrett made his professional debut in 2017 but lasted just four starts until an injured elbow forced him to undergo Tommy John Surgery. Garrett went under the knife on June 20, 2017 and missed the rest of the 2017 campaign, as well as the entirety of the 2018 season. While rehabbing, however, he roomed with fellow Marlins prospect Jordan Holloway, who had underwent Tommy John Surgery just five days before Garrett did so.

-Garrett underwent a second Tommy John Surgery on December 16, 2024, causing him to miss the entirety of the 2025 season. Prior to getting recalled for a May 14, 2026 start, he had not pitched in a major league game since June 17, 2024, a span of 696 days. Garrett, though, did pitch in three minor league games in September of that 2024 season.

-Garrett made his major league debut for the Marlins in game two of a doubleheader on September 13, 2020 against the Philadelphia Phillies. He ceded just one run on three hits in five innings, striking out six against two walks.

-Had he not decided to turn pro, Garrett had signed to pitch at Vanderbilt University.

-Garrett began his high school career at Foley High School in Alabama. However, he moved to Florence when his father, Steve, became the Florence Falcons' head baseball coach.

-Under the tutelage of his father, Garrett was named Alabama's Mr. Baseball as a junior and the state's Gatorade Player of the Year and a first team USA Today All-American as a senior, when he posted a 0.83 ERA with 131 strikeouts in 65.1 innings.

2026 SEASON

-Garrett threw the 14th no-hitter in Jacksonville baseball history (1970-present) on April 21 at Gwinnett in a 2-0 loss to the Stripers (8.0 IP, 0 H, 2 R, ER, 3 BB, 6 K). The southpaw hit a pair of batters to start the sixth. One runner scored from second on a wild pitch and the other eventually scored on a sacrifice fly. The Jumbo Shrimp mustered only one hit in the defeat.

-Garrett was recalled by Miami on May 14 and optioned to Jacksonville on May 20.

2025 SEASON

-Garrett did not pitch while rehabbing from Tommy John Surgery.

2024 SEASON

-Opponents showed reverse splits in the major leagues against Garrett. Right-handed hitters batted .254/.285/.407/.692 against him in 120 plate appearances. Left-handed batters slashed .294/.368/.441/.809 against him in 36 plate appearances.
