Today: Coming off a resounding victory in the series opener, the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the second in a six-game series at the Fort Wayne TinCaps, the High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. A Lugnuts victory would bump Lansing back over .500 for the first time since May 4.

Starting Matchup: The Lugnuts send lefty **Brady Basso** to the mound for his fourth start, with right-hander **Mitch Myers** expected to piggyback in relief. Basso missed all of last season in rehabbing following Tommy John surgery. Fort Wayne counters with right-hander **Jared Kollar**, making his fifth appearance and fourth start.

Last Night: Lugnuts 11, TinCaps 4. Fort Wayne scored two runs in the first inning and then watched the Lugnuts score the next ten runs, pinning six to reigning Midwest League Pitcher of the Week **Jairo Iriarte** to double the amount of runs the ace had allowed all year, on their way to a series-opening romp.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play Fort Wayne through Sunday, enjoy a day off, and then return to Jackson Field to host the Cedar Rapids Kernels in a series ending May and beginning June.

LUG•NOTES

Season Highs: Yesterday marked the Lugnuts' highest single game base hit total of the year (16), runs total (11) and doubles total (4). It was the second time this year that Lansing has scored more than six runs in a game.

Streaking: 1B/OF **Danny Bautista, Jr.**, went 1-for-2 with a single, a walk and an HBP yesterday, extending his hitting streak to nine games. Bautista, Jr., is batting .387 (12-for-31) during the streak, raising his average from .226 to .270.

Roster Movement: Before last night's series opener, the Lugnuts added outfielder **Brayan Buevas** to the roster. Buevas, MLB Pipeline's No. 22 Athletics prospect, was slashing .263/.368/.466 in 36 games with Single-A Stockton, leading to this promotion. He wrapped up his time in the California League by delivering two separate game-winning pinch-hit three-run homers for the Ports against the San Jose Giants, including in his final at-bat on Sunday.

Familiar Faces, Part I: Lansing infielder **Euribiel Ángele**s played in 18 games for Fort Wayne to end the 2021 season before he was traded to Oakland shortly before the start of 2022. Current TinCaps Brandon Valenzuela, Edwain Bencomo and José Geraldo were also on those 2021 TinCaps. Ángele also played alongside Valenzuela, Geraldo, Colton Bender, Keegan Collett, Lucas Dunn, Jairo Iriarte, Carlos Luis, Joshua Mears, Bodi Rascon, Ethan Routzahn and Nick Thwaits on the 2021 Lake Elsinore Storm.

Familiar Faces, Part II: Lugnuts outfielder **Junior Pérez** played in the Padres system in 2018 in the Dominican Summer League, where he was teammates with Valenzuela, Geraldo and Alan Mundo, and in 2019 in the Arizona League, where he was teammates with Collett, Geraldo and Rascon.

Quick as a Wink: Infielder **Jack Winkler** singled, walked and was hit by a pitch last night, reaching base three times exactly for the fourth consecutive game. In the process, Winkler has lifted his batting average from .212 to .252 and his OPS from .597 to .681.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: An hour and 46 minutes for a nine-inning game? The Lugnuts' Henderson Alvarez (7 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 4 K) and the Cedar Rapids Kernels' Will Smith (8 IP, 5 H, 6 K) breezed right through a 1-0 Kernels victory in Cedar Rapids. The game featured zero walks and a combined seven runners left on base.

2010: Ryan Goins went 5-for-5 with four singles and a double, but the Lugnuts lost at home to Great Lakes, 10-7. Lugnuts pitchers gave up 12 hits and 10 walks.

2017: With time running out due to intensifying rainstorms, the Lugnuts rallied for two runs in the bottom of the seventh to beat Lake County (who were furious that the game wasn't called sooner), 5-4. Drenched broadcaster Jesse Goldberg-Strassler called the game outside from The Outfield apartment complex. Justin Maese set a career high with 12 strikeouts in seven innings, his league-leading third complete game of the year (6 IP, 7 IP, 9 IP).

Personal: Brady's last name is pronounced "bass-o," with 'bass' like the fish rather than the instrument... got married during the 2020-2021 offseason after spending 2020 hiatus planning his wedding in addition to preparing for the 2021 season... made seven appearances for the Lugnuts in 2021 before suffering ACL tear... 687 days between MiLB appearances, June 15, 2021, and May 3, 2023, in returning from Tommy John.

Raising Expectations: An MLB.com from Athletics MiLB camp by Jonathan Mayo on April 28, 2021, carried a bit of surprising news on a couple of breakout pitchers, specifically, as Mayo wrote, "Brady Basso's role is changing. A lefty who signed for just \$75,000 as a 16th-round pick in the 2019 Draft out of Oklahoma State, Basso pitched almost exclusively in relief in college and threw well in that role in the Rookie-level Arizona League in 2019. Now that he's up to 95-96 mph with his fastball to go along with a curve that flashes plus and a work-in-progress changeup, he's going to get the chance to start." Melissa Lockard, writing for The Athletic on May 2, 2021, included Basso in her Lugnuts preview, writing, "Left-hander Brady Basso (2019, 16th round) opened a lot of eyes this spring with his fastball sitting at 95-97 mph."

Pro Debut: Brady pitched for Athletics Gold in the AZL after signing: 15 G, 1 GS, 1.64 ERA, 25 2/3 IP, 0 HR, 8 BB, 38 K... limited right-handed hitters to .194/.257/.313 in 74 PA, while lefties hit .250/.344/.286 in 32 PA... opposing base stealers were nabbed twice out of three attempts... made first professional start on 8/16/19, tossing three innings with 4 K's.

Draft Day: Basso was selected 494th overall in the 16th round of the 2019 draft from Oklahoma State... scout: Chris Reilly... signed for \$75,000... in the same round, two all-name players were drafted: the Tigers selected Kona Quiggle and the Blue Jays took Jackxarel Lebron... one of eight OSU Cowboys to be drafted in 2019... joins 2022 ninth-rounder Caeden Trenkle as Oklahoma State Cowboys on the current Lugnuts roster.

College Days: Brady was primarily a reliever at Oklahoma State (12 G, 2 GS as freshman; 18 G, 5 GS as sophomore; 14 G, 0 GS as a junior)... after a rough sophomore season (8.27 ERA), rebounded as a junior (1.64 ERA, 11.0 IP, 6 H, 16 K)... majored in finance in Stillwater with the intention of becoming a financial advisor after his playing career ends.

Let Your Babies Grow Up to be Cowboys: Oklahoma State players in MLB have included Allie Reynolds, Robin Ventura, Jeromy Burnitz, Pete Incaviglia, Mickey Tettleton, Mike Henneman, Doug Dascenzo, Andrew Heaney, Matt Hague and Jordy Mercer.

Baseball Runs in the Family: Brady's father, Mike, played in the minors for nine seasons in the San Diego Padres system, 1986-1994, rising as high as Triple-A... after retiring as a player, immediately began managing in 1995 at age 30, and managed in the Padres' org. from 1995-2000... joined the Toronto Blue Jays and managed in the Jays system in 2003-2006 and 2009... spent the next decade as an MLB scout before being let go by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2020.

Hometown: Hails from Pearland ("PAIR-land"), Texas, south of Houston... during senior year at Pearland H.S., posted 0.48 ERA, with 101 strikeouts in 57 innings... named All-District in football, averaging 29.9 yards per catch as a receiver with one primary route: go deep... also from Pearland H.S.: Kirk Dressendorfer, Clay Hensley and Robbie Weinhardt; Megan Thee Stallion spent her teen years living in Pearland.

In a Nutshell: Opened season as the Lugnuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though once again received a no-decision... the last Pitt Panther to start a game for the Nuts was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st overall pick in 2016, who made two starts for Lansing in 2016 and is now in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9 on social media.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

College Journey: Initially committed to University of Alabama, joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros)... upon transferring to Pitt, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.
