HATCHER COLLECTS FIVE HITS IN LOSS:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 7-5 on Saturday evening from Arvest Ballpark. Frisco (31-25, 75-50) jumped out to an early lead in the top of the second inning against Northwest Arkansas (27-28, 62-62) starter Ben Kudrna (2-3). **Cooper Johnson**, who walked to open the inning, scored on a wild pitch before an RBI single by **Alex De Goti** gave the Riders a 2-0 lead. After a scoreless first inning for **Andy Rodriguez** in his first professional start, the Naturals cut the deficit in half with a sacrifice fly from Peyton Wilson in the home half of the second. Rodriguez picked up the first two outs in the bottom of the third before issuing back-to-back walks, forcing **Jackson Kelley** into the game. Northwest Arkansas added a run to tie the game at 2-2 in the bottom of the third inning on a RBI single by Carter Jensen. Rodriguez ended his outing after 2.2 innings, surrendering two runs on two hits and four walks with a pair of punchouts. The RoughRiders regained the lead on a leadoff 415-foot home run from Johnson, his 12th homer of the season that gave Frisco a 3-2 advantage. **Josh Hatcher** extended the lead to 4-2 with an RBI single in the top of the fifth inning, plating **Maximo Acosta** with his third hit of the game. The Naturals chased Kelley from the game in the bottom of the fifth inning after opening the frame with a single and a walk. **Larson Kindreich** picked up two outs before walking a pair of batters, including a bases-loaded walk to Peyton Wilson. Dillan Shrum cleared the bases with a three-run double, giving the Naturals a 6-4 lead. **Damian Mendoza** took over in the home half of the sixth and allowed a leadoff single to Leonel Valera, who later scored on a double steal to push the Naturals lead to 7-4. The righty allowed just one run on two hits and a walk while fanning two across 3.0 innings. Trailing by three in the top of the ninth, the Riders saw the first three reach as Hatcher doubled home **Daniel Mateo** to make it a 7-5 game with nobody out. Beck Way retired the next three he faced, earning the save. Hatcher's five hits set a new career-high and paced the Riders offense. He also drove in two to lead the team. Acosta also recorded two hits as the top two in the order combined to go 7-for-10.

THESE ROUGHRIDERS ARE SO HOT RIGHT NOW:

The RoughRiders have been playing well recently, winning seven of their last 10 games. In the 10 games, Frisco is first in the Texas League in runs per game (6.2) and second in OBP (.361) while hitting 13 home runs in the 10 games. Frisco finished 13-14 in August, just falling short of a winning month in every month of the season for the first time in franchise history.

ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire for the RoughRiders recently. Over his last 37 games, Ortiz is hitting .309/.407/.532/.939 with seven doubles, eight home runs, 25 RBIs, 27 runs scored and 22 walks. In his last 18 games, he is batting .369 (24-for-65)/.494/.646/1.140 with three doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs, 15 walks, 16 strikeouts and 17 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. Since, he is hitting .294 with an .886 OPS, raising his batting average to .230 and a .705 OPS.

DOUBLE-A RON TAKING DOUBLE-A:

Aaron Zavala has been swinging the bat well as of late, hitting in 10 games in a row. Over that streak, he is batting .389 (14-for-36)/.452/.444/.896 with two doubles and 11 RBIs. Over his last 25 games, he is hitting .273/.369/.341/.710.

HOMER HAPPY:

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with **Luis Mieses** capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 19 home runs in the last 14 games, with those 19 home runs being second in the Texas League over the last 14 games. Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 93 across their 123 games (on pace for 104, which would be for the fifth-fewest in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 40-22 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco has a +69 run differential, a 4.12 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .763 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 35-28 with a 3.40 ERA, but a +23 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .654 OPS (9th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 13 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .314/.406/.543/.949 at home as opposed to .145/.218/.237/.547 on the road.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

ABOUT KOHL

-While he was born in Orem, Utah, Drake grew up in Sachse, Texas (25 minutes from Riders Field) and attended Wylie High School. The Wylie Pirates produced NFL players Kyle Fuller, Chris Givens, Kameron Kelly and Nikita Whitlock.

-Began his collegiate career at Arkansas Tech (2019), spent 2020 at San Joaquin Delta College in Stockton, California and ended with his final two seasons at Walters State Community College in Tennessee. WSCC is the same program which produced Texas LHP Brett Martin.

-In 2022, he was named NJCAA D1 Pitcher of the Year with WSCC after setting a program record with 160 strikeouts (15.43 K/9) while just walking 17 batters. He went 14-0 with a 1.93 ERA (20 ER/93.1 IP) in 17 starts as a redshirt sophomore.

-He and teammate Jake Knapp (3rd TM NJCAA All-American) led the pitching staff at WSCC, tying for the national lead with 14 wins. Knapp is now at UNC, but will miss the whole season with Tommy John Surgery.

-2022 Draft for Rangers as RoughRiders include: RHP Matt Bosky (2023), INF/OF Josh Hatcher (2023, 2024).

2024 SEASON

-Made first start of the season with Down East on 4/9/24, allowing just four baserunners (3 H, 1 BB) in 4.0 scoreless innings while striking out six.

-After spot start with Frisco on April 18th, he returned to Down East and pitched eight games for Hickory before coming back to Frisco for an August 25th start.

-Entering into August 25th, he has a 38 percent strikeout rate. That and his 131 strikeouts are first among Texas Rangers farmhands and his K/BB of 5.04 is fourth in the organization.

-In home debut with the RoughRiders on August 25th, Drake struck out six over six innings, allowing just two base runners (one hit, one walk), in win.

2023 SEASON

-Made his professional debut for the ACL Rangers (Rk.) and Down East (A), totaling a 2-5 record, 6.86 ERA (33 ER/46.2 IP), and 55 strikeouts (10.6 SO/9) over 14 G/4 GS.

-His only scoreless outing of the season came in third appearance (6/22/23 @ A-MRN): 3.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 5 K.

-Participated in Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.
