**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play a doubleheader for the fourth and fifth games in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, making up a rainout last night. The Nuts are 4-5 in Eastlake and 5-7 overall vs. the Caps, splitting a six-game series at Classic Park in late April/early May and losing two of the first three games of this series.

Thursday Night: Lugnuts 10, Captains 3. Jared McDonald belted a two-run homer in the 1st inning, a three-run homer in the 3rd and a two-run homer in the 5th, finishing 3-for-4 with a walk, three roundtrippers and seven RBIs in an easy Nuts victory. Euribiel Angeles added two singles and two doubles, helping Lansing stop a season high seven-game losing streak.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Captains tomorrow before returning home to host the Great Lakes Loons on Independence Day, taking a day off on Tuesday, and then continuing against the Loons through Sunday, July 10.

#### Lug•Notes

Let's Play Two... Again: This is the Lugnuts' eighth doubleheader of the season, their third in three series against Lake County. The Nuts have swept one doubleheader, split three, and been swept in three. The last time that the Lugnuts played a twinbill at Classic Park, Jeff Criswell came three outs from a no-hitter in Game 2, settling for a one-out complete game shutout on April 30th.

Historic for Big Mac: In his performance Thursday, Jared McDonald... 1) became the fourth Lugnuts player to ever hit three home runs in a game, matching the team record (the last to do so was Jason Dubois on August 30, 2001)... 2) came one RBI from matching the single game RBI record at eight, set twice before... 3) nearly doubled his home runs for the year, from four to seven... 4) nearly matched his home run total from all of last year, which was four... 5) increased his RBI total by 41% for the year, from 17 to 24... 6) became the 18th Minor Leaguer to hit three home runs in a game this season.

Compare and Contrast: The Nuts have scored ten runs in each of the last two games, the first a loss, the second a win. On Wednesday, the offense collected seven walks and ten base hits, hitting two home runs, one triple and one double. On Thursday, the offense collected five walks and 15 hits, hitting three homers and two doubles. The difference? On Wednesday, Lugnuts pitchers allowed 18 hits in a 14-10 loss; Lake County finished 9-for-18 with runners in scoring position. On Thursday, the Nuts limited the Caps to six hits in a 10-3 win; the Captains went 1-for-3 with runners in scoring position.

**Soder Pop:** C/1B **Tyler Soderstrom** is 2nd in the Midwest League with 49 RBIs, 4th with 120 total bases, 4th with 29 extra-base hits and tied for 5th with 13 home runs. Through three games of this series, Soderstrom has reached base via five hits and three walks, scoring five runs. Others among the league leaders include P **Kumar Nambiar**, who is tied for 2nd with 25 relief appearances, while P **Angello Infante** is tied for 4th with six saves.

Nuts to the Show: 6-foot-2, 280-pound pitcher Max Castillo (2018) made his MLB debut for the Toronto Blue Jays on June 19, becoming the 169th all-time Lugnut to reach The Show. He is the 8th former Lugnut to reach the Majors this year, joining Oakland A's pitchers Zach Logue (2018) and Zach Jackson (2017) and infielder Christian Lopes (2013); Toronto Blue Jays utilityman Vinny Capra (2018) and catcher Gabriel Moreno (2019); Seattle Mariners reliever Danny Young (2016) and Boston Red Sox starting pitcher Josh Winckowski (2019) as former Lugnuts to make it to the Major Leagues this year.

# 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

**Scouting Report:** Noted for fastball touching 97 mph, though slider is considered best pitch... posted 17% SwStr % at Stockton.

**Hometown:** Manhattan Beach is in southwestern Los Angeles County, bordering the Pacific Ocean, with a beach stretching over two miles... motto: "Sun, Sand, Sea"... city name was decided by coin flip, with landowners George Peck and John Merrill arguing between the names Shore Acres and Manhattan; they flipped to decide the name, and Manhattan won... the postmaster added "Beach" to the end to differentiate it.

Glory Days: Attended Loyola High School (the "Cubs"), a private all-boys Roman Catholic prep school in Los Angeles that first opened in 1865... Loyola also produced Royals broadcaster Ryan Lefebvre, volleyball great Sinjin Smith, linebacker Anthony Barr, and New York Giants outfielder Fred Snodgrass, who played with Christy Mathewson on John McGraw's powerful Giants teams... Beers distinguished himself at Loyola, named a 2017 Perfect Game First Team All-State, First Team All-Region and Third Team All-American.
