# **UPCOMING GAMES & PROBABLE PITCHERS**

YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their fourth straight game, falling, 4-3, to the RubberDucks. Kahlil Watson opened the scoring with a solo homer in the first and Yordys Valdes added a run with a sac fly later in the inning. In the fourth, **Dilan Rosario** hit an RBI double and **Damon Dues** hit into an error that scored **Brett Auerbach** to tie the game, 2-2. In the bottom of the fourth, Milan Tolentino moved the RubberDucks back ahead, 3-2, with an RBI double. In the sixth inning **Luis Toribio** tied the game, 3-3, with a sac fly. The RubberDucks took a 4-3 lead in the eighth with a bases-loaded walk by Valdes. **Hayden Birdsong** started and threw four innings with five strikeouts, allowing three runs. **Wil Jensen** pitched two scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, in the fourth of a six-game series at Canal Park. The two teams split a series at The Diamond from April 9-14. Along with this series, the Flying Squirrels return to Akron for three games from July 19-21 following the All-Star Break. The RubberDucks return to Richmond from Sept. 3-8 for six games. Richmond enters having lost four straight and Akron has won 10 consecutive games.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost four straight games since Sunday after going 7-2 in their previous nine games from April 18-27. Last week, they picked up their first series win of the year, taking four-of-six against the Baysox. The Flying Squirrels have gone 6-5 in their last 11 games since April 20, including winning four straight from April 20-24.

**THE RUBBERDUCKS** have won 10 consecutive games, the longest win streak by an Eastern League team this year. It is also the longest win streak for Akron since winning 11 in a row in August 2016 en route to winning the Eastern League championship. Last week, they picked up their first six-game sweep in franchise history, taking the entire series at Altoona. For the season, Akron's pitching staff leads the Eastern League in ERA (2.31), shutouts (5) and WHIP (1.16). Akron's roster features five of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including OF Chase DeLauter (No. 1), OF Petey Halpin (No. 14), RHP Andrew Walters (No. 18), 3B Dayan Frias (No. 19) and SS Kahlil Watson (No. 22). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes five Akron players, including DeLauters (No. 1), Watson (No. 14), Halpin (No. 15), Walters (No. 25) and Frias (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his fifth start of the season. He was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday after throwing seven perfect innings in his start last Saturday night against the Baysox, retiring all 21 batters he faced with four strikeouts on 68 pitches. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. *For more on Bertrand*, see *page two*.

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Ryan Webb makes his fifth start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He pitched on Saturday at Altoona and allowed three runs over five innings with five strikeouts. He pitched at The Diamond on April 10 and allowed two runs in 3.2 innings with six strikeouts in his Double-A debut. He spent most of the 2023 season with the High-A Lake County Captains, going 3-4 with a 3.29 ERA in 17 starts. He was with Low-A Lynchburg in 2022 for 11 games. Webb was selected in the fourth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Guardians out of the University of Georgia.

**AWESOME APRIL:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (7,923) and Worcester (7,412).

RISPY BUSINESS: In their last seven games since April 25, the Flying Squirrels have hit .122 (5-for-41) with runners in scoring position, averaging 2.1 runs per game (15 total runs). In this week's series in Akron, Richmond is batting .047 (1-for-21) with runners in scoring position and averaging 1.7 runs per game (5 total runs). After being shut out on Tuesday, the Flying Squirrels scored their only two runs on Tuesday on a pair of solo homers.

**BISHOP BASHING:** In his five-game hit streak dating back to last Saturday, **Hunter Bishop** is batting .368 (7-for-19) with a homer, three doubles, four runs scored and one RBI. He has picked up two hits in each of his last two games at Akron. On Wednesday night, he hit a solo homer for his second Double-A home run. Bishop is playing his first Double-A season and his first season overall since 2022 after missing all of last year with an injury.

WILL POWER: Will Wilson saw his 11-game on-base streak end on Thursday night. That streak is tied for the longest by a Richmond batter this season. Over his last 12 games since April 17, Wilson is batting .333 (15-for-45) with a homer, three doubles, seven walks, six RBIs and five runs scored. Dating back to 2021, Wilson has played 158 games for the Flying Squirrels over parts of four seasons.

**PITCH PERFECT:** John Michael Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday for April 22-28. On Saturday, he pitched seven perfect innings against the Baysox at The Diamond, retiring all 21 batters he faced in order on 68 pitches. He is the first player on Richmond's roster to win one of the Eastern League weekly awards this season.

**STRONG ARMS:** The Richmond pitching staff has combined for 227 strikeouts this season, third-most in the Eastern League, and is ranked fourth with a 3.29 ERA. Flying Squirrels starters have combined for a 3.55 ERA this year, which is fifth-best in the league. The Richmond bullpen has the second-lowest ERA (3.06) in the league, trailing only Akron (2.56).

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** There are five relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 10 IP), three Richmond pitchers rank in the top 10 in ERA. **Tanner Kiest** is fourth with a 0.77 ERA (1 ER/11.2 IP), **Evan Gates** is fifth with a 0.79 ERA (1 ER/11.1 IP) and **Wil Jensen** is ninth with a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP), which is the lowest in the league for any pitcher who has worked at least 15.0 innings. **José Cruz** has posted a 1.17 ERA (1 ER/7.2 IP) in his six outings and **Nick Garcia** has a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP) in his eight appearances.

BIDDING FOR HISTORY: Richmond starters Hayden Birdsong and John Michael Bertrand each worked hitless starts over the weekend. On Friday night, Birdsong threw five innings and the bullpen carried a no-hit bid into the ninth inning. On Saturday, Bertrand worked through seven perfect innings before the Baysox broke up the perfect game and no-hitter in the eighth inning. There has only been one no-hitter pitched by the home team in the 40-year history of The Diamond, which was a seven-inning no-no in 2013 by Jack Snodgrass and Daryl Maday. The last time a Richmond team completed a no-hitter at home was on June 1,1977 when Richmond Braves pitcher Mickey Mahler no-hit the Toledo Mud Hens at Parker Field. The only other nine-inning no-hitter thrown by the home team in the current location, which dates back to 1954, was thrown by Al Downing and the Richmond Virginians on May 12, 1962 against the Syracuse Chiefs. The only perfect game by a Richmond professional baseball team was thrown in a seven-inning game by Pete Smith for the Richmond Braves in 1992 at Rochester.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **John Michael Bertrand** is fourth in ERA (2.03), fifth in innings pitched (26.2) and eighth in WHIP (1.05). **Carson Ragsdale** is seventh in ERA (2.42), tied for sixth in strikeouts (27) and tied for eighth in BAA (189). **Hayden Birdsong** is fourth in strikeouts (29) and seventh in WHIP (1.03).

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Reggie Crawford (No. 9), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20) and Sugastey (No. 24).
