SAINT PAUL, MINN. – Outfielder Drew Waters produced his second straight four-hit game Tuesday afternoon and starting pitcher Daniel Lynch fired 6.0 scoreless innings as the Storm Chasers beat the Saints 6-1 in the series opener at CHS Field.

In his fourth Major League rehab start with Omaha, Lynch cruised through six innings, as the southpaw held St. Paul to just three hits with no walks and five strikeouts on just 61 pitches, including 47 strikes (77% strikes).

In his 11th start of a Major League rehab assignment, Waters opened the game with double on the pitch, then scored moments later on an RBI single from Nick Loftin, giving the Storm Chasers a lead they held the rest of the game.

Greyson Jenista opened the 2nd inning with a double in his first Chasers at-bat, then scored as Dairon Blanco followed with a double of his own four pitchers later... two batters after that, Angelo Castellano singled Blanco in for a 3-0 lead.

Blanco drove in his second run of the game in the 4th inning, with a 455-foot solo homer that stretched the lead to 4-0... after Waters singled to lead off the 5th, his third hit of the day, he came around to score on a sac fly from Loftin, stretching Omaha's led to 5-0.

The Chasers added one more run in the 9th inning, again driven in by Loftin, as he doubled home Waters, who doubled two batters earlier, for a 6-0 lead.

Behind Lynch's six scoreless innings, 2022 Saints pitcher Evan Sisk threw 2.0 scoreless innings and struck out a pair, preserving Omaha's shutout into the 9th inning.

The shutout fell short for the Storm Chasers, as the Saints opened the bottom of the 9th with a pair of hits against Collin Snider, then scored a run on a groundout, though Snider retired his final three batters to end the game.

With 3 runs batted in, Loftin has a team-best 17 RBI in 18 games in May, tied for ninth in the league this month in RBI ... Blanco's two hits bring him to a .368 average in May (14-for-38) with five extra-base hits and five RBI.

NOTES AND NUGGETS RUSHING WATERS

Outfielder **Drew Waters**' rehab assignment with Omaha is a tale of two halves.

Over his first 6 rehab games (May 9 to 16), he went 1-for-22 (.045) with 1 double, 1 walk and 7 strikeouts.

walk and 7 strikeouts. Over his last 7 rehab games (May 17 to 23), he's gone 15-for-27 (.556) with 5 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers, 3 walks and 6 strikeouts, including three 4-hit games.

RELIEF AID

Over the last 10 game, Omaha has had one of the best bullpens in Triple-A.

Since May 10, Omaha's relievers have combined for a 3.05 ERA (15 ER in 44.1 IP) that is good for 5th among all Triple-A teams.

7 of the 10 relievers last week did not allow an earned run, giving Omaha its best bullpen ERA of any six-game series this season, 2.54 (7 have been played).

Since May 10, 28 of 40 relievers that have come into a game have had a scoreless outing, including 9 of 2.0+ innings.

IT'S GONNA BE MAY

While April was a slow month offensively for the Chasers, much of the lineup has turned things up in the month of May, including **Nick Loftin** and **Dairon Blanco**.

In May, Loftin is slashing .338/.402/.507 (24-for-71) with 17 runs batted ... that contrasts to a .220/.244/.402 (18-for-82) slashline last month, with 11 RBI ... this month, he leads Omaha with 17 RBI, 24 hits and 36 total bases.

Loftin's active 7-game hitting streak and 11-game on base streak are his longest of the season and the longest active streaks amongst Storm Chasers hitters ... his 7-game hitting streak is tied for Omaha's longest this year ... since his 11-game on-base streak started on May 10, he has 15 hits and 7 walks, Omaha's 2nd-longest this year.

In May, Blanco is slashing .368/.547/.632 (14-for-38) with 13 walks hits ... that contrasts to a .265/.359/.368 (18-for-68) slashline last month, with 7 walks ... this month, he leads Omaha with 13 walks and 15 steals, plus a .368 average, .547 OBP and 1.179 OPS.

YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

While they didn't steal a base yesterday, the Chasers have 82 steals in 44 games (average of 1.86 SB/game) and have been caught just 15 times for a success rate of 84.54%.

9 92 steals rank 2nd in the International League, 2nd among all Triple-A teams and 10th in Minor League Baseball ... among Triple-A teams, only the Worcester Red Sox (85) have more steals, while the Lynchburg Hillcats lead the minors (123) and Kansas City's Single-A affiliate, the Columbia Fireflies are 2nd in Mil.B (107).

With one steal Sunday, outfielder **Dairon Blanco** has 28 stolen bases this season (in 31 tries), which is 1st in the league, 1st in Triple-A and tied 4th in Mil.B ... Blanco has stolen 15 bases in 13 games this month ... he already has six games of 2+ steals.

Samad Taylor added a steal Sunday as well and is 2nd on the team behind Blanco with 22 steals (in 26 attempts) and ranks 4th in the league and 4th in Triple-A and is tied 11th in the Minors ... he's stolen 10 bases in 19 games this month.

The Chasers have stolen at least one base in 30 of 44 games, with multiple steals in 26 games and five occasions of 5+ steals.

MANAGER: Mike Jirschele • #23

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.



PITCHING COACH: Dane Johnson • #59

- p Dane Johnson enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.
- He previously spent one season in the Miami Marlins organization (2019) as a Pitching Consultant and 19 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays as a Minor League Pitching Coach from 2000-03, Pitching Coordinator from 2004-14 and Major League Bullpen Coach from 2015-18.
- Prior to entering coaching, spent 15 years as a player, including over 280 games in the Minor Leagues and parts of three seasons in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox (1994), Blue Jays (1996) and Oakland Athletics (1997), also playing two seasons (1990-1991) in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Johnson and his wife, Gina, reside in Palm Harbor, Florida. They have two children: a daughter, Madison (31), and son, Cobi (27).



HITTING COACH: BIJAN RADEMACHER • #52

- **Bijan Rademacher** (bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).
- Prior to coaching, he spent eight years playing professionally (2012-2019), spanning seven seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization (2012-18) and slashed .280/.361/.402 over 702 career MiLB games, reaching as high as Triple-A. He also played one season in independent baseball (2019) with the New Britain Bees in the Atlantic League, in addition to an offseason in the Mexican Pacific Winter League.
- g Over 243 career Triple-A games with the Iowa Cubs, he played 11 games at Werner Park and was a .378 hitter (14-for-37) with one homer and 5 runs batted in while playing in Omaha.
- Rademacher lives in Tempe, Arizona with his wife Melissa.



BENCH COACH: David Noworyta - #33 (3rd Base Coach)

- David Noworyta (Nova-REE-tah) enters his second year in the Royals organization and first as Omaha's Bench Coach, after making his coaching debut in 2022 as the Assistant Hitting Coach for the River Bandits Kansas City's High-A affiliate.
- Prior to coaching, he spent four years playing professionally (2018-21), including three minor league seasons in the Detroit Tigers organization (2018-20), and one with the Independent Pioneer League's Billings Mustangs in 2021. Before signing with Detroit in 2018, Noworyta graduated from the University of Hawaii with a bachelor's degree in communications and journalism, and played in parts of three seasons for their baseball team.
- Moworyta attended Holy Cross Academy (N.J.), where he played baseball and basketball, and was selected by the Royals in the 37th round of the 2014 MLB Draft. He resides in Hainesport, N.J. in the offseason.

- James Stone is entering his fifth season as the Certified Athletic Trainer for the Storm Chasers after serving the previous seven seasons with the Wilmington Blue Rocks (Royals High-A), including the 2015 season, in which he was named Carolina League Athletic Trainer of the Year.
- He joined the Kansas City organization in 2010 as the athletic trainer for the Class-A Burlington Bees. He came to the Royals after spending one season with the Central Valley Coyotes (Fresno, California) in Arena Football 2.
- g Stone worked three seasons in the Florida Marlins organization, with stops in Jupiter (2008), Greensboro (2007) and Jamestown (2006), winning New York-Penn League Trainer of the Year honors in 2006.
- He was the Strength and Conditioning Coach for the Baltimore Orioles Class-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2005.
- Stone graduated with a bachelor's of science in kinesiology from Cal State-Northridge. He resides in Simi Valley, California with his dog, Ozzie.

- Yannick Plante is entering his third season as the Strength & Conditioning Coach for the Storm Chasers, after being slated to serve in that role with Northwest Arkansas in 2020.
- g He began with the Kansas City Organization in 2019 as the athletic trainer for the Burlington Royals (Advanced Rookie, Appalachian League. He was then a staff member of the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League in the fall of 2019.
