Leading Off

Reading continues a six-game series and 12-game homestand tonight against New Hampshire. The Fisher Cats lead the season-series 13-6.

Looking Back

Reading fell 6-3 last night to New Hampshire in the opening game of the series. The Fisher Cats struck early with four runs in the first and Reading could not battle back. Ricky Tiedemann was stellar, striking out 11 R-Phils over 3.2 innings of work. In total, Reading hitters struck out 18 times, which is a season-high and their most since Sept. 11, 2022, also against New Hampshire. Jhailyn Ortiz had two hits and an RBI for Reading and Ethan Wilson drove in a run as well. Tommy McCollum and Dominic Pipkin each pitched scoreless frames out of the bullpen.

Home Run Merchants

Much like their parent club, the Phillies, Reading has hit a boatload of home runs in August. With two days left in the month, the Fightin Phils have slugged 36 long balls in August, which is tied for the league lead with this week's opponent New Hampshire. Overall, Reading is third in the league in homers with 145, which paces for 165 for the season. This comes after Reading hit just 119 last season, which was last in the Eastern League.

Shutting It Down

Reading's shutout win on Sunday was its third shutout win of the season. It was also the second one against Harrisburg, with both coming in the Sunday series finales. The R-Phils also tossed two two-hitters last week, with the other led by seven innings from Mick Abel.

Parkinson Powers

David Parkinson was stellar again on Sunday, tossing six-shutout innings. Dating back to July 7, Parkinson is 6-1 with a 1.58 ERA over nine starts. In August, Parkinson went 3-1 with a 1.26 ERA over five starts and only allowed earned-runs in one start (Aug. 22). His 1.26 ERA in August ranks second in the Eastern League. Parkinson's league ranks now sit at the following: ERA (3rd-3.74), Wins (5th-8), Strikeouts (8th-114), IP (4th-110.2), BAA (7th-.248), WHIP (8TH-1.35), WPCT (3RD-.615).

Jhailyn's Strong Week

Jhailyn Ortiz's strong stretch continued with two hits last night. Over his last five games, Ortiz is hitting .389 with four extra-base hits and has driven in eight runs. Ortiz also owns a five-game hitting streak, which is a new season high.

Around the Organization

The Phillies beat the Angels 12-7, thanks to five home runs last night. Lehigh Valley beat Syracuse 9-8 as Christian Pache had two hits and two RBI. Jersey Shore beat Aberdeen 3-2 as Cole Moore doubled and Gabriel Cotto went five-strong innings. Clearwater is postponed through at least Thursday due to the Hurricane. The DSL Phillies fell to the DSL Pirates 10-9 in ten innings to conclude their season in the DSL Semifinals.

Welcoming the Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight with a 20-29 record in the second half, which is last in the Eastern League, and 55-62 overall record. Last week, New Hampshire won just one-of-five games with Binghamton and Sunday was cancelled. Next week, the Fisher Cats remain on the road at Bowie before finishing the season at home against Somerset. Five of the Blue Jays top-30 prospects are on New Hampshire: Ricky Tiedemann (1), Alan Roden (7), Chad Dallas (14), Damiano Palmegiani (19) and Mason Fluharty (28). Tiedemann ranks No. 33 on MLB Pipeline's Top 100.

Cats Pitcher

Michael Dominguez makes his fifth start for New Hampshire. He is 1-0 with a 3.18 ERA (17 IP, 10 H, 9 BB, 20 SO). He last started on Aug. 24 and allowed one run on two hits, with nine strikeouts in a no decision against Binghamton. He began the year with High-A Vancouver and was promoted to New Hampshire on Aug. 1. With Vancouver, Dominguez was 7-2 with a 3.65 ERA over 15 starts. He split 2022 between Vancouver and Single-A Dunedin, going 1-6 with a 5.02 ERA over 20 games/18 starts. The Blue Jays drafted Dominguez in the 15th round of the 2020 draft out of Jefferson High School in Tampa, Florida.

Earned first win since May 5 on Aug. 4, throwing 5.1 shutout innings at Hartford. Pitched five shutout innings against Altoona on July 20, which was first start in 21 days. From June 2 though July 20, pitched six-straight starts of more than five innings. First two wins came in back-to-back strong starts. Six-innings of one run ball on Apr. 29 against Altoona, and followed with six-innings with one-run allowed on May 5 at Hartford. Went career-high seven innings last time out at Harrisburg, allowing just two hits and striking out three Senators hitters.

2022: Split season between high-A Jersey Shore and double-A Reading. Started 18 games for Blue Claws, going 7-8 with a 4.01 ERA. Had 103 strikeouts over 85.1 innings and just 38 walks. Struck out 10.9 hitters per nine innings. Promoted to double-A Reading on August 20. Made five starts for Reading, going 1-3 with a 3.52 ERA. Formed rotation with Phillies' top-prospects Andrew Painter and Griff McGarry. Struck out season-high ten hitters on July 29 at Wilmington, while still with Jersey Shore.

Career: Began pro career with single-A Clearwater in 2021. Made 14 starts for Threshers and went 1-3 with 4.43 ERA. Struck out 66 hitters over 44.2 innings (13.3 K/9) and hel opposing hitters to a .174 average. Made debut on May 5 and threw last game of 2021 on July 21. Was placed on 7-day IL on August 3 and would miss rest of season with shoulder troubles.

Draft/Prep: Selected by Phillies in First Round (No. 15) in 2020 Draft out of Jesuit High School in Portland Oregon. Missed most of Senior season due to Covid. Abel was ranked as the top high school pitcher in the 2020 Draft class. Barely pitched at Jesuit, but showcased on summer showcase circuit in high school. Growing up, helped Cedar Mill Little League Team win a state title. Played 1B and pitcher for Jesuit High School. Sophomore season cut short due to injury to non-throwing shoulder that required surgery. Junior Year, went 10-0 with 1.26 ERA and 111 strikeouts over 72.1 innings. Led team to State Title and was named Oregon Gatorage Player of the Year and Junior All-American by Max Preps in 2019. Also in 2019, was selected for U-18 USA Team and going into 2020. Abel was selected a preseason All-American by MaxPreps and Baseball America. Ranked as fourth-best collegiate prospect in nation. Committed to Oregon State after Freshman Year of high school.

Scouting Report: With a tall frame, Abel projects as a right-handed starter. Has a quick arm and fastball sits in mid-to-upper 90s. Also showcases a mid-80s slider, which is a plus pitch for Abel. Has a slower curveball and changeup. As Abel develops, scouts look for him to hone in on his command and improve strike throwing. Growing in that area could help him reach ceiling as front-half of the rotation big league starter.
