Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Rorik Maltrud** to the mound tonight, looking to bounce back from last night's loss (have not had consecutive losses since 4/12-4/14). Buffalo will counter with RHP **Grant Rogers**. Columbus is 11-5 (.688) versus right handers this year. Rogers has never pitched against the Clippers in his career, as tonight will be his fifth career start in Triple-A.

vs. the Bisons

Since 5/23/09, the Clippers are 41-66 (.383) against the Bisons, despite being outscored by only 39 runs (480-519). Among those 107G, the Clippers are 19-22 (.463) in games decided by at least four runs and 22-44 (.333) in games decided by three or fewer. In Buffalo, the Clippers have been victorious in 11 of the last 16G, winning both series played since the expansion of the International League.

Bison Ball

Neither team homered last night, marking the second straight completely homerless game the Clippers have played in (consecutive homerless games at Worcester from 4/8-4/9). In 11G on the road this season (average temp: 54 degrees), the Clippers have hit 10HR while giving up 8HR (collective SLG: .364). At home (12G, 71 degrees), Columbus has hit 22HR and given up 12HR (.472SLG).

High, But Not *That* High

Columbus batters racked up 14K last night, hitting double digits for the 12th time this year, to move into a tie for 5th most strikeouts in the IL (213). Along with 137BB (2nd) and 33HR (4th), the Clippers are the only team in the IL to rank among the top five in each of the three true outcome categories. However, their 40.8% rate ranks a distant 4th in the IL (Durham leads at 47.1% due to an astronomical 273K).

Walters Rehab

Andrew Walters (right lat surgery) has remained with the Clippers on rehab, as **Hunter Gaddis** and **George Valera** ended their assignments last Monday. Walters has pitched five times so far, giving up a homer in two outings (2-run shot on 4/7 at Worcester and a solo bomb on 4/10 at Worcester). All-time in Columbus, 63% (9) of his 16ER allowed have come on 6HR (one every 33.3BF).

Under the Radar

Petey Halpin extended his hit streak to 9G last night (.293, 12x41, since 4/12), while reaching base in his 11th straight (.321OBP since 4/10). Halpin has reduced his strikeout rate to 21% (11K in 53PA) over the course of his on base streak, compared to 30% (15K in 50PA) through his first 10G of the season. His run scored on Tuesday was the 100th of his Clipper career (2nd in the IL since debut, 3/28/25).

Discerning Eye

Travis Bazzana earned his second straight multi-walk game last night (5BB in 10PA this series, 5BB in 41PA of 9G prior), boosting his walk rate to 17% (24% last year). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/12/25, Bazzana has walked more times than any other player in the IL (46; 4th best OBP, .414). Over his last 10G, he has reached base in all (.532OBP), while hitting .405 (15x37) with 8XBH (.676SLG).

Get Out There

Though **CJ Kayfus** has started at first base over 70% of the time in his MiLB career (142), he'll be in right tonight, as **Dom Nunez** will get the infield start (Nunez, **Kody Huff**, **Dayan Frias**, **Juan Brito** and **Nolan Jones** have combined to start at first 20 times this year and 121 times in their careers, 5% of starts). Dating to 7/10/25, Kayfus has just 4RBI in 16G at Triple-A (40RBI in first 57G with Columbus).

Slump Town

Dom Nunez was hitless last night (hitless in 52% of games in Clipper career, 80 of 153), but did draw a pair of walks (12% walk rate this year, compared to 17% last year). **Dayan Frias** was 0x4 last night and is hitless in 21AB since homering on 4/16 vs. Iowa (3x40 in last 11G; 3x4 in game prior, 4/8). Among 119 IL hitters with at least 70PA, Frias ranks 117th in average, 115th in OBP and 117th in SLG.

Bad Dream

Last night's multi-error game was the seventh of the year for the defense (all since 4/3; .964 fielding percentage in the last 17G, worst in the IL), as they now have 21E through 23G. Last year, the Clippers made multiple mistakes in only 14G total and it took until game #46 for them to reach 21E. Columbus pitchers (6E) and catchers (5E), have paired to form the worst defensive battery in the IL (.955).

This Date in Clipper History

4/23/2007

Joel Hanrahan, Winston Abreu and **Chris Booker** combined for a 2-hit shutout in Durham, giving the Clippers a 1-0 win. Abreu's performance (3.0IP, 0H, 8K), was the start of a 13 appearance scoreless streak with the Clippers that covered 21.0IP. During that time he struck out 21 batters over a nine inning stretch and at one point retired 30 of 34 batters without allowing a hit.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,417 to 1,368).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 30-31 (.492) in pitch reviews, with batters going 18-21 (.462) and pitchers/catchers going 12-10 (.545). They have run out of challenges in 13G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 0-1 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-34 when playing past regulation (.595, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 84G to require extra play, 67 have been resolved after one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 16th in the IL this year (.973), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 12G this season (7-5, .583), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Milan Tolentino moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 4/7 at Worcester and those runners came around to tie the game in an eventual win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-22 (.792) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-1 (.500, blew 7-run lead in loss) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsports in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 398-417 (.488), 368-371 with Columbus (.498).
