## FROM THE CROW'S NEST

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Marauders rode a stellar mound performance by **Valentin Linarez** and an early rally to a 6-1 win over Palm Beach on Friday night... Linarez tossed 6 IP scoreless and matched his season-high with 7 strikeouts... It was Linarez' team-leading fifth quality start of the season... **Sergio Campana** went 2-for-4 with two doubles and two RBI... **Tres Gonzalez**, **Wyatt Hendrie**, and **Bubba Chandler** each contributed run-scoring hits in a three-run first inning... **Tsung-Che Cheng** added a sacrifice fly in the fourth inning and went 1-for-2, extending his hit streak to seven straight games... **Jack Brannigan** went 0-for-3 with a walk, ending a four-game hit streak but stretching his on-base streak to five games... The win, along with another Tampa loss, pushed Bradenton to a two-game lead over the Tarpons for first place in the FSL West.

**THE OPPONENT:** In their last head-to-head matchup, the Marauders split their six-game series with the Cardinals the week of May 16 at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium... The Cardinals are coming off a five-games-to-one series win last week over Jupiter... The team's roster currently features two players in *Baseball America's* latest top 30 prospect rankings for the St. Louis organization: RHP Tink Hence (#7) and C Leonardo Bernal (#29)... *BA* lists the Cardinals' farm system as #18 in baseball.

**THE Z-MAN RETURNS:** **Tsung-Che Cheng's** current seven-game hit streak is the longest active hit streak by a Marauder... He is batting .462 with a 1.213 OPS during the streak and has also hit safely in 17 of his last 19 games... Cheng is also Bradenton's active leader with 20 multi-hit games... After slashing just .218/.327/.310 in July, the 21-year-old from Taiwan is slashing .438/.558/.625 in 10 games in August.

**FLYING HIGH AGAIN:** The Marauders have won two straight series and five of their last six... The team is now five games over .500 for the first time since end-of-day May 1 (13-8)... With Thursday's win and Tampa's loss to Dunedin, Bradenton took sole possession of first place in the FSL West for the first time since July 13.

**RUM RUNNERS:** The Marauders have 26 stolen bases in their last 14 games and rank second among FSL teams with 156 stolen bases... **Sergio Campana** leads the team with 24 SB, good for seventh-most in the FSL... He's trailed by **Tsung-Che Cheng** (22), **Jase Bowen** (20), **Juan Jerez** (12), and **Deivis Nadal** (11).

**TOP PIRATES PROSPECTS:** The Marauders roster currently includes three prospects in *Baseball America's* Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: LHP **Anthony Solometo** (#10), RHP/DH **Bubba Chandler** (#11), and OF **Rodolfo Nolasco** (#28)... *Baseball America* lists the Pirates' farm system as the third-best in baseball.

**FIELD STAFF:** Manager **Jonathan Johnston**, the 2021 Low-A Southeast Manager of the Year, is in his second season at the helm for the Marauders... Former major leaguer **Yorman Bazardo** is the club's first-year pitching coach after spending 2021 as a pitching coach for the FCL Pirates... Former Pirate **Mendy López** joins as hitting coach after serving as the Pirates' Latin American Field Coordinator in 2021... **Casey Harms** is the Marauders' Integrated Baseball Performance Coach after a collegiate coaching career in the Northwest League (Waterloo Bucks, 2019-20) and at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018)... **Gustavo Omaña** is the Marauders' Development Coach after serving on staff at Triple-A Indianapolis in 2021.

**HITTING TRIPLE DIGITS:** The 2022 season marks the 100th year of operation for LECOM Park, known as City Park upon opening in 1923. It has served as a spring training home for six different MLB franchises, including the Pirates since 1969. Baseball hall-of-famers who once called the historic park their spring home include Hank Aaron, Roberto Clemente, Dizzy Dean, Rogers Hornsby, Reggie Jackson, and more.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS/INFO

**2022:** In season debut April 10 at Dunedin, pitched behind rehabbing RHP Luis Oviedo: two singles and a HBP led to a sac fly in the second inning; after a scoreless third, allowed a double, two-run homer, and another double, was lifted after a strikeout... April 17 vs Lakeland, allowed a walk in the first inning that led to two RBI-doubles, allowed a solo homer in the second, retired the next seven straight batters but was lifted after allowing another solo home run in the fourth... April 24 at Daytona, held Tortugas scoreless over first three innings (worked around four baserunners) before allowing an RBI-single in the fourth, exiting with two out and bases loaded (all runners stranded by Cristian Charle)... Has gone 5 IP in each of last 4 GS... May 22 at Palm Beach: allowed just two unearned runs (2 errors) and all 6 hits allowed were singles... June 15 at Fort Myers: after 3 scoreless IP to begin outing, allowed 4 runs on 4 hits, a walk, and an error (pulled with 2 out in 4th)... Became the first Marauder this season to turn in back-to-back quality starts (June 1 at Lakeland, June 8 vs Clearwater)... **Has allowed 2 or fewer runs in 11 of last 13 starts.**

**2021:** In stateside debut, split season between starting rotation and bullpen, posting a 1.09 WHIP and holding opponents to a .224 AVG...

**2020:** (No MiLB season)

**2019:** Returned to DSL Pirates 1 and worked primarily as a starter, limiting opponents to a .240 AVG in 12G (11GS)...

**2018:** In professional debut season, pitched to a 1.64 ERA and 1.00 WHIP out of the bullpen for DSL Pirates 1, holding opponents to a .147 AVG...

**PERSONAL:** While growing up, idolized Pedro Martinez... Names Phillies righty Zack Wheeler as the current major leaguer he looks up to most... Born and raised in Santiago, Dominican Republic, home of 2003 American League Rookie of the Year (and former Marauders coach) Angel Berroa, former major league outfielder Carlos Gomez, and 2021 Low-A Southeast Player of the Year Endy Rodriguez...
