ON THE BUMP: Jacob Misorowski will start for the Sounds in the rubber match on opening weekend against the Jumbo Shrimp. The Brewers' no. 4-rated prospect finished fourth in the organization in strikeouts a year ago with 127. He was a non-roster invitee to Major League Spring Training and went 3-0 (7.2 IP, 7 H, 8 ER, 9 K, 5 BB). The numbers got a bit inflated during his last game in Phoenix when he allowed four runs (all earned) on three hits in 1.2 IP but still earned the win over the Cubs as the Brewers went on to win 9-7.

At the time of his promotion to Nashville from Double-A Biloxi on August 3, 2024, he was leading the Brewers farm system in strikeouts and BAA, holding opponents to a .182 AVG. He earned Southern League Pitcher of the Week three different times throughout the course of last season, making him one of three pitchers to win 3+ POTW honors (Quinn Priester, STL & Yilber Diaz, ARI) and the only one to do it in the same league.

He earned his first and only career save against the Jumbo Shrimp last year on August 20th when he pitched two innings in relief with a pair of strikeouts and no hits allowed.

OLD CRAIGG: New Year, same Craig. Brewers' no. 19-rated prospect Craig Yoho picked up right where he left off in 2024. After posting a 0.94 ERA in 48 appearances across three levels of the Brewers farm system last year, Yoho worked 1.1 IP without an earned run allowed on Saturday night with a pair of strikeouts. Yoho's 42.4 strikeout rate and his ERA were tops among all 1,300 minor leaguers with at least 50.0 IP in 2024. It was the 13th scoreless appearance in 15 Triple-A games for Yoho since making his Nashville debut on August 9, 2024.

EIGHT IT GREAT: Logan Henderson matched his Triple-A high with eight strikeouts on Saturday night. From the time he made his first start of the year with High-A Wisconsin (May 24) through his final start with Biloxi (August 2) before his promotion to Triple-A last year, nobody in the Brewers farm system had more strikeouts than Henderson's 102. He posted five starts with at least eight strikeouts last season and has 13 such games in his 45 career starts so far.

OH BABY, A TRIPLE: Ernesto Martinez Jr. collected the first triple of the season for the Sounds and the 12th of his professional career. His triple also gave him a hit in both games to start 2025. He was the only Nashville player who was in the lineup on Opening Day to also get a hit on Saturday night.

RISPY-BUSINESS: The Sounds were 0-for-11 with runners in scoring position against Jacksonville in the loss on Saturday. Nashville left the bases loaded in the bottom of the sixth with only one out before John Rooney was able to retire the side. The team ranked fifth in the International League last year, hitting a collective .306 in 160 at-bats with the bases loaded, which was also the fifth-most across the league in 2024.

IN A PINCH: Adam Hall served as a pinch hitter for the Sounds when he entered the game in the seventh inning and proceeded to single up the middle. Nashville only used seven pinch hit at-bats in all of 2024 and the team combined to go 1-for-7 with a double, two walks, and four strikeouts.

THAT ONE KATY PERRY SONG: Nashville pitchers combined to issue nine walks and hit three batters on Saturday night against Jacksonville. The team had 10 games last year with 9+ walks. They also had 14 strikeouts. Nashville & Gwinnett are the only two teams that have had 11+ strikeouts by their pitching staff in both games to start the season.

C-ROD: Friday night marked the eighth time in Carlos Rodriguez's 78-game career that he has had 7+ strikeouts while working 5.0 IP or less.

OOOOH, THEY STEALIN': The Sounds swiped five bases on Friday night including two each from Jared Oliva and Raynel Delgado. The five stolen bases are the most on an Opening Day by a Sounds team since 2005 when MLB Stats Portal began tracking team high/losses. The five stolen bases are also tied for the fifth-most overall by Nashville for a single-game since 2009.

OPENING YAY: With the win on Friday night, the Sounds record on Opening Day now sits at 22-25 all-time and Nashville improved to 29-18 in home openers.

HOW SWEET: With Nashville's 7-1 win on Opening Night, Sounds Manager Rick Sweet picked up his 400th win as the club's skipper. Sweet entered 2025 as the winningest active manager in Minor League Baseball and has the fifth-most wins all-time in the minors. He is 63 wins shy of passing Buddy Bailey for third all-time.

2024 SEASON NOTES

SPRING IS IN THE AIR: Was a Non-Roster Invitee to his first MLB Spring Training and entered the year as the no. 2-rated prospect (#1 pitcher) in the Brewers system and no. 60 in the Top 100 (*Baseball America*)...Made one relief appearance on March 2nd against the Dodgers and struck out the side with a walk in an inning pitched...Started the Spring Breakout Game against the Royals and fanned five with three walks over 2.2 hitless innings.

SHUCKS: Started his season with Double-A Biloxi and was named the Shuckers Opening Day starter...During his time with Biloxi (4/5-7/28) he held opponents to a .182 BAA, fourth-best in Double-A and his 105 strikeouts were seventh-most in the circuit...Among Southern League pitchers, he ranked second in strikeouts, third in BAA, 10th in ERA (3.50) and WHIP (1.28)

THE MISIOROWSKI AWARD: Earned three Southern League Pitcher of the Week awards (4/28, 6/23, 7/14) and his fourth overall (8/20/23)...One of three pitchers to win three POTW awards in the Minors and the only one to do it in the same league (Quinn Priester, STL, Yilber Diaz, ARI),

PITCH CITY: Earned his promotion to Nashville for his Triple-A debut after leading the Brewers system in strikeouts and BAA...Was third in ERA and WHIP after his final start with Biloxi on July 28th.

NEW ROLE: After starting his first 41 professional games prior to arriving in Nashville, he made two planned short starts with the Sounds before moving to the bullpen in an attempt to limit innings and a potential shot at making his Major League Debut in a specialty role for the postseason...Earned his first career save on 8/20 vs. JAX (2.0 IP, 0 H, HB, 2 K).

2023: Worked his way through three levels during his first full pro season...Combined to go 4-2 with a 3.41 ERA in 20 starts and had 110 strikeouts in 71.1 IP... Ranked fifth in the Minors with a 35 percent K rate (min. 70 IP)...Shined at the 2023 Futures Game where he struck out the side in his lone inning of work...Threw 11 triple-digit fastballs, and earned two strikeouts on breaking pitches...Earned his first career Pitcher of the Week Award after spinning five no-hit innings with nine strikeouts on May 31st @ Lynchburg while with Low-A Carolina...His 48 strikeouts through nine starts with Carolina were tied for eighth in the Carolina League...Averaged five strikeouts an outing through his first four starts for High-A Wisconsin where he surrendered nine hits and three runs (2 ER)...Bumped to Double-A Biloxi following the All-Star break for his final five starts of the year...Surrendered his first career home run on July 28th in his 18th pro start and after 257 batters faced...Second HR came just six batters later...Ended the year by earning his second Pitcher of the Week honors with a career-high 12 strikeouts over six scoreless innings and one hit allowed on the road at Mississippi on August 15th in his final outing of the year...Shut down with arm fatigue.

2022: Made two starts for Low-A Carolina following the draft...Seven walks in 1.2 IP and 14 batters faced.

MISC: Pronounced "Miz-uh-RÔW-skee"...Graduated from Grain Valley High (MO) High School...Had senior season wiped out by the COVID-19 pandemic...Attended Crowder CC and suffered a torn meniscus in his first college start...During his redshirt freshman season in 2022, posted a 10-0 record with a 2.72 ERA and finished third in NJCAA Division I with 136 strikeouts over 76.0 IP...Was named a 2022 NJCAA Division I Second-Team All-American...Had a scholarship to Louisiana State University but instead decided to sign with the Brewers after being selected 63rd overall and an above-slot value deal of \$2.35 million...Became the highest-drafted player out of Crowder, surpassing current Brewers pitcher Aaron Ashby (4th round, 2018).
