### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Kolby Allard** to the mound tonight, looking to extend the road winning streak to 6G (last: 7G from 6/29-7/23/22 at Iowa and Toledo). Indianapolis will counter with RHP **Noah Davis**. Columbus is 30-13 (.698) versus right handers this year. Davis has pitched against Columbus three times in his career, going 0-0 with a (7.0IP, 1H, 1R, 1ER, 5BB, 6K).

### vs. the Indians

Columbus is 4-2 against Indianapolis this year, posting a +4 run margin (9-9, +13 in 2025; 12-5, +45 in 2024; 10-8, -23 in 2023; 12-8, +53 in 2022). Since the start of the 2022 season, the Clippers are 16-7 (.696) in games against Indianapolis that are decided by at least five. Individually, **Bo Naylor** is 17x56 (.304) with 3HR, 15RBI in 16G against Indy and **Cooper Ingle** is 10x28 (.357) with 3HR, 8RBI in 10G.

### Something's Gotta Give

Columbus batters are leading the IL in walks this season (333, +13 on 2nd; 5.4 per game), but Indian pitchers have issued the 3rd fewest in the league (246, +11 from 1st; 3.9 per game). In the previous series between the two, 3/31-4/5 in Columbus, the Clipper lineup collected 36BB in 6G (4-2). Tonight's lineup has a 14% walk rate, even with **Juan Brito** (14%) and **Nolan Jones** (14%) on the bench.

### Never Too Late

Each of the last three wins for Columbus have come in the last at bat, while each of the last four have been by a single tally. Saturday and Sunday each featured a walk-off victory, as the Clippers overcame 1-run and 7-run deficits, respectively (IL-best 22 comeback wins and IL-best nine wins when trailing by at least three). From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored 102 runs (+11 on 2nd in the IL).

### Under the Radar

**Petey Halpin** saw his career best hit streak snapped at 14G Thursday (.300, 18x60, 4/12-4/28) and his on base streak went down at 16G (.359OBP, 4/10-4/28). At the time of his promotion last month, he led the IL with 105 runs scored since his debut (3/28/25). Despite the month away, Halpin enters tonight at #5 on that list, 11 off the lead (has scored 12 times in last 14G with Columbus).

### Arias Rehab

**Gabriel Arias** joined the Clippers on rehab Thursday (2x9, HR in 3G), coming back from a strained left hamstring (on the shelf since 4/7, transferred to 60-day on 5/29). Arias hit .200/.250/.433 with 2HR and 4RBI in 10G with Cleveland prior to injury (5x14 in 5G after 1x16 start). All time with Columbus, Arias owns a .795OPS in 500PA (114G) in opposing IL ballparks (.798OPS in 510PA, 128G, at home).

### Getting There

**Cooper Ingle** finally reached the qualification level for rate statistics in the IL and his current .456OBP paces the circuit. Ingle has slumped to a .304OBP over the last 12G (9x47, .191, 78BB), but since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, he has the best OBP in the IL (.428, +27 points on **Johnathan Rodriguez**) and the 3rd most walks (58). As a catcher, Ingle has a 1.290OPS (.478OPS in 12G elsewhere).

### Nayled It

The Clippers are 8-2 with **Bo Naylor** in the lineup, averaging 6.4 runs per game (4.2 per in previous 10G). His homer on Tuesday (29HR and 103RBI in 136G of Columbus career) was his only hit last series, but he has drawn 8BB in 5G to boost his OBP to .455 (Columbus catchers are hitting .317/.470/.580, leading the IL in all three categories by a wide margin, 2nd in all is Memphis: .271/.388/.489).

### Watch Out for Watson

**Kahlil Watson** is hitting .293/.379/.593 with 22XBH and 33RBI in his last 39G (1XBH in first 12G), including 8HR and 21RBI since 5/10 (1-4th most HR in the IL during that span, 7th in RBI). However, with RISP this year, he is hitting just .172 (10x58). Watson's walk on 5/30 snapped a 15G streak without, as he has 3BB and 28K in his last 20G (87PA; was 2nd in the IL with 30BB in 31G through 5/9).

### Half Season, Full Huff

Tonight will mark **Kody Huff**'s 51st game of the year, just over halfway to his career high of 101G in 2025 (208PA this year, 51.1% of career high: 407PA last year). Saturday's HR established a new career high (9, had 7HR with Akron in 2024), while giving him 43RBI (career best is 47RBI in '25). His 37 runs are 82% to his career best, his 52 hits are 63% of the way there and his 33K are 34% to a high.

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

## This Date in Clipper History

6/9/2010

The Clippers clobbered Rochester 8-0 at Huntington Park, led by **Matt LaPorta** and **Carlos Carrasco**. Carrasco racked up 9K in 8.0IP (3H, 1BB), while LaPorta went 4x4 with 3HR and 5RBI. The 3HR game was the first ever at HP, a feat that has been matched four times since (**Chad Huffman**, 4/21/11 vs. LOU; **J.D. Martinez**, 4/19/14 with TOL; **Dan Black**, 5/29/14 with CHA and **Eric Stamets**, 6/16/17 vs. GWN).

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,438 to 1,386).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 86-82 (.512) in pitch reviews, with batters going 46-55 (.455) and pitchers/catchers going 40-27 (.597). They have run out of challenges in 33G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 846, would rank as 4th most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

## On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 88 through the first 62G (on pace for 211SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 20CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 3rd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (48; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,936RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.39 through the first 62G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 162HR (20HR under the average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 9th in the IL this year (.979), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 34G this season (22-12, .647), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

**Kody Huff** bunted a run in, while moving another to scoring position in a 5/24 win vs. Louisville. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 87-23 (.791) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 4-2 mark this season (.667, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 421-433 (.493), 391-387 with Columbus (.503).

### Split Maddux:

The combination of Allard's first 2GS resulted in 9.0IP of shutout ball on only 93 pitches thrown (78% of pitches were strikes). He followed up with a quality start on 6/3 vs. Omaha, averaging 11 pitches per inning in a scoreless performance (6.0IP, 66 pitches, 68% strikes). Since 5/20, Allard is the only pitcher in the IL with at least 15.0IP and 0ER (also only pitcher with 0BB, IL-best 0.53WHIP) and is averaging an IL-low of 10.6 pitches per inning (over 2.0 better than 2nd place).

### In the Majors:

Allard did not make Cleveland's opening day roster, but had his contract purchased on 3/30 to pitch out of the Guardian bullpen. He made four appearances for Cleveland over a couple weeks, giving up at least 1ER every time out, including multiples in each of his last 3G (6.0IP, 9ER). Following a 69-pitch outing at Atlanta on 4/12 (3.0IP, 5ER), Allard was DFA'd on 4/13 and outrighted to Columbus on 4/16.

### Bumpy Beginning:

Following his assignment, Allard appeared once out of the Columbus bullpen (3ER in 1.0IP vs. Iowa on 4/19) before going on the shelf with a sore right hip (4/22-5/6). Upon activation, he allowed 2ER in each of his first 2G back (4.1IP), averaging 48 pitches per outing. Allard was moved into the rotation beginning on 5/20 vs. Louisville, working a scoreless start (4.0IP) on only 37 pitches (0BB to 15BF; issued 7BB to 24BF in 3G of relief), followed by scoreless, walkless outings on 5/27 at Toledo (5.0IP, 17BF) and 6/3 vs. Omaha (6.0IP, 20BF).
