FROM THE CROW'S NEST

SEE SERGIO STEAL: With his steal of home in the fourth inning last night, Sergio Campana became the first Marauders player to steal home since Jose Osuna did so on April 11, 2014 in Jupiter. Campana is third on the club with three stolen bases in three attempts. As a team, the Marauders are second in the Low-A Southeast with 17 stolen bases and have been caught just once.

SHARE THE WEALTH: Ten of the 14 position players on the Marauders roster have recorded at least one multi-hit game this season, with **Dariel Lopez** and **Endy Rodriguez** sharing the team lead with four multi-hit games each. Also, six Bradenton hitters have at least one multi-RBI game, with Rodriguez and Alexander Mojica leading the way with two such games

WE'RE STRANDED: The Marauders own the fourth-highest team batting average in the Low-A Southeast at .251, but are batting just .226 (24-for-106) as a team with runners in scoring position. Wednesday's game saw Bradenton go 2-for-16 with men in scoring position while leaving 12 on base, their second-highest total of the season.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: In a combined four appearances, right-handers Nick Garcia and Logan Hofmann have held opponents to one run on two hits, walking just two and striking out 12 over a cumulative 10 innings of work out of the bullpen. Both were selected within the first five rounds of last year's draft and are in their first professional seasons

WELCOME ABOARD: Alexander Mojica currently owns both the longest on-base streak (six games) and the longest hitting streak (four games) among Marauders hitters. The 18-year-old Dominican Republic native is batting .304 (5-for-18) with two home runs and five RBI.

TOP PROSPECTS: The Marauders roster currently boasts six prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the organization: Hudson Head (#6), Eddy Yean (#13), Sammy Siani (#19), Nick Garcia (#21), Endy Rodriguez (#27), and Alexander Mojica (#30). Three of the six (Head, Rodriguez, and Yean) came to the organization via blockbuster trades: Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the three-team Joe Musgrove deal, while Yean came from Washington in the Josh Bell trade.

UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT: New Jersey native Jonathan Johnston takes the helm in Bradenton for his first season in the Pirates organization. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020 (he was originally slated to manage the short-season West Virginia Black Bears), he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

THE OPPONENT: The Dunedin Blue Jays pitching staff was ravaged in the opening series, surrendering 78 runs on 73 hits to the Tampa Tarpons over the six-game set. Dunedin dropped each of the first five games of the series before salvaging Sunday's series finale, 4-1. The five-game skid was the D-Jays' longest losing streak to open a season since 2011, when Dunedin lost its first six games

HEAD TO HEAD: The Marauders struggled against Dunedin in 2019, going 5-8 against the D-Jays despite outscoring them in their 13 matchups, 63-57.
