SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

MARTINEZ'S HIT PARADE: 1B Ernesto Martinez tallied his first three-hit game in Double-A on Friday... Martinez's three-hit performance was his first since he had four hits with the High-A Wisconsin Timber Rattlers on July 19, 2023 at the Dayton Dragons... Since being promoted to Double-A, Martinez has reached base in 12 of 13 games, tallying a hit in eight games.

SOMETHING NEW EVERY NIGHT: OF Jackson Chourio hit a 417-foot opposite field home run on Thursday, his 19th of the year... He enters today one home run away from becoming the first teenager with at least 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases between Double-A and/or Triple-A since OF Delmon Young in 2005 with the Montgomery Biscuits (TB).

- Schourio's 34 stolen bases are the most by a teenager in Double-A since INF Elvis Andrus stole 51 with the Frisco RoughRiders (Double-A, TEX) in 2008.
- SHis 417-foot home run on Thursday was 15-feet farther than any opposite field home run hit by a Brewers' player in 2023... The longest is 402-feet from **INF Willy Adames** on April 7 against the St. Louis Cardinals.

ON THE MOVE: The Shuckers enter today with 192 stolen bases in 2023, eight away from becoming the third Southern League team since 2005 to reach 200 in a season... The last team to reach 200 was the 2022 Montgomery Biscuits, who stole 203... The Biscuits also swiped 213 in 2019, the most by a Southern League team since 2005.

DRIVING IN RUNS AT A RECORD PACE: OF Jackson Chourio hit his 18th home run of the year on Wednesday, bringing home his 75th and 76th RBI of the year, setting the new Shuckers' single-season record... Chourio broke the previous record of 74, set by **OF Johnny Davis** in 2018.

Since the start of July, Chourio has driven in 30 runs in 37 games... Through the first five months of the season, including August, Chourio has driven in at least 15 runs in three months.

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: If the season ended today, the Biloxi Shuckers would miss the 2023 Southern League Playoffs.

- The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs for the first time since 2019; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division.
- The Shuckers are a game behind the Montgomery Biscuits for the division lead with 20 games remaining... The Shuckers own the second-half tiebreaker against the Biscuits, winning four of six match-ups... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CHRISTIAN MEJIAS (4-10, 7.19): RHP Christian Mejias makes his 22nd start of the year and his fifth start of the year against Pensacola... Mejias worked into the fifth inning in has last start, the fifth time he's done so over his last seven starts... Entering today, right-handed batters are hitting .218 against Mejias, the fifth-lowest among all qualified pitchers in the Southern League.
