LAST TIME OUT

Moosic, PA (April 14, 2023) -The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders were topped 13-7 by the Syracuse Mets on Friday night. Three home runs came on either side, but Brett Baty's grand slam topped them all.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre got the runs started in the first. Estevan Florial took a walk to begin the inning. Elijah Dunham reached on a fielders choice and an error allowed Florial to come home. Andres Chaparro smacked a two-run homer, his fifth, to put SWB up 3-0.

The Mets tied it up immediately in the second, but the RailRiders got back up quickly with a solo shot from Jose Godoy, his first of the season.

Syracuse put up seven runs in the fourth inning. Brett Baty smashed a grand slam to right center for his third home run of the series. Jaylin Davis singled and came home on Arauz's base knock. After Mauricio doubled to reach, Peraza's two run single made it 10-4.

Godoy started off the bottom half with a base hit and was able to score on an error to cut into the lead. The RailRiders continued to chip away in the sixth. Jesus Bastidas got to first on a hit by pitch and came home on Jamie Westbrook's grounder. SWB got within four.

Another double from Mauricio put a runner in scoring position and Lee knocked an RBI single. Back-to-back walks loaded the bases and a third walk brought a runner home for a 12-6 lead. Mauricio continued his hitting spree with a solo shot in the eighth for his fourth hit of the contest.

In the bottom of the ninth, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre started to rally. Chaparro smashed his second homer of the game, a solo shot to left. Jake Bauers and Billy McKinney hit back-to-back singles, but a double play ended the contest 13-7 Syracuse.

Tanner Tully got the start tossing 3.1 innings allowing four runs on six hits. He struck out two. Michael Gomez (L, 0-2) pitched an inning and two thirds allowing six runs, five earned. D.J. Snelten took over in the sixth sitting down the side in order. He recorded two outs in the seventh allowing a pair of runs. Aaron McGarity entered with the bases loaded in the eighth and allowed one run via walk. The righty let up a solo homer, but recorded a 1-2-3 ninth.

NEWS & NOTES

AMAZING ANDRES - Rookie Andres Chaparro has been on a tear this week, batting .389 with seven hits including five homers. He has batted in seven runs and has secured seven of his own. Chaparro takes over the International League with a leading six home runs along with Mets #6 prospect Ronny Mauricio and Jacksonville's Peyton Burdick. Chaparro also leads the RailRiders with nine total RBIs and nine runs scored in twelve games.

DURAN DURAN - Rodolfo Duran has now extended his hitting streak to five total games, recording at least one in every contest he has participated in. Last night he had two doubles for three total on the season. Duran has also hit a home run. He is second on the team in runs batted in with five. As a catcher, he has been influential in his contests behind the plate. Duran caught his second runner stealing last night and is 2-for-3 on the season. He has not allowed a passed ball, but has three assists.

FLORIAL WALKS - Since rejoining Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, Florial has been walked six times, including four in last night's contest. He has also hit two homers for four RBIs.

RUN DIFFERENTIAL - Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has only allowed nine more runs than they have scored this season. The RailRiders have let up 67 runs, while scoring 58 of their own. The best differential in the International League is Columbus with +36 on a 7-6 record. The worst is Gwinnett who are -34 with a 2-10 record.

THE WEISSERT WAY - Greg Weissert was selected by the New York Yankees yesterday for his second time in his Major League career. He has four saves in four attempts in Triple-A. Weissert had a phenomenal season in 2022 as the RailRiders closer and pitched his way into the record books. He became the third Scranton/Wilkes-Barre player and first RailRider to win the International League's top pitching honor. He was named as both the league's Pitcher of the Year. Weissert appeared in 42 games in 2022, going 2-1 with 18 saves and a 1.69 ERA while striking out 70. The Yankees signed the right-hander to a Major League deal on August 25 and he made his big league debut that night. With New York he pitched 11.1 innings and recorded three wins.

LEADING THE CHARGE - Manager Shelley Duncan has been rotating through his starting lineup pretty consistently, seemingly focusing on pitching matchups. While every player has gotten at least one rest day, three have participated in all but one contest. Andres Chaparro, and Elijah Dunham have gotten into twelve games this season. Out of the bullpen, Michael Gomez, Nick Ramirez, Matt Bowman, and DJ Snelten have the most appearances with five total.

EXTRA EXTRS - With 16 doubles and 21 homers in 13 games, the RailRiders have amassed 38 extra base hits. Jake Bauers has a pair of doubles, a triple and three homers, while Elijah Dunham has four two-baggers and one home run. Bauer's triple was the first of the season for the RailRiders. Andres Chaparro has all six of his extra base hits as homers.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Oswald Peraza (#3 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) alongside outfielder Elijah Dunham (#18) in his first Triple-A season. Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle (#29) are both set to be essential parts of the starting pitching staff. Peraza made his big league debut at the end of last season and even aided the Yankees in their postseason race.

SHIPPED OUT, SHIPPED IN: The Yankees traded Ken Waldichuk, JP Sears and Hayden Wesneski prior to the 2022 trade deadline, all SWB pitchers. When Sears was traded he was slated to pitch on August 2 for the RailRiders. With those moves, Mitch Spence was called up from Somerset (Double-A) to make his Triple-A debut.

DAY GAME EXPERIENCE: Mitch Spence threw five games during the day last season. His record is 1-1 with a 6.49 ERA in 18.2 innings. He's allowed three home runs. In games beginning before 5PM, he has had 13 walks and 15 strikeouts.

CHANGE IT UP, LITERALLY: At USC-Aiken, Spence only threw a fastball and a slider. He now throws five pitches after spending over three years in the system (view repertoire right). He says he feels "like (he's) completely changed what kind of pitcher (he is)."

- 2022: Combined with Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to go 6-7 with a 4.70 ERA (130.1IP, 138H, 73R/68ER, 42BB, 127K, 17HR) in 27 games (25 starts)...ranked among Yankees farmhands in games started (tied for third) and strikeouts (sixth)
- Became a starter in 2021, spending the entire season in Hudson Valley and posting a 3-4 record and 5.29 ERA over 23 appearances. His 20 starts, 105 IP and 118 K led the Renegades.
- Worked solely as a reliever in 2019 with Pulaski, making 16 appearances out of the bullpen, tying for 2nd on the team, going 3-2 with a 3.54 ERA, 4 saves and 29 K over 28.0 IP.
