**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn dropped their 3rd-straight contest to Aberdeen, 7-2, on Saturday afternoon...IronBirds scored 2 runs in the 1st without the benefit of a base-hit...3B **Max Wagner** and 1B **Isaac De León** added solo home runs in the 6th and 8th innings, respectively...The Cyclones broke up the shutout on a 2-run single to center by LF **Alex Ramírez**...SS **Jackson Holliday** and Wagner registered multi-hit days for Aberdeen...IronBirds swiped 9 bases...RHP **Alex Pham** tossed 5.0 innings of 1-hit, shutout ball to earn his first win of 2023...RHP **Benito García** permitted 1 hit and 1 run, striking out 4, in relief for Brooklyn.

**PUNCHING TICKETS:** Cyclones pitchers matched a season-best with 17 strikeouts vs. Aberdeen on Saturday afternoon...RHP **Joander Suárez** struck out a season-high 8...RHP **Benito García** (4), RHP **Jace Beck** (2), and LHP **Quinn Brodey** (3) each sat down multiple hitters...Brooklyn previously whiffed 17 batters at Winston-Salem on April 14...The 17 K's were the most for the 'Clones are Maimonides Park since Brooklyn punched out 18 batters — also against Aberdeen — on July 23, 2016, when both were members of the Short-Season New York-Penn League...RHP **Justin Dunn** (5), LHP **Kyle Regnault** (2), and RHP **Nabil Crismatt** (11) combined for the 18 K's.

**STU-PENDOUS:** RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the SAL in 2023...The 23-year-old punched out a career-high 9 batters over 5 innings in a no-decision on Tuesday vs. Aberdeen...Entering Sunday, Stuart trails only Wilmington's RHP **Kyle Luckham** (1.29) for the league lead in ERA (1.93)...He is also 6th in batting average against (.203)...The right-hander is also 3rd in xFIP (3.12) and 4th in strikeout rate (34.6%) plus strikeouts per nine innings (13.02).

**ALEX SMACKS:** OF **Alex Ramírez** had his team-season-long 12-game hitting streak halted on Tuesday, but the 20-year-old has reached in 17-straight games dating back to April 12...In that span, Ramírez is slashing .288/.373/.379 with a .752 OPS and a 108 wRC+...Alex is 19-for-66 at the dish with 8 runs scored, 4 extra-base hits, 1 home run, 12 RBI, 7 walks, and 4 stolen bases in 5 attempts...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in hits (85) and doubles (21), in addition to being tied for the league-lead in RBI (48)...He only trails teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** in extra-base hits (28) and total bases (126).

**STAN BY ME:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** is hitting at a torrid pace for the Cyclones in 2023...Since he clubbed his first home run of the season on April 12 at Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has posted a .317/.382/.650 slashline with an eye-gouging 1.032 OPS...Consuegra is 19-for-60 at the plate (.317) with 10 extra-base knocks, 4 home runs, and 15 RBI in 16 games...The Dominican native has only failed to reach base in one of those 16 affairs...Since joining the SAL last July 4, Consuegra paces the circuit in extra-base knocks (31) and total bases (128).

**NEW KIDS ON THE BOARDWALK:** RHP **Christian Scott** and C **José Mena** rejoined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie and Double-A Binghamton, respectively, this weekend...Scott made 1 start for St. Lucie, taking the loss vs. Jupiter on Wednesday night (2.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 3 K)...Mena went 0-for-3 with a walk in his lone game with the Rumble Ponies on April 21 at Hartford...Scott made 6 appearances (5 starts) for Brooklyn in 2022...The right-hander tallied a 3.80 ERA (9 ER in 21 IP) and 25 strikeouts...Mena slashed .239/.274/.356 with a .630 OPS, 8 home runs, and 35 RBI in 83 games for the 'Clones last summer...In a corresponding move, C **Drake Osborn** was placed on the temporarily inactive list.

**TIDWELL'S SHARP BLADE:** RHP **Blade Tidwell** set a career-high and a team-season-best with 10 strikeouts over 5.1 innings vs. Aberdeen on Thursday night...The 21-year-old is the first Cyclone pitcher to register 10-plus punch outs in a single game since RHP **Carson Seymour** struck out 10 hitters on July 22, 2022, at Jersey Shore...Tidwell was the first Brooklyn arm to whiff 10 at home since RHP **Dominic Hamel** accomplished the feat with 10 K's on July 16, 2022, vs. Greensboro.

**vs. ABERDEEN** Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game set against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds claim 5 of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...2022 No. 1 overall pick — SS **Jackson Holliday** — is the top-rated prospect at No. 3 in the organization...OF **Dylan Beavers** (11), OF **Jud Fabian** (14), INF **Max Wagner** (19), and INF **Frederick Benkosme** (29) are also featured...The Cyclones were eliminated by the IronBirds, 2-1, in the 2022 South Atlantic League North Division Championship last September...Brooklyn is 118-108 (.522) all-time against Aberdeen.

**SPEED DEMONS:** Brooklyn has habitually swiped bases in 2023...Coming into Sunday's matchup, OF **Omar De Los Santos** is tied for 4th in the SAL with 13 and IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is tied for 8th with 10...More importantly, both are a combined 23-for-24 on attempts...The 'Clones are 10th in the league with 39 team stolen bases, but have the 3rd-best success rate in the SAL at .867...Only Hudson Valley (.875) and Aberdeen (.873) have stolen bags more successfully...Brooklyn has been caught stealing a league-low 6 times this year...Aberdeen and Hudson Valley are 2nd with 8 runners caught.

**OMNIPRESENT OMAR:** In addition to his 13 stolen bases in 13 attempts in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 83 stolen bases in that span, which is 4th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (90), Athletics OF **Esteury Ruiz** (85), and Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (84) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 51 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 32...Omar is already 19 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) that was set back in 2017.

**DANIEL'S DOMINANCE:** LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 8 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and 3 walks, striking out 13...In 13 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 12.2 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 21 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 8 hits allowed, 12 walks, and 28 strikeouts in 23.0 innings.

**ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL:** Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

**MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

**PROSPECTS:** Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...INF **William Lugo** (27/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (30/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Tallied his 4th-straight no-decision on Tuesday vs. Aberdeen...Permitted 2 runs (1 earned) on 4 hits over 5.0 innings...Walked 3 and struck out a career-best 9...Induced a double play...Hurled a career-high 92 pitches (51 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Jordan Geber** in the top of the 6th and the game tied at 2...Cyclones went on to defeat the IronBirds, 4-3, in 10 innings on a walk-off RBI single from LF **Omar De Los Santos**.

**2022:** Signed with New York for \$220,000...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning at FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Yielded 4 runs on 4 hits, striking out 6, in 2.2 innings over 2 appearances (1 start)...Placed on the 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on August 30.

**LEAGUE LEADER:** The Kankakee, Ill. native enters play on Sunday ranked 2nd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.93)...Stuart also sits 6th in the circuit in batting average against (.203) and 10th in WHIP (1.23)...He also is 3rd in the league in xFIP (3.12), and 4th in strikeout rate (34.6%) plus strikeouts per 9 innings (13.02).

**SOARING EAGLE:** Stuart was selected by the Mets in the 8th round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi...Was a 4th-year sophomore at Southern Miss in 2022 after redshirting as a true freshman and missing his sophomore campaign due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Accumulated a 4-0 record with a 3.38 ERA (15 ER in 40.0 IP) and 1 save in 22 outings (4 starts)...Whiffed 38 and walked 13.

**NEW ROLE:** Despite primarily serving as a relief pitcher in college, Stuart is expected to make his 6th professional start on Sunday...In those outings, he has no record and a 2.14 ERA (5 ER in 21.0 IP), adding 32 strikeouts (13.71 SO/9)...The Kankakee, Ill. native made only 4 starts throughout his collegiate tenure, all coming in his final season during 2022.

**SUMMER NIGHTS:** The 23-year-old is no stranger to pitching in the northeast...Stuart tossed 6.0 scoreless innings over 4 appearances with the Bourne Braves of the prestigious Cape Cod Baseball League in the summer of 2021...Was teammates with 2022 Cyclones LHP **Nick Zwack**...Also made 1 start with the Amsterdam (N.Y.) Mohawks of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League in 2019.
