TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue their longest road trip of the season on Saturday with games four and five of a six-game series in Birmingham. The road trip will include 12 games: six against the Barons at Regions Field, April 16-21, and six against the Montgomery Biscuits, April 23-28. The M-Braves will send out RHP Hurston Waldrep in game one and RHP JJ Niekro in the nightcap.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Barons and M-Braves were postponed by rain on Friday night at Regions Field. The club waited out a 2-hour delay before the game was called at 9 pm.

SECOND DOUBLEHEADER OF THE YEAR: This is Mississippi's second doubleheader of 2024. The club swept a doubleheader against Biloxi on April 11, winning game one, 4-1, and walking off the second game in eight innings, 1-0.

FINAL TRIP TO BIRMINGHAM: This week's six-game road series marks the Mississippi Braves' final trip to Birmingham. Since 2005, the M-Braves are 135-123 against the White Sox affiliate, including 62-67 in Hoover or Birmingham. The Barons moved from Hoover to downtown Birmingham in 2013.

NEED FOR SPEED: The M-Braves lead all of Double-A baseball with 31 stolen bases (31/34) through 12 games. Rocket City is second with 29. **Justin Dean** is 2nd in the league with nine steals, and **Cody Milligan** is third with eight. Mississippi had 157 (1.1 per game) stolen bases last season and is on pace for 359 (2.6 per game) in 2024. The most by an M-Braves team was 159 in 2007. .

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Justin Dean** ranks among the league leaders in stolen bases (2nd, 9), batting average (3rd, .345), OPS (7th, .912), and OBP (7th, .429). Dean has also reached in nine of his 10 games. **Nacho Alvarez Jr.** ranks among the circuit leaders in walks (T-2nd, 9), hits (3rd, 14), batting average (7th, .318), OBP (6th, .434), and steals (T-7th, 5).

NACHO AVERAGE SHORT STOP: Atlanta's top-ranked position player prospect, **Nacho Alvarez Jr.**, is on a five-game hitting streak, batting .381 with one RBI, three walks, and three stolen bases. The 21-year-old has a hit in nine of his first 12 games.

THERE'S JUST SOMETHING ABOUT THE NAME NIEKRO: **JJ Niekro**, the son of Joe Niekro and nephew of Phil Niekro, is trying to create his legacy. Our Farm Bureau Pitcher of the Week, Niekro, made his first two Double-A starts during the opening homestand and went 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (2 ER/10.2), two walks, and eight strikeouts. Niekro won during the home opener on April 9 with 6.0 shutout innings in the 2-0 weather-shortened contest. The Plant City, FL native ranks among the Southern League leaders in WHIP (7th, 0.84), ERA (6th, 1.69), and opponent's batting average (7th, .179).

GIVE ME FIVE: The M-Braves are 4-1 when their starters go 5+ innings and 0-7 when starters go less than 5.0 innings. In the five games with 5+ innings, they combined for a 0.93 ERA (3 ER/29 IP). In the seven losses, the starter ERA is 8.52 (24 ER/25.1 IP).

MR. MEJIA: After struggling in his first start, **Ian Mejia** has allowed just one run over his previous two quality starts, including 12 innings, one run allowed, four walks, and 13 strikeouts. Mejia set a new career high with nine strikeouts. Mejia ranks among the Southern League leaders in innings pitched (8th, 13.2) and strikeouts (T-6th, 14).

OPENING DAY ROSTER FEATURES FOUR TOP-20 ATL PROSPECTS/17 RETURNERS: Mississippi returns 17 players from last season's club and four of the Atlanta Braves' Top 20 prospects. The Top 20 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline, include RHP **Hurston Waldrep** (No. 2), INF **Nacho Alvarez Jr.** (No. 6), C **Drake Baldwin** (No. 11), and LHP **Luis De Avila** (No. 20). RHP **Ian Mejia** (No. 28), and INF **Keshawn Ogan** are part of Baseball America's Top 30 prospects ... The 17 returning players include pitchers De Avila, RHP **Domingo Gonzalez**, RHP **Patrick Halligan**, LHP **Hayden Harris**, LHP **Jake McSteen**, RHP **Trey Riley**, RHP **Hurston Waldrep**, RHP **Peyton Williams**, and position players **Baldwin**, C **Tyler Tolve**, C **Javier Valdes**, INF **Cade Bunnell**, INF **Cal Conley**, INF **Bryson Horne**, OF **Justin Dean**, OF **Cody Milligan**, and OF **Brandon Parker**.

COACHING STAFF WITH A NEW FLO: After spending one season as manager of the Braves High-A affiliate Rome Braves (Emperors), **Angel Flores** will take the reins for the first time at the Double-A level, succeeding **Kanekoa Teixeira**. Teixeira was promoted to manager of the Triple-A Gwinnett Stripers after **Matt Tuasosopo** was named to the Braves' Major League coaching staff for 2024. Flores returns to Mississippi, where he served as bench coach in 2022. Flores took over as interim manager from April 26 to May 15, 2022, while Bruce Crabbe took a leave of absence from the club. During the 18-game stretch, the M-Braves went 10-8. During his first season as a full-time manager last year, Flores led the R-Braves to a 34-32 record in the second half and an overall 64-68 mark. Overall, he holds a 74-76 record as a manager.

ABOUT LAST SEASON: The club finished with a 62-75 overall record, 33-35 in the first half and 29-40 in the second half. The M-Braves were 32-36 at Trustmark Park and 30-39 on the road. The M-Braves went 19-32 in July and August but finished with a franchise record nine wins in September.

FINAL SEASON IN MISSISSIPPI: On January 9, it was announced that after 20 years, 2024 will be the M-Braves' final season in Pearl, MS. As of the start of the 2025 season, the Double-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves will be relocating to Columbus, GA.

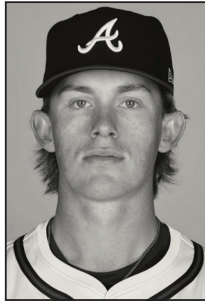

ATLANTA'S NO. 2 PROSPECT (MLB), NO. 2 PROSPECT (BA)

TODAY'S GAME

- Atlanta's first round selection in 2023, Hurston Waldrep makes his third start of 2024, and first against Birmingham. This is Waldrep's sixth Double-A start, making three for the M-Braves in 2023.

LAST TIME OUT

- Waldrep suffered his second-straight loss last Saturday night in Mississippi's 6-1 loss to Biloxi at Trustmark Park. The right-hander set a career-high with four walks and three strikeouts, allowing three runs on four hits over 4.1 innings.

VS. BIRMINGHAM

- This is Waldrep's first start against Biloxi.

2024 SPRING TRAINING

- Tossed 4.1 scoreless innings over two appearances for Atlanta in Spring Training, striking out five, and walking four.

2023 NOTES

- Cruised through four levels of the Braves organization during his professional debut ... Made eight starts in total, ranging from 3.0 to 4.2 innings.
- Assigned to Augusta on August 2 ... Transferred to Rome on August 8, to Mississippi on August 29, and to Gwinnett on September 23.
- Made his first start with Class-A Augusta on August 5 vs. Columbia (ND, 3.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 SO in 5-4 win) ... Notched his season-high for innings (4.2) and strikeouts (10) in the same outing, August 26 with High-A Rome vs. Greensboro (3 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 0 BB in 4-2 win).
- In three starts for the M-Braves, posted a 2.70 ERA (3 ER/10.0 IP), seven walks, 11 strikeouts, and held opponents to a .216 batting average. Waldrep had a solid showing in his first crack at Double-A, striking out four batters across three scoreless innings on September 2 against Rocket City at Trustmark Park.
- Joined the Stripers for one start, September 23 vs. Durham ... Tossed 4.1 scoreless innings (4 H, 3 BB, 5 SO) to lead a combined six-hitter in a 2-0 victory.
- In making his Triple-A debut in just his eighth pro outing, it marked the first time a Braves player had reached Gwinnett in the same year he was drafted

AMATEUR

- Pitched two seasons at Southern Mississippi from 2021-22 before transferring to the University of Florida for his junior year in 2023 ... Between the schools, went 17-5 with a 3.68 ERA and 1.28 WHIP in 47 games (36 starts) ... Struck out 312 batters over 208.0 innings for a 13.5 SO/9.0 IP ratio.
- At Southern Miss: During his freshman and sophomore seasons, combined to go 7-2 with a 3.22 ERA and 156 strikeouts in 106.1 innings over 28G... Named Third Team All-American by D1Baseball in 2022 ... Led Golden Eagles to 2022 NCAA Super Regional.
- At Florida: Named Second Team All-American by D1Baseball and ABCA First Team Southeast All-Region after going 10-3 with a 4.16 ERA, 1.40 WHIP, an .228 BAA in 19 weekend starts ... Struck out 156, the second-most in a single season in UF history (1 shy of Alex Faedo's record set in 2017) ... Posted a UF record 13.8 SO/9.0 IP ratio (besting John Burke's 13.3 mark set in 1990) ... Struck out 12-plus batters (37 total) in three consecutive NCAA Tournament starts vs. UConn, South Carolina, and Oral Roberts ... Helped lead the Gators to the CWS Finals vs. LSU (lost in three games).

- Niekro is facing off against Birmingham for the first time.

2024 NOTES

- Made the start on Opening Night at Trustmark Park on 4/9, vs. Biloxi, helped Mississippi to their first win of 2024 with 6.0 shutout innings on three hits with five strikeouts to one walk.

2024 SPRING TRAINING

- Saw action in one game for Atlanta in Spring Training, posting 1.1 scoreless innings with no walks and two strikeouts on February 26 vs. Pittsburgh.

2023 NOTES

- Spent the season with High-A Rome, going 4-4 with a 3.89 ERA (46 ER/84.2 IP), 36 walks, 75 strikeouts over 31 games (7 starts).

2022 NOTES

- Split the season between Single-A Augusta, and High-A Rome, boasting a 10-3 record, with a 3.19 ERA (43 ER/121.1 IP), 114 strikeouts, only 33 walks, and a 1.18 WHIP over 15 games (eight starts) in Augusta, and nine starts for Rome.
- Ranked among Atlanta farmhands in ERA (1st, 3.19), wins (3rd, 10), innings pitched (6th, 121.1), WHIP (3rd, 1.18), and BAA (6th, .243).

NIEKRO BASEBALL LEGACY

- The son of Joe and nephew of Phil ... Phil and Joe Niekro combined to total more than 500 wins and 5,000 strikeouts in their major league careers ... Joe, who died from an aneurysm in 2006 when J.J. was 8 years old, won 221 games over a 22-year major league career, including two years with the Braves from 1973-74 ... Phil, who died in 2020, won 318 games over a 24-year Hall of Fame career, playing for the Braves from 1964-83 in Milwaukee and Atlanta, then returned for his final major league appearance in 1987 ... J.J.'s half-brother, Lance, also reached the majors, spending four seasons as a first baseman with the San Francisco Giants.

IN HIS OWN WORDS

- I never think it carries any pressure. Being a Niekro is always a blessing in so many ways. My dad and my uncle, obviously, are most recognized for playing baseball, and my brother as well. But any time I hear a story of them or see a picture or video or a highlight, it's always a representation of how great of people they were — how great of men they were off the baseball field. When someone talks about "Knucksie," they always talk about how much he was a teammate that made them laugh or cared for me or was there for me when I was down.- JJ Niekro
