SETTING THE SCENE: Springfield and NW Arkansas (KC) open up July 4th week with the 1st of a 3-game set and brief 3-game homestand ... SGF is 5-7 vs. NWA this season ... the Freedom Week festivities begin with 5,000 Free Hot Dog Night, Great Southern Bank \$2 Tuesday, and American Country Fireworks pres. by Around the Ozarks.

MAUTZ ON MOUND: LHP Brycen Mautz makes his 13th start of the season and his 3rd vs. NWA ... allowed 2 runs (on 2 solo HR) over 6.0 IP in last start on 6/24 this season ... has pitched season-high 6.0 IP in 2 of last 3 starts ... has a 4.15 ERA over 2 starts (8.2 IP) vs. NWA.

LAST TIME OUT: The Cardinals surrendered a late lead, allowing 5 runs in the 8th to Wichita, in a 7-4 loss to close out the series in the ICT ... RHP Luis Gastelum allowed 5 runs on 5 hits in the 8th and picked up the loss and blown save ... IF Jeremy Rivas went 2x2 with a 2B, HR, and 2 BB in the contest ... RHP Hancel Rincon struck out 8 and allowed 2 runs on 5 hits over 5.0 IP.

MEMORABLE MONTH: The Cardinals closed out a historic June with a 19-6 record ... the month saw the Cardinals celebrate a 1st-Half title, the 1st 9-inning no-hitter in franchise history and a new club record for 1st-half wins (43) ... finished 12-1 at home during the month and slugged a season monthly-high 28 home runs in 25 games.

BEWICHD: Springfield dropped 4-of-6 in Wichita, marking the club's 1st series loss since going 2-4 vs. NWA (4/30-5/4) ... was 6-0-1 over last 7 series with one 6-game sweep (6/10-15 vs TUL).

THE FUTURE IS HERE: IF JJ Wetherholt was named to the NL roster for the MLB Futures Game to be played on July 12 at 3 p.m. CT at Truist Park in Atlanta ... is 9th-straight season a SGF player was selected to be featured in the showcase game ...
