FRISCO STOMPS AMARILLO IN MONSTER OFFENSIVE DAY AGAIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Amarillo Sod Poodles 18-1 on Saturday evening from HODGETOWN. Frisco (39-29, 83-54) jumped ahead in the top of the first inning against Amarillo (28-39, 58-78) starter Dylan Ray (2-5) when **Cody Freeman** drove in **Alejandro Osuna** with a single to center. **Abimelec Ortiz** belted a three-run homer to left to give the Riders a 4-0 lead. In the top of the second inning, Osuna and **Josh Hatcher** launched back-to-back solo home runs to push the RoughRiders lead to 6-0. Amarillo found the run column with a solo homer in the bottom of the fourth with a solo homer by Gavin Conticella against **Bryan Chi**. Chi exited after 3.0 innings, allowing one run on a pair of hits and a walk while fanning three. **Ryan Lobus** worked a pair of scoreless relief innings before handing the ball to **Bryan Magdaleno**. The RoughRiders erupted for five more runs in the top of the fifth inning as the first four batters reached. **Sebastian Walcott** delivered the first run with a single before **Keyber Rodriguez** added on with an RBI single. **Aaron Zavala** mashed his fifth homer of the season, a three-run shot to left that extended the lead to 11-1. In the top of the seventh inning, **Daniel Mateo** delivered his fifth homer of the season to pad the lead at 12-1. Walcott, the youngest player in franchise history, unleashed on his first career Double-A homer in the top of the eighth inning. The three-run shot gave the RoughRiders a 15-1 lead. In the visiting portion of the ninth inning, Hatcher doubled in Osuna before an Ortiz two-run shot brought the score to its final resting place, 18-1. Over his last two games, Ortiz is now 7-for-10 with four homers. Offensively, the Riders set season highs with 18 runs, 21 hits and seven homers. Ortiz paced the offense with five hits as each of the nine starters collected a hit for the second straight night. Six different players recorded multi-hit nights in the win.

I LIKE BIG BATS AND I CANNOT LIE:

Over the last three games, the Riders have hammered the Sod Poodles, batting .409/.465/.858/1.323 as a team while scoring 40 runs in the three games. Their 14 home runs in the last three games are first in MiLB as well.

PUSH IT TO THE MAXIMO:

Riders infielder **Max Acosta** has been en fuego at the plate, hitting .341 (59-for-173)/.404/.526/.930 over his last 44 games. Since July 10th, in those last 44 games, he is second in the league in average (.341) and fifth in OPS (.930). In his last 31 games, he is hitting .363 (45-for-124)/.430/.565/.995. He has hits in 12 of his last 13 games, batting .449/.550/.796/1.346. Acosta now has a career-best in all slashline categories and is one of five qualified players in the Texas League this year who is 21-year-old or younger.

CHASING RECORDS:

The RoughRiders are within reach of the franchise record for the best winning percentage (.607, 2007). The Riders need to finish 1-0 in their last game to get the winning percentage record. On the pitching side, they are on pace to allow the fewest hits in a full season (not including the 119-game 2021 season), with 1,036 and the lowest batting average against in a full season (.231).

HATCHIN HOMERS:

Josh Hatcher has been one of the hotter hitters in the Texas League recently, batting .327/.394/.494/.888 over his last 42 games with 10 doubles, six home runs and 24 RBIs. In his last 14 games, he is hitting .368 (21-for-57)/.429/.632/1.061 with six doubles, three home runs, 10 RBIs, 11 runs scored.

ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire for the RoughRiders recently. Over his last 47 games, Ortiz is hitting .320/.411/.597/1.008 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 27 walks. Since July 10th, in those 47 games, he is third in average (.320), first in OPS (1.008), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he leads all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 28 games, he is batting .364 (39-for-107)/.469/.710/1.179 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 20 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. Since, he is hitting .307 with an .955 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .759 OPS. In a four-game hitting streak, Ortiz is batting .556 (10-for-18)/.619/1.278/1.897 with four home runs, eight RBIs and eight runs scored.

HOMER HAPPY:

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with **Luis Mieses** capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. Since then, the RoughRiders have hit 40 home runs in the last 26 games, with those 40 home runs being first in the Texas League over the last 26 games. Frisco is still just sixth in the Texas League in home runs this season with 116 across their 137 games.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders were fantastic at home this year, going 44-24 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco had a +69 run differential, a 3.88 ERA and is averaging 5.2 runs per game with a .743 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 38-30 with a 3.55 ERA, but a +33 run differential while averaging 4.3 runs per game and owning a .681 OPS (9th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 14 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .303/.392/.524/.916 at home.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 8/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John" ligament replacement surgery on 8/15/22

2021 SEASON

-Pitching mainly in an extended relief role, he combined to go 3-1, 3.70 (23 ER/56.0 IP) in 20 G/4 GS for Down East (A) and Hickory (A+), averaging 10.0 strikeouts per 9 innings.

-Began season with Down East and was promoted to Hickory on 7/7.

2019 SEASON

-Saw minimal pro action after being drafted. Posted a 9.9 SO/9 figure over 7 G for Spokane (A) and AZL Rangers (Rk.).
