NOTES AND NUGGETS

WE ARE THE CHAMPLAINS, MY FRIEND

- Omaha starter **Chandler Champlaine** threw 5.0 scoreless innings last night, in what officially goes down as a complete game shutout, in the rain-shortened contest.
- The outing was the first complete game of Champlaine's career ... it was also his first scoreless start (of more than 1.0 innings) in 2025 ... the last time Champ threw multiple innings without allowing a run was September 15, 2024 vs. Toledo, when he threw 6.0 scoreless frames at home against the Mud Hens.
- Champlaine's complete game last night was Omaha's first since **Austin Cox** threw 7.0 innings in Game 1 of a doubleheader on August 28, 2022 vs. Scranton/WB ... Champ threw Omaha's first CG shutout since **Jake Kalish** threw 7.0 scoreless innings in Game 1 of a doubleheader on July 2, 2018 vs. Nashville.
- The complete game shutout last night from Champlaine was just the 4th in the Storm Chasers era (since 2011) ... the last Omaha pitcher to throw a complete game shutout that lasted less than 7.0 innings was **Anthony Lerew**, who threw 5.0 scoreless innings in a rain-shortened win on August 31, 2010 vs. Round Rock.
- Yesterday was just the second shutout of the season by an International League pitcher, after **Wade Miley** threw a rain-shortened 5.0 innings for Louisville on May 20 vs. Gwinnett.

PITCH, PLEASE

- Yesterday was Omaha's 4th pitching shutout of the season, continuing a strong stretch on the mound.
- Storm Chasers pitchers have not allowed a run over the last 22.0 innings, going back to the 2nd inning Wednesday.
- The current scoreless streak from Omaha's pitchers is the staff's longest of the season, passing a 19-inning stretch from May 9 (3rd inning) to May 11 (1st inning) @ Louisville.
- Omaha's staff is closing in on matching last year's longest scoreless streak on the mound ... the 2024 Storm Chasers had a stretch of 24.0 innings without allowing a run, from August 2 to 4 @ Rochester, spanning parts of 3 games.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

- While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.
- Omaha has successfully stolen 102 bases this year, and only been caught 17 times ... 102 steals rank 4th both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.
- 102-for-119 in steal attempts is a 85.7% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 4th-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 89.1%, 49-for-55).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

- The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 630 strikeouts this season ... that is the 2nd-most of any team in the league or at the Triple-A level.
- Over 567.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 9.99 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.
- With 630 strikeouts through 66 games, an average of 9.55 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,422 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

SACRIFICIAL LOVE

- The Omaha Storm Chasers lead the International League lead in both sacrifices (14) and sacrifice flies (29) as well.
- The Chasers led the IL in sacrifice bunts in 2024, with 38 last year ... the 14 sacrifice bunt this year are tied for the most in the league, tied 3rd at the Triple-A level, and tied 13th in the Minors ... **Tyler Tolbert**, **Harold Castro** and **John Rave** each have 3 sacrifice bunts, tied for the 4th-most in the league.
- 29 sac flies are the most of any Triple-A club and tied for the 3rd-most in Minor League Baseball ... **Tyler Gentry's** 6 sacrifice flies lead the IL and are tied for the most at the Triple-A level, one off the Minor League lead.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

- This season, 49 of Omaha's 66 games (74%) have been decided by 4 runs or less, including a recent stretch of 21 straight games.
- Wednesday's 5-run margin of victory of Toledo was Omaha's first game decided by more than 5 runs since a 8-2 loss to the Columbus Clippers on May 17.
- Over 21 games from May 18 to June 10, Omaha went 7-14 and every game had a scoring margin of 4 runs or less ... 16 of 21 games had a save recorded, including 5 of Omaha's 7 wins ... over the Chasers' recent 13-game, 2-week homestand, 11 games featured a save, including the first 10, between May 27 and June 6.
- While the games of recent have been close, only 27 of Omaha's first 42 games (64%) were decided by a margin of 4 runs or less.
