BIRDS SQUANDER EARLY LEAD IN 12-4 LOSS

The Myrtle Beach Pelicans were defeated by the Lynchburg Hillcats 12-4 on Friday evening at Bank of the James Stadium. The Pelicans (14-22) jumped ahead in the first when Jose Escobar doubled to score Ty Southisene, and Cameron Sisneros singled to plate Escobar, taking a 2-0 lead. The Hillcats (23-14) responded immediately in the bottom half, with Jose Pirela singling to score Tommy Hawke and Bennett Thompson hitting a sacrifice fly to score Welbyn Francisca, tying the game at 2-2. Lynchburg surged ahead in the second when Hawke doubled to score Robert Lopez and Yaikel Mijares, aided by a throwing error by center fielder Leonel Espinoza, and Thompson singled to score Hawke, making it 5-2. The Hillcats piled on in the third with Garrett Howe's triple scoring Logun Clark, Lopez's single scoring Howe, Francisca's single driving in Lopez and Hawke, and Thompson's single scoring Francisca, pushing the lead to 10-2. Pelicans starter Nazier Mule struggled, taking the loss after allowing six runs on six hits over 2.0 innings with two strikeouts, two walks, and two hit batters. Mathew Peters allowed four runs on six hits in 2.0 innings, and Cole Reynolds gave up two runs on four hits over 4.0 innings. Myrtle Beach rallied for two runs in the seventh when Anderson Surriel singled to score Yahil Melendez, and Southisene walked to score Christian Olivo, cutting the deficit to 10-4. Lynchburg answered in the eighth with Luis Merejo's triple scoring Francisca and Thompson's single scoring Merejo, finalizing the score at 12-4. The Pelicans managed eight hits, going 2-for-6 with runners in scoring position but leaving six runners on base, hampered by two fielding errors. Offensively, the Birds were led by Sisneros, who drove in one run with a single, finishing 2-for-4. Olivo paced the team in hits, going 2-for-3 with one run scored.

THE SILVER SEASON

The Pelicans celebrated their 25th season in 2024. After the departure of the Myrtle Beach Hurricanes in 1992, the Pelicans were established in 1999 following the relocation of the Durham Bulls to Myrtle Beach. During their 25 seasons, the Pelicans have won four Carolina League titles in 1999, 2000, 2015, and 2016. Myrtle Beach has been affiliated with three teams in their 25 seasons, including the Atlanta Braves (1999-2010), Texas Rangers (2011-2014), and the Chicago Cubs (2015-present)

A NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN

The Pelicans have a new manager in 2025. Yovanny Cuevas joined the Chicago Cubs organization as a player in 2015. His minor league career ran through 2021 with stops in the Dominican Summer League (DSL), the Arizona Complex League (ACL), and the Northwest League with the Eugene Emeralds. Overall, Cuevas' minor league slash line was .241/.369/.356 over 272 games. In 2022 Cuevas transitioned into a coach. His first assignment was with the ACL Cubs. The following season Cuevas was the hitting coach for the DSL Cubs Red squad, the Cubs affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. Last season he returned to the ACL Cubs as the hitting coach.

MEET THE "SQUADRON"

Highlighting the Pelicans roster are five of the Cubs' Top 30 prospects in Cole Mathis, Angel Cepeda, Yahil Melendez, Nazier Mule and Ty Southisene. Mathis is the 15th ranked prospect in the organization and will make his minor league debut this season with the Pelicans after being drafted 54th overall by the Cubs out of the College of Charleston in 2024. Cepeda slots into the 17th spot in the prospect rankings and is also the youngest player on the roster, having turned 19 in January. Angel grew up in New Jersey and scouts began taking interest in his talent when he was just 14 years old. He moved back to the Dominican Republic before signing with the Cubs in 2023.

The Pelicans Opening Day roster also welcomed eight Cubs' picks from the 2024 MLB Draft to the Grand Strand, including Mathis. Of the eight 2024 draftees, four are pitchers and four are position players. Brooks Caple, Evan Aschenbeck, Hayden Frank, Brayden Risedorph make up the pitchers while the hitters include Mathis, Owen Ayers, Matt Halbach and Cameron Sisneros.

16 players who have experience wearing the Pelicans uniform will return in 2025. Nazier Mule made 13 starts last season for the Pelicans, which was third most by any pitcher last season and leads all returners. In 2022 he was drafted by the Cubs in the 4th round and the 20-year-old is ready for his second season in Myrtle Beach.

Other returning players include Ayers, Sisneros, Jeral Vizcaino, Leonel Espinoza, Eriandys Ramon, Christopher Paciolla, Jose Escobar, Dilan Granadillo, Yenri Rojas, JP Wheat, Anderson Surriel, Alfredo Romero, Will Frisch, Luis Martinez-Gomez and Mathew Peters.

BIRD DROPPINGS

- After leading the league in home runs in both 2023 and 2024, the Pelicans have hit 20 homers this season which is the sixth most in the league. Myrtle Beach has hit 14 of their 20 homers on the road, the 2nd most road homers of any team in the league. Their 6 homers at home rank tied for tenth.
- Leonel Espinoza's 11-game hitting streak from 4/6-4/18 was the longest hitting streak in the league when it ended. Cameron Sisneros matched his streak with an 11-gamer from 4/25 to 5/11.
- Jose Escobar's 18-game on-base streak from 4/19 to 5/14 was the longest streak for a Myrtle Beach hitter since Jacob Wetzel reached base in 18 consecutive games from 5/22/2024-6/14/2024.

- Eriandys Ramon set the single-game franchise record with four doubles 8/15/24 vs. Columbia. He is 1 of 12 MB hitters with 2+ doubles as the Pelicans pace the Carolina League with 60 two-baggers. Cole Mathis is responsible for 8 doubles, placing him in a tie for ninth place on the league leaderboard.
- Pelicans' backstop Owen Ayers has been a dominant force in controlling the running game...he leads all of minor league baseball with 19 caught stealings while ranking 28th in total innings caught.
- Defensively, Myrtle Beach is 1 of 3 teams in all of Single-A to boast a fielding percentage above .975.
- MB ranks 6th in the league in total runners left on base and are 1 of 3 teams yet to attempt a SAC bunt.
