SPRINGDALE, AR – The Northwest Arkansas Naturals were unable to secure a series split with the Corpus Christi Hooks, dropping Sunday's series finale 17-4 at Arvest Ballpark, the largest margin of defeat this season.

- Corpus Christi scored at least two runs in seven of the game's nine innings, tagging every Naturals pitcher for at least two runs, two hits and two walks.
- The Hooks totaled 17 runs on 16 hits and 16 walks off Naturals pitching, as Northwest Arkansas had to use six pitchers to finish the game ... 16 walks broke the franchise record previously tied on May 3 @ Springfield.
- Combined, Naturals pitchers did also strike out 11, though, including five from starter **Alec Marsh** across 2.0 innings of work, as he maintained his league lead in strikeouts, coming one off the Double-A lead.
- Down 8-0 heading into the fourth inning, Northwest Arkansas was finally able to crack onto the scoreboard, as **Maikel Garcia** doubled off the wall to begin the inning and scored moments later on an opposite-field two-run home run from **Tucker Bradley**, Bradley's sixth homer this year.
- Garcia was replaced defensively at shortstop in the seventh by **Ryan Grotjohn**, who left the yard for the second time this season in his lone trip to the plate, a two-run home run to left field that scored **Jake Means** to give the Naturals their final runs of the game.
- Bradley and **Michael Massey** followed Grotjohn with back-to-back hits, but Northwest Arkansas was unable to close the deficit any further Sunday afternoon.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 3-10 all-time when playing on June 7

On June 7, 2012, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Arkansas Travelers, 6-5 in 10 innings at Arvest Ballpark. The Travs scored a run in the top of the 9th to tie the game at five, but after **Brendan Lafferty** and **Bryan Paukovits** combined for a scoreless top of the 10th, **Yem Prades** singled home **Paulo Orlando** with two outs for the second of 10 walkoff wins in 2012. All nine Naturals in the starting lineup had at least one hit, while Prades had three from the leadoff spot in the batting order. **Buddy Baumann** produced a sensation effort out of the bullpen, throwing four hitless and scoreless innings, while striking out two.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 17 of the Naturals' 27 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
10 of the Naturals' 27 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Angel Zerpa.

WALK THIS WAY

The Naturals pitching staff struggled with location in Sunday's loss, walking a franchise-record 16 batters in the 17-4 defeat to Corpus Christi.

- Each of the first five Naturals pitchers used in the game each walked at least two hitters, with starter Alec Marsh and reliever Walter Pennington each walking four ... all nine Hooks hitters drew at least one walk, including four multi-walk games.
Sunday's game was the fifth this season where Naturals pitching has walked at least 10 batters, the second time this week against a Corpus Christi team that walks more than any other in the Texas League.
The previous record was 13 walks, which had happened twice, first on April 9, 2015 @ Midland and most recently on May 3 @ Springfield ... the Naturals have twice walked 12+ against the Cardinals, also on April 9 (12).

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring six runs or more, the Naturals are 22-4, while when scoring five runs or less, just 2-22.
The Naturals are 17-5 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 7-21.
The Naturals are 22-8 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 2-18 when out-hit by their opponent.
When the Naturals score first, they are 17-9, whereas 7-17 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 3-12 in one-run games this season, meaning 12 of their 26 losses this season have been decided by just one run.

- Eight of the Naturals' last 13 losses have been by just a run.
The Naturals have had the winning run at the plate in six losses this season (all one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in 13 losses this season (including 10 of their one-run losses).

STARTER SUCCESS

The first five games of last week's series against Corpus Christi saw some of the best starting pitching of the season, as every starter pitched at least 5.0 innings, the first series this season where more than four starting pitchers threw at least 5.0 innings.

- Alec Marsh was only able to pitch 2.0 innings in Sunday's loss ... while five of his six outs came via the strikeout, he threw 64 pitches, an average of 32 pitches per inning, the 3rd-highest rate for a starter that throws at least one inning.
Through 50 games this season, Naturals starting pitchers have thrown at least 5.0 innings in 25 games, including seven outings of 6.0 innings or more, four coming from Drew Parrish.
In 39 of 50 games, Naturals starters have pitched at least 4.0 innings, including 24 of 30 since the start of May.

YO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 50 games, the Naturals have stolen 68 bases in 80 attempts (average 1.36 steals/game, 85.00% success rate) and pulled off a double steal 10 times.

- 68 steals ranks fourth in the Texas League, sixth in Double-A and tied 29th in the Minors.
Maikel Garcia's 16 steals (in 18 attempts) ranks tied fifth in the Texas League and tied ninth in all of Double-A.

HE DID THE MONSTER (MICHAEL) MASHEY

After a slow start to the season, second baseman Michael Massey has quickly become one of the top hitters in the Texas League.

- Michael has reached base in 38 of 47 games he's played this year, with a team-best 19 multi-hit games, including 8 in his last 13 games.
The second baseman does not just lead the Texas League in runs batted in, but all of Double-A too with 46 RBI, raking tied sixth in MiLB, while tied seventh in hits across the minors (64) ... among all Double-A hitters, Massey ranks fourth hits and ninth in batting average (.323) ... he is third in the Texas League in hits, ranks sixth in batting average, seventh in total bases (102), tied eighth in doubles (14) and tied 10th in extra-base hits (22).
He is scattered all across the Royals' organizational leaders, ranking first in hits, tied first in doubles, second in batting average, runs batted in, extra-base hits and total bases, fourth in slugging percentage (.515), OPS (.884) and runs scored (32), tied fourth in home runs and fifth in on-base percentage (.369).
From May 25 to May 28, Massey recorded multiple hits in five consecutive games, as the final five games in a season-best seven-game hitting streak and was subsequently named the league's Player of the Week.
In the month of May, Massey hit at a .381 (37-for-97) average with a 1.016 OPS across 24 games, while recording a league-best 37 hits and ranking second with 29 runs batted in.
Massey's turnaround at the plate truly began April 22, when he entered the day hitting just .213 and proceeded to homer in three consecutive games, April 22 to 24 in Frisco ... he went from having no home runs through the first 11 games of the season, to having eight in his last 33, leading the Naturals in homers.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop Maikel Garcia has reached base in 43 of the 48 games he has played in this season, reaching base twice on 29 occasions, 16 multi-hit games.

- In 228 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 89 times (58 hits + 31 walks), for a .392 on-base percentage.
Garcia has walked 31 times and struck out 40 times, a 0.78 K/BB rate.
The shortstop places among the Texas League leaders in several categories, ranking tied fifth in steals (16), tied sixth in hits (58), tied seventh in walks (31), tied eighth in runs scored (39) and doubles (14) ... he ranks among the Double-A leader in hits (tied eighth) and steals (tied ninth).
His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year and tied for the 15th-longest in club history ... it is also tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

PUSHIN (P)ORTER

Catcher Logan Porter has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest batting average (.333), on-base percentage (.462) and OPS (1.009) and ranks second in slugging percentage (.547) ... his .462 OBP ranks third in the league and Double-A, while fifth among ALL Minor League hitters.
Porter has reached base in 29 of 32 games he's played this season, with hits in 23 of 31 and 14 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
In the month of May, Porter hit .343 (24-for-70) with a team-best 1.017 OPS and he had drove in 13 runs with 11 walks.

* **May: LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (2)

* **April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.

* **May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

Pitchers of the Week (2)

* **May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.

* **May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.


#36 CHRIS WIDGER • MANAGER

- Chris Widger will manage the Naturals after guiding the River Bandits to a High-A Central championship in their first season as a Kansas City affiliate in 2021. In doing so, he was named the Minor League Manager of the Year by *Baseball America* following the 2021 season.

- Widger and his wife, Whitney, reside in Pennsville, N.J., with their children: C.J., Ashlynn and Skylar.




#43 DERRICK LEWIS • PITCHING COACH

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).
- Núñez played for parts of 12 seasons in the Majors with the Pirates (1997-2004), Cardinals (2005), Phillies (2006-2007) and Mets (2008). A switch-hitter, he owns a career average of .242 as a utility infielder in the big leagues, primarily playing third base, but could play all four infield positions.

#27 CHRISTIAN COLÓN • ASSISTANT HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



#23 MIKE JIRSCHOLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.
- Jirschele previously managed the Triple-A Omaha franchise for 11 seasons (2003-13), leading the team to four division titles, three-straight trips to the Pacific Coast League championship round (2011-13), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and a Triple-A Championship in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field.
- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.
- He was slated to serve in that role with Wilmington in 2020 and previously filled those roles with Lexington in 2019, Burlington from 2017-18 and with Surprise in 2016.
- Accola graduated from the University of Central Missouri in 2014 and previously held an athletic training internship with the Denver Broncos in 2013.
