**First Place Meeting:** The Somerset Patriots host the Erie SeaWolves for a six-game series beginning Wednesday night. The SeaWolves enter 0.5 games behind Bowie for first place in the Southwest Division and boast two top 10 MLB prospects according to Baseball America: Spencer Torkelson (No. 5), Riley Green (No. 9).

**Shutouts On Shutouts:** Somerset shut out the Harrisburg Senators in each of the last two games - and three of the last four games - of the preceding series. Patriots pitchers now enter the current series against Erie riding a season-best 20.1 consecutive innings without allowing a run, while the bullpen has tossed a season-high 15.2-straight scoreless innings. Somerset has tossed nine shutouts as a team this year, tied with Low-A Charleston for the most shutouts in Minor League Baseball.

**Hits and Misses:** The Patriots pitching staff has the lowest ERA (2.98) among all of Minor League Baseball (full season), is tied for the second-lowest WHIP (1.13), ranks second in batting average against (.203) and third in strikeouts (628). They lead all of Double-A in each of those respective stats.

**Otto-matic:** RHP Glenn Otto allowed one hit and struck out 12 batters over seven scoreless innings last night. He retired 20-straight at one point and carried a no-hitter through 6.2 innings. It was the fifth time this year Otto struck out 10 or more batters. The No. 28 Yankees prospect leads all Double-A pitchers and ranks second in MiLB with 95 K.

**The Right Junk:** RHP Janson Junk tossed three scoreless innings of relief Friday night and now leads all qualified pitchers in Minor League Baseball with a 1.00 ERA. The righty has only allowed five earned runs over 45.0 innings of work this year. Additionally, Junk ranks third in MiLB among qualified pitchers in WHIP (0.78) and BAA (.150).

They Have The Power: The Patriots tied a season-best with five home runs Saturday night, including a season-first three home runs in a single inning (Top 3rd). Somerset leads the league in home runs (75) and ranks third in all of Double-A baseball. Diego Castillo's leadoff homer in the top of the first marked the eighth time the first Patriots batter of the game hit a home run and the third time it's happend on the road this season. Somerset has 19 first-inning home runs this year - most in MiLB.

Go, Diego! Go!: Infielder Diego Castillo is hitting .333 (17-for-51) over the last road trip with four home runs, eight RBI, five doubles and 11 runs. Castillo's 10 home runs this season surpass his career total (8) entering the 2021 season. The Venezuelan infielder currently ranks second in the league in OPS (.973), fourth in slugging (.597) and fourth in batting (.327).

**Gill-I-Am:** Outfielder Isiah Gilliam has reached base safely in 13 of his last 14 games. Gilliam is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with a home run, five runs, eight RBI and nine walks over this stretch.

**Post Milone:** Outfielder Thomas Milone has reached base in 21-straight games dating back to May 11th, the longest such streak for the team this year. Milone is hitting .319 (23-for-72) over this streak with four home runs, 10 RBI, 13 runs and a .386 OBP.

**Here's Oswaldo:** Infielder Oswaldo Cabrera went 2-for-5 with a HR and a season-high four RBI Saturday night. It was his fourth multi-RBI game over the previous 12-game road trip (12 RBI). He now leads the team with 29 RBI on the season.
