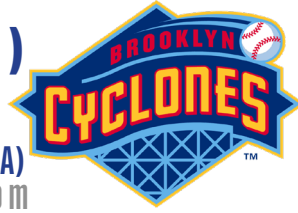

**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn emerged victorious in a high-scoring affair on Saturday, 9-7, over Jersey Shore...The Cyclones collectively notched 14 hits (five of which went for extra-bases), the most they've had in a single game this season... Six different members of Brooklyn's squad finished with multi-hit games, while CF **Omar De Los Santos** and SS **Kevin Vilavicencio** each logged two RBI...The 'Clones saw their once-six-run lead trimmed to just one, but an RBI base knock from 1B **Nick Lorusso** in the eighth, combined with three scoreless innings on the back end from RHP **Victor Castaneda** and RHP **Justin Lawson** sealed the deal for the win.

**CLIFF NOTES:** 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford** enters Sunday's matchup on a personal and team season-high seven-game hitting streak and 11-game on-base streak...Over the seven-game hit streak since Saturday's double-header, the 20-year-old is 9-for-24 (.375) with three doubles, three RBI, and three walks...His on-base streak stretches since April 9...During that span, Clifford is 11-for-37 (.297) with five extra-base hits — including a home run — four RBI, and seven walks.

**YIPPEE KI-YAY:** TWP **Nolan McLean** has been a revelation for the Cyclones so far in 2024...The 22-year-old has picked up at least one extra-base hit in all five games he has appeared as a position player...At the dish, McLean is 7-for-20 (.350) with six runs scored, four doubles, two home runs, and four RBI...On Saturday, the Willow Springs, N.C. native registered a career-high three hits — including a pair of doubles — and an RBI...Offensively, McLean enters the day tied for fifth in the South Atlantic League with six extra-base knocks, despite at least 15 fewer at-bats than any of the players tied or ahead of him...The former Oklahoma State Cowboy tossed 31 shutout innings in his first start and has punched out six over 6.0 total innings, thus far.

**HIT 'EM UP:** Brooklyn's offense erupted for a season-best nine runs on 14 hits in Saturday's 9-7 victory over Jersey Shore...The Cyclones' previous high-water marks were six runs and nine hits in Thursday's 6-4 win...Brooklyn's nine tallies were the most for the franchise in a single game since a 13-12 victory at Asheville last August 24...The 14-knock performance was the Cyclones' best since a 15-hit effort in an 11-9 loss in 10 innings vs. Wilmington on July 25, 2023...That contest was also the last time Brooklyn registered 9+ runs and 14+ hits in the same game.

**WOODEN AIR CONDITIONER:** Cyclones pitchers have created a ton of additional breeze via strikeouts in 2024...Entering play on Sunday, Brooklyn has registered 152 strikeouts in 118.1 innings, which is third most in the South Atlantic League, and only three behind Greenville, who leads the pack...Not only have the Cyclones racked up the punchouts, they have limited walks, too...Brooklyn enters the day tied for the second-fewest free passes (49) in the circuit...As a team, the 'Clones have a 30.2% strikeout rate and a 9.7% walk rate.

**WIZARD OF OS:** C **Drake Osborn** has been unstoppable at the plate to start the 2024 season...On Friday, the 25-year-old reached base four times thanks to an error and went 2-for-3 at the dish with a double, a walk...Osborn has reached base safely in all seven games he's played, hitting .409 (9-22) with a 1.155 OPS and adding two doubles, a home run, and three RBI...Among players in the South Atlantic League with at least 25 plate appearances, the Corpus Christi, Texas native leads the circuit in on-base percentage (.519) and is third in OPS (1.155).

**DE RECORD SETTER:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** enters Sunday's series finale 8-for-9 stealing bases to start the season...The eight swipes are tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League...De Los Santos is second on the Cyclones' all-time stolen base list (45)...He is three steals shy of matching UTL **Jaylen Palmer's** (48) all-time record...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for seventh across the Minors for swipes (115)...He broke INF **Walter Rasquin's** (32) franchise single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023.

**GRAB SOME PINE:** RHPs **Calvin Ziegler**, **Jordany Ventura**, **Sean Reid-Foley**, **Justin Lawson**, and **Ben Simon** united to punch out 18 Asheville batters in Sunday's walk-off victory...RHPs **Calvin Ziegler**, **Josh Hejka**, **Dakota Hawkins**, and **Joshua Corneilly** also combined to strike out 18 Wilmington hitters over 9.2 innings in April 7's loss at Wilmington...The 18 strikeouts by Cyclones pitching are the most for the franchise in a single game since July 23, 2016, vs. Aberdeen...RHP **Justin Dunn** (5), LHP **Kyle Regnault** (2), and RHP **Nabil Crismatt** (1) combined to whiff 18 IronBirds over 9.0 innings in a 7-2 win...The multiple contests with 18+ strikeouts are tied for the most by a Cyclones team since 2005...Brooklyn

**vs. JERSEY SHORE:** Brooklyn will play their first full six-game road series of 2024 against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Justin Crawford** (4), SS **Bryan Rincon** (9), INF **William Bergolla** (12), OF **Emaarion Boyd** (17), OF **Hendry Mendez** (23), and LHP **Samuel Aldeghe-ri** (24)...Last season, the BlueClaws won the season series against the Cyclones, 15-11, including a 11-6 record at ShoreTown Ballpark...Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 48-40 (.545).

also accomplished the feat in a pair of extra-inning games in 2016 and two nine-inning games in 2008...The single-game franchise mark for team strikeouts is 22 set in a 20-inning, 3-2 loss vs. Staten Island on June 17, 2016.

**KING STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** powered his first extra-base hit and home run, as well as earning his first RBIs of 2024 in Game 1 on Saturday...The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in all three categories with 43 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 94 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

**HOME OPENER:** The Brooklyn Cyclones opened up their 66-game home schedule last Tuesday evening vs. Asheville with a 3-0 win...The shutout marked the first for Brooklyn in a home opener since a 3-0 victory in 11 years...The Cyclones last blanked an opponent in their home debut on June 20, 2013, vs. Aberdeen...RHP **John Gant** (5.0 IP), RHP **Tim Peterson** (2.2), and LHP **John Mincone** (1.1) combined for the win...The 'Clones are now 17-5 all-time in their first home game of the season.

**YOUTH IS SERVED:** **Gilbert Gómez** takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, **Dariel**, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, **José**, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, **Héctor**, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

**FAMILIAR FACES:** Out of the 32 players on the Cyclones' current roster, 16 of them have previous experience playing on Coney Island...**Jeffrey Colón**, **Joshua Cornielli**, **Felipe De La Cruz**, **Jordan Geber**, **Josh Hejka**, **Joey Lancellotti**, and **Jordany Ventura** return to the bump, while **Drake Osborn** and **Christian Pregent** are holdovers behind the dish...**Ryan Clifford**, **Mateo Gil**, **William Lugo**, **D'Andre Smith**, and **Junior Tilién** are back in the infield, as **Stanley Consuegra** and **Omar De Los Santos** are set to roam the outfield.

**GENUINE DRAFT:** Eight members of last summer's New York Mets' draft class are with the Cyclones early in 2024...Pregent returned to the roster, while second-round selection RHP **Brandon Sproat** and third-round pick two-way player **Nolan McLean** are scheduled to make their High-A debuts...RHP **Noah Hall** (7th), INF **Nick Lorusso** (9th), RHP **Brett Banks** (11th), RHP **Ben Simon** (13th), and RHP **Justin Lawson** (15th) round out the group...RHP **Dakota Hawkins**, who signed as an undrafted free agent, is also with the club.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 5), **Brandon Sproat** (11), **Nolan McLean** (15), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: **Clifford** (4), **Sproat** (13), **McLean** (19), **Ziegler** (22), and INF **Wilfredo Lara** (23)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 93rd-best farmhand in all of baseball.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision in the opening game of the series at Jersey Shore on Tuesday night...Allowed just one run on three hits over four innings... Walked a pair and tied a career-best with five strikeouts... Only run allowed came on a DH **Leandro Pineda** solo home run in the fourth...Relieved by RHP **Diosmerky Taveras** to start the bottom of the fifth inning with the game tied at one...BlueClaws scored one in the sixth and another in the eighth to defeat the Cyclones, 3-1.

**PROSPECT RADAR:** Sproat enters the 2024 campaign as one of the top pitching prospects in the New York Mets farm system...The 23-year-old is considered New York's No. 11 prospect per *Baseball America* and No. 13 by MLB Pipeline...He is the fourth-ranked pitching prospect in the organization by *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline.

**SPRING BREAKOUT:** The Pace, Fla. native earned a hold pitching in relief for the New York Mets prospects in their contest against the Washington Nationals' farmhands on Friday, March 15...Sproat came on in support of fellow Cyclone RHP **Nolan McLean** in the top of the sixth...The right-hander retired the side in order on just six pitches (all strikes) earning punch outs of C **Maxwell Romero Jr.** and OF **Andrew Pinckney**...McLean earned the win and teammate RHP **Calvin Ziegler** picked up the save in New York's 4-2, seven-inning win.

**GATOR BAIT:** Sproat did not pitch after being drafted by the Mets last season, but thrived for the 2023 NCAA runner-up Florida Gators...In 19 starts, the right-hander posted an 8-3 record with a 4.66 ERA (55 ER in 106.1 IP), earning All-SEC Second Team honors...Sproat finished the campaign seventh among Division I pitchers in strikeouts (134).

**THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM:** Sproat was drafted for the third and final time in the MLB draft last summer, ultimately signing for a \$1.47 million bonus...Prior to being New York's second-round selection in 2023, the 23-year-old was picked by the Mets in the third round of the 2022 draft out of Florida, but did not sign...In 2019, Sproat was drafted by the Texas Rangers in the seventh round out of Pace High School, but also did not sign.

**FAMILIAR FACES:** While at the University of Florida, Sproat spent the summer of 2021 pitching for the Chatham Anglers of the Cape Cod Baseball League...During that time, the right-hander was teammates with current Cyclones TWP **Nolan McLean** and former Brooklyn RHP **Kolby Kubichek** and C **Kevin Parada**.
