

LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox bounced back for a convincing win over the Reading Fightin Phils on Wednesday at FirstEnergy Stadium. After falling behind in the first inning, Bowie knotted the game up in the fifth inning before exploding for four runs in the eighth inning, closing the night with a 5-1 win. Andrew Daschbach highlighted the four-run frame with a three-run homer, his fourth of the season. While Ryan Watson did allow a solo home run to Aldrem Corredor in the first inning, the right-hander saw no issue cruising through five innings. Rico Garcia picked apart the Reading offense for three innings, retiring all nine batters faced, and throwing a four-pitch seventh inning along the way, and Morgan McSweeney spun a scoreless ninth to finish.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

One of the most tenured teams in the entire league, Reading is running into many of the same struggles that plagued them in 2021, as they have been at least five games back in the Northeast Division standings for 12-straight games. The Fightins are batting a league-worst .203 at the start of this series. Opponents have made the most against Reading pitching this season, as their 5.04 ERA is the third-highest in the league. Despite playing in a notably hitter-friendly stadium, Reading pitchers have allowed only 22 home runs, the fourth-fewest in the league, with 12 coming at home.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Erik Miller is taking things slow on a return from injury that sidelined him for most of the 2021 season. A top-15 prospect in the Phillies organization, Miller has not thrown more than three innings in any outing this season, and has only made two starts. His outings have been strong, though, as he's struck out 18 batters against only four walks in 12 innings, and has only allowed two runs. He pitched well in the Arizona Fall League as well, where his fastball flashed 99 miles per hour at points, as well as a three-dimensional slider in the low-80s, and a changeup.

SHIFT HIM THE OTHER WAY

Baysox infielder Joey Ortiz slapped a double to the right-center field gap in the sixth inning of Wednesday's game, returning to a form he held at the start of the season. After the first nine games of the season, Ortiz was hitting the ball either up the middle or to the opposite field 85.7% of the time, the highest qualified mark in the league. After working on that number in the cage, Ortiz has shifted back to a much more traditional spray hitter, as his pull rate has jumped over 40%, and his opposite field rate still holds above 35%

MAKING DO

As Bowie has dealt with fluidity in their starting rotation, needing to dip into bullpen arms for their recent turn through the rotation, their main starters have picked up the slack to compensate. Bowie's usual starters (Garrett Stallings, Drew Rom, and Ryan Watson) have been able to carry the load while Zach Peek, Antonio Velez, and Brandon Young have been on the IL. Since Zach Peek's last start on 4/30, Bowie's standard starters have gone at least five innings in every start, holding an even 4.00 ERA in the outings, and logging 27 strikeouts in 27 innings.

PATIENCE, YOUNG GRASSHOPPER

Bowie has been frustrating opposing pitchers this season with their patience and discipline at the plate. Their 138 walks lead the Eastern League, despite playing two fewer games than most teams in the circuit. Bowie also sports three of the top 15 batters in the Eastern League for most pitches seen, as Andrew Daschbach, Gunnar Henderson and Jordan Westburg sit in the rankings.

TOP GUNNAR



Infielder Gunnar Henderson was named the Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday, after going 9-for-17 at the plate with a double, a home run, four RBI, and five runs scored. While he did go 0-for-2 on Wednesday, he extended his on-base streak to 27 consecutive games thanks to two walks. He's reached base in every game this season for the Baysox, the longest stretch in the league. Gunnar has increased his walk rate from just 12.1% across three levels played last season up to over 20% so far this season. Henderson is ranked as the Orioles #3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's #64 overall prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline. Listed as #4 for the Orioles and #57 in MiLB by Baseball America. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at 4 third base by MiLB.com for his 2021 season.

Eight of his first nine appearances were out of the bullpen, but his following 14 appearances to close

- Apr 17 @ BNG Struck out the side in the first inning (including an auto-strike three on the leadoff batter) When Bowie had jumped to a 4-0 lead, Velez allowed a solo home run in the second inning before tossing a perfect third. Was chased in the fifth inning after allowing five consecutive batters to reach base, as well as four runs, with a two-run home run mixed in by top Mets prospect Francisco Alvarez. All four runs were scored with two outs.
 - Worked heavily on pitching to contact. Only struck out one batter over the firs 4.2 innings. Only run over first five inning was due to a leadoff triple followed by a single in the fifth. Only used 38 total or 23 v AKR pitches over the first five innings. Was the first pitcher for Bowie this season to pitch into the sixth inning, but allowed a string of four hits and a sacrifice fly on the third trip through the order that knocked him out of the game. Spent the game going toe-to-toe with Akron's Daniel Espino while the top Gaurdians pitching prospect struck out the first 11 batters of the game, and 14 total.

Third batter of the games was a two-run home run by Sean Roby, his eighth home run of the season. Velez did not allow another baserunner for the remainder of the outing, aside from one error. Bowie held Richmond to only two hits, but lost 2-1.

Manager: Kyle Moore

Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double- A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
