Tonight: The Lugnuts play the third game of a six-game series with the West Michigan Whitecaps, the ninth meeting of 24 total between the archrivals this season. The first eight have been split evenly, with a six-game series halved in June and Lansing winning the opener on Tuesday before the Whitecaps struck back to take a matinee yesterday. Right-hander **Jack Cushing**, the Georgetown Hoyas' all-time career strikeout record-holder, makes his third Nuts start, opposed by Caps right-hander **Garrett Hill**.

Last Night: Whitecaps 5, Lugnuts 1. Eric De La Rosa delivered a two-run single in the third inning, Jimmy Kerr led off the seventh with a solo home run, and the Whitecaps recovered from allowing a run in the first four Lugs batters (Shane Selman HBP, Lazaro Armenteros 2B, Austin Beck SF) to limit the Lugnuts to two hits and no runs after the first inning.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday before returning home July 27-August 1 against the Fort Wayne TinCaps.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

No Place Like Close to Home: The Lugnuts are in the midst of a period of easy travel. Between June 28 and August 1, the Nuts don't leave the state of Michigan, with their only road trips to Midland (Great Lakes) and Comstock Park (West Michigan).

Alumni Report: Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who played for the 2017 Lugnuts, is third in the Majors in batting average (.329), second in home runs (32), first in RBIs (79), first in on-base percentage (.430), first in total bases (224), first in OPS (1.107) and first in runs (75). 2019 Lugs outfielder Griffin Conine, playing for Beloit (MIA), leads the minors with 23 homers. 2021 Lugnuts infielder Max Schuemann, now playing in Double-A Midland, is tied for fourth in the minors with 35 steals.

Bruised: This is getting ridiculous. The Lugnuts were hit by two more pitches yesterday and have now been hit four times in two games in this series, 17 times in 18 games this month, and a league-leading 65 times this year, third highest in the Minors. Meanwhile, Nuts pitchers have hit 18 batters in 18 games this month, one vesterday, and 56 this year, third highest in the High-A Central.

Cobie! Infielder Cobie Vance has reached base eight times in nine plate appearances in this series. On Tuesday, he singled, doubled, homered, walked and was hit by a pitch. Yesterday, he singled, walked and was hit by a pitch again. Vance has an OPS of .885 this month (.291/.394/.491) with 13 runs scored in 16 games.

Youth is Served: 20-year-old Jordan Díaz, the youngest player on the Lansing roster, is hitting .344/.437/.525 with 11 runs, 14 RBIs, 7 XBH (2 HRs) and a 10/6 BB/K ratio in 18 games in July.

Heating Up: Starter Reid Birlingmair gave up one unearned run in five innings Friday and has now posted a 1.06 ERA in three starts this month (3 R/2 ER, 17 IP) with a .153 opponent batting average. Fellow starter **Jack Cushing** has a 1.00 ERA in three appearances, two starts, (2 R/18 IP), allowing an OBA of .145.

Trusted Relief: This series involves some of the most heavily used relief pitchers in the High-A Central, with Jared Tobey (27 gms., 1st), Dalton Sawyer (26 gms., 2nd), and Zack Hess (25 gms., 3rd), and Charles Hall and Angel Reyes (24 gms., T-4th). All four have already appeared in this series.

Whitecaps Killer: Catcher Drew Millas is hitting 11-for-24 (.458) with four runs, one double, two homers and five walks (.552 on-base percentage) in six games against West Michigan this year.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: Mike McDade hit a monstrous home run off Austin Bibens-Dirkx over the parking lot in Peoria out beyond right-center (estimated over 450 ft.) and the Lugnuts beat the Chiefs, 6-2, behind five shutout innings from Henderson Alvarez.

2017: Griffin Jax, a third-round selection from the Air Force Academy in 2016, pitched 6 2/3 innings before departing to a standing ovation on his way to reporting to active duty with the U.S. Air Force, and the host Cedar Rapids Kernels topped the Lugnuts, 12-4.

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's a larger crowd than any of the Blue Jays' home games this season in Dunedin or Buffalo and it's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Oakland Athletics, Miami Marlins and Toronto/Buffalo/Dunedin Blue Jays. Only eight of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Roster Index: The newest Nut, José Mora, is the 845th Lugnut all-time and the 41st player used this year. The 2021 Lugnuts have surpassed the total number of players used in the 1996 (40), 1999 (38), 2001 (40) and 2009 (38) seasons. The franchise record for most players used in a single year is 54, set in 2017. Currently, 18.6% of all Lugnuts have reached the Major Leagues (157 of 845). If that percentage continues to hold true, at least seven of the 41 players to see time this year with the Nuts will reach MLB.

Major League Lugnuts: Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, and pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBis, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard University, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth College and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell University before grad-transferring to Wake Forest. Speaking of outstanding academic institutions, starter Jack Cushing spent four years at Georgetown University.

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Nevada (Connor Hughes), North Carolina, Ohio (Scott Steinmann), Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 14 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.



2021 in Lansing:

- Began the season as the No. 3 starter in Stockton's rotation and blasted out of the gates with four hitless innings, walking three and striking out two, against the Modesto Nuts, May 6.
- Finished May with a 0.92 ERA in four starts: 2 ER in 19 2/3 IP, 7 BB, 23 K and a .147 opponent average. Struck out 10 batters in six innings at Rancho Cucamonga, May 27, allowing two hits, one walk and

Going Pro: Drafted in the 22nd round, 2019, signing with the A's for \$1,000... signing scout: Tripp Faulk, who also signed the Lugnuts' Bryce Nightengale and Elvis Peralta, Jr., and was the scout for 2021 Oakland Athletics draft picks Zack Gelof (2nd round) and Aaron Holiday (13th round).

2019 Pro Debut: Opened in AZL with two appearances for A's Gold before making 11 appearances, 6 starts, with Short-Season Vermont... in best appearance, 8/1/19, pitching five shutout two-hit innings at State College, striking out two... opposition went 4-for-5 in stealing bases against him.

Traveling Childhood: Born in Enid, Oklahoma - the ninth-largest city in the state - Cushing moved to Colorado for "several years" before his family relocated to Flower Mound, 28 miles northwest of Dallas, when he was seven... he grew up rooting for the Texas Rangers... Flower Mound is named for, yes, a flowering mound - a 50-foot tall hill nicknamed "The Mound," maintained by The Mound Foundation, which features dozens of flowers naturally blooming each spring...
