FRES-NOTES

WORKHORSE NEEDED: Austin Newton gets the ball for game three carrying something no other pitcher in the California League can claim — his 76.0 innings pitched lead the entire circuit. That durability gives Fresno a real chance to grab momentum back tonight against Stockton LHP Alex Barr, who's been one of the most hittable starters in the league (1-4, 8.24 ERA). With Fresno's bats running hot and holding a .282 average / .827 OPS against right-handed pitching this year, tonight sets up as a good spot to turn the series around.

CLAUSEN'S STILL HEAD OF CLASS: Seth Clausen took the loss Wednesday despite two strong innings. He ran into trouble in the eighth but escaped the jam. Despite not being able to get out of the ninth, he's been one of the best relievers in the California League all year. He carries a 1.38 ERA and 8 saves (2nd-most in the league) into this series, and his .125 opponents' average is still the best mark on the Fresno staff by a wide margin. For context, his 8 saves are double the total of Stockton's own closer, Kevin Brown (4). One tough night against a strong Ports lineup doesn't change who the best arm in this bullpen is.

CHOPPING WOOD, CARRYING WATER: Roldy Brito is 4-for-10 with a homer and 2 stolen bases through two games, extending a season-long trend of hitting Stockton better than any other opponent (.333, 4 HR in 13 games this year). Derek Bernard has been even hotter, going 4-for-7 with 2 doubles and a homer to open the series — a .571 average. They weren't alone Wednesday, either: Wilder Dalis matched his season high with 4 hits, and the Grizzlies matched their team season-high with 6 doubles in the game.
